# Crew safe after B-52 Crash at Andersen Air Force Base, Guam

**A**NDERSEN AIR FORCE BASE, Guam -- A U.S. Air Force B-52H Stratofortress bomber crashed at approximately 8:30 a.m. local time, on the Andersen flightline, May 19, 2016. All seven aircrew members have safely egressed the aircraft.

No injuries have been reported. Emergency responders are on scene.

The B-52 was deployed to Andersen AFB from Minot, North Dakota, as part of the DoD's continuous

bomber presence mission in the Pacific. The aircrew are members from the 69th Expeditionary Bomb Squadron and were performing a routine training mission.

The incident is under investigation

and measures to mitigate possible environmental impacts are being taken. More information will be released as it becomes available.

## Investigation Continues After B-52 Accident on Andersen AFB, Guam

**A**NDERSEN AIR FORCE BASE, Guam -- Emergency responders and law enforcement officials have successfully completed their initial response procedures following a B-52H Stratofortress accident that occurred earlier today.

The seven aircrew

members aboard are safe and no injuries have been reported.

"We are thankful that the aircrew are safe," said Brig. Gen. Douglas Cox, 36th Wing Commander. "Because of their quick thinking and good judgment in this emergency situation, the aircrew not only saved their lives but averted a more catastrophic

incident."

Responding to the incident was a joint effort as emergency response personnel from Andersen, Navy Base Guam, Joint Region Marianas and Government of Guam promptly established a cordon and extinguished the flames.

"Our personnel regularly train to respond to crises like the one we experienced today," said Cox. "We're also grateful for the support from our Government of Guam and U.S. Navy partners in addressing this serious incident."

Andersen environmental specialists are assessing any potential impacts that may have resulted from leaked fluids or burning aircraft materials to prevent damage to the ecosystem.

The aircraft was carrying inert munitions at the time and posed no danger to the local community.

When an incident or accident occurs, there are three types of boards that will convene. First is the Interim Safety Board, which serves as the on-scene safety team and is responsible for information

gathering and the preservation of evidence.

Following the ISB, a Safety Investigation Board will be convened to investigate the incident for the sole purpose of preventing future mishaps. The SIB report is privileged and is not releasable outside of safety channels.

Upon completion of the SIB, the Accident Investigation Board is convened. The AIB's charter is to perform the legal investigation, and as such that is a publically releasable report.

Once the AIB is completed, results will be released via a public affairs release.

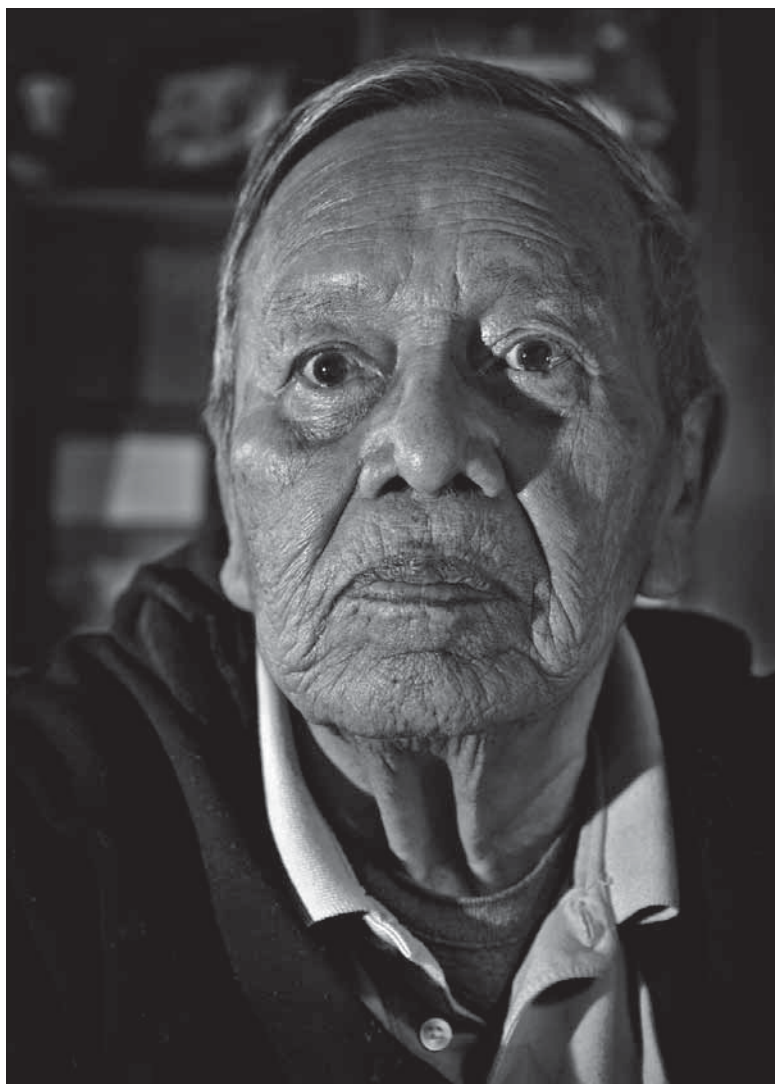

# Commentary: A Proud Heritage

**M**INOT AIR FORCE BASE, N.D. -- We hear it over and over from our leadership as it's reiterated at each commander's call. It feels like a mandatory tag line at the end of every speech. It's the topic that the chief will inevitably have to 'piggyback' off of. What am I talking about? We all know the phrase, "Airmen, know your Air Force heritage..." Even our Airman's Creed states that we are "faithful to a proud heritage."

We all read the stories about Jimmy Doolittle and the Raiders, Henry "Hap" Arnold, and certainly, the Tuskegee Airmen. We've memorized the key dates in the Air Force's historical timeline, and we share a slice of cake on our service's birthday. This is what I thought it meant to know your heritage, because that's the heritage I'm told to know for my promotion test, right? At the beginning of this year I was told by my leadership to make a list of work-related goals for 2016.

My goals were simple: Write more stories, strengthen my photography skills and make Senior Airman Below the Zone. In order to work towards my goal of improving my photography, I made an effort to take more portraits.

What began as a single cold-call interview formed into a personal project taking portraits of veterans, and in turn learning about my heritage - a heritage more personal than something I could ever find in the Air Force Professional Development Guide.

I drove a little more than two hours to Mandan, North Dakota, to meet with a man named Wilbur Pleets. Airman 2nd Class (Sep.) Pleets served in Europe as an aircraft missile accessory repairman during the Vietnam War era.

Pleets and I sat at a small table in his living room. He sipped his coffee and reminisced about his time in the service, and I

tried to catch every word with my pen and notepad.

"I remember the little pots of coffee on the flightline, that Airmen sat around talking about being home," said Pleets with a chuckle as he took another drink from his own cup.

We sat for hours as he told me stories of his time in France, Holland, Ireland, North Africa, Spain, Germany and Iceland.

"Airman 2nd Class Pleets reporting," said Wilbur, recalling his first moments overseas as he reported to his barracks chief. "He said, 'where you from chief,' he must have known I was Indian."

Pleets, who is Standing Rock Sioux, told me about his experience as one of the few Native Americans, whom he knew of, at his air base.

Pleets also spoke of his visit to the American Cemetery and Memorial in Normandy, France and seeing the remnants of WWII.

"My uncle, Herbert Buffaloboy, was assigned

to the 82nd Airborne Division and was in the invasion of Normandy," said Pleets proudly. Then after a long pause of contemplation, he continued in a more somber tone.

"We saw some of those places, where they kept Jews. It made you upset how people died there."

There was a certain light in his eyes as he spoke about his time in the Air Force, remembering old friends and long forgotten memories.

It was that moment when it hit me. This is my heritage.

Pleets is just one of many Airmen that served their country before me and paved the way to make us the world's greatest Air Force.

event and the limited parking spaces available, the Outlet Fishing Area will be closed Saturday to Refuge visitors from 5 am to 3 pm.

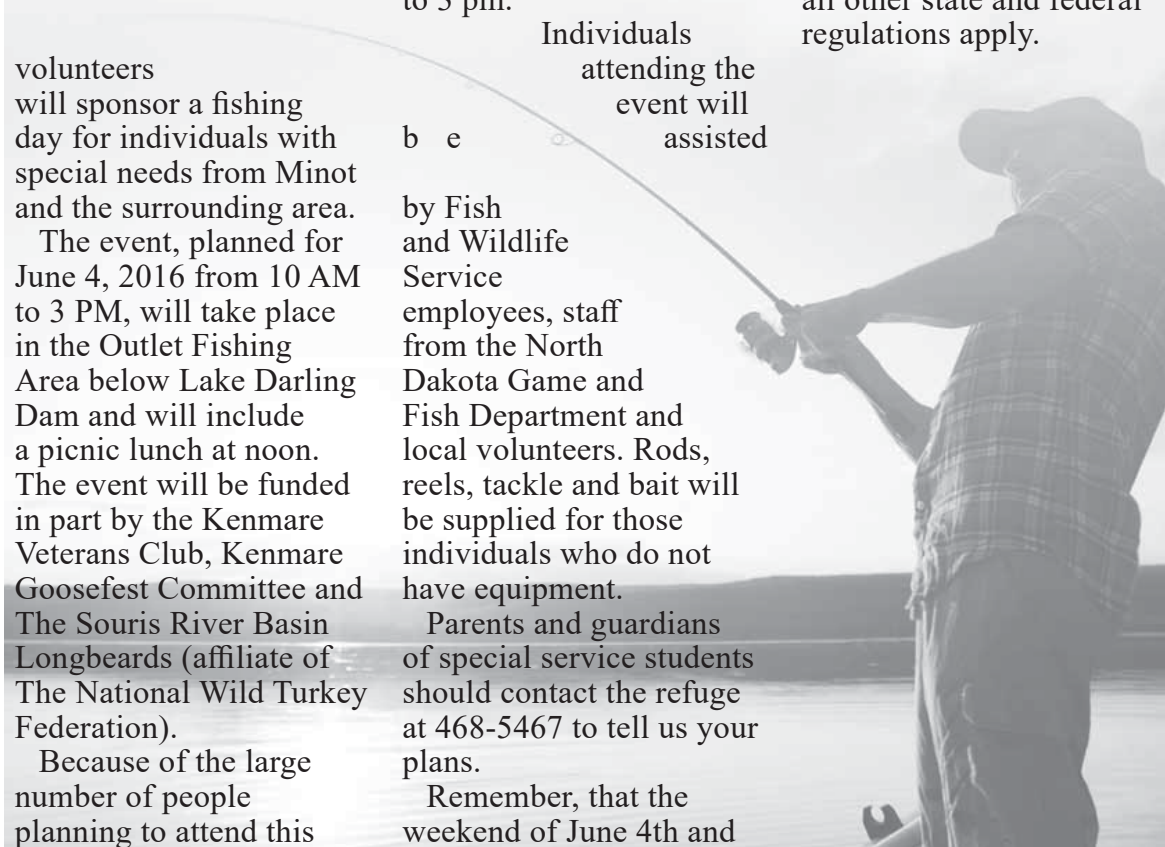
Individuals attending the event will be assisted

## PRAIRIE ADVENTURES

The N.D. Game and Fish Department has offered online licensing and lottery applications for several years and it continues gaining popularity.

The 2015 legislature ramped that up a notch by requiring online sales only for all non-lottery licenses – fishing, upland, habitat and small game stamp, sportsman's combination, and archery licenses, for example.

People need to go online with their computer or smartphone to order licenses or they can go to authorized vendors with computer access to purchase them.

So far, though, paper applications are still available for all lottery species – turkey, tundra swan, deer, pronghorn, and the “Big Three” – elk, moose, and bighorn sheep.

Admittedly, feedback is mixed about online only license sales, N.D. Game and Fish Department wildlife division chief Jeb Williams.

Some hunters prefer to go to vendors and mail in lottery applications, Williams explained, while others might not have Internet access.

However, every year more hunters apply for lottery licenses online. “It's been climbing every year... it's about 70 percent online,” Williams described.

The Game and Fish Department will eventually have all lottery applications be available online only. However, there is no timeframe or target date, Williams added.

Part of the hesitancy to online only lottery applications is the challenge of dealing with legal land descriptions for gratis license applicants. Most paper, mail-in lottery applications are from those requesting gratis licenses because they must enter the nuances of legal descriptions for each parcel they want applied to the gratis license.

Many hunters have al-

ready discovered online licensing advantages, however: They can print out multiple copies.

If they lose their hard copy license, they can access the Game and Fish Department website and print it out again.

In addition, the North Dakota legislature also made it legal for hunters who carry smartphones with them to use an electronic copy of the license, saved either as a PDF file or by going to the online copy from the Game and Fish Department website, as the equivalent of a paper hard copy license.

Basically, there isn't any reason not to have one's hunting license in their possession as required by North Dakota law.

By ordering online hunters can have license copies in every vehicle, jacket, shirt, or pants pocket, and one's smartphone.

Also, when by submitting online lottery applications, the Game and Fish Department politely informs applicants if they're successful.

Or not.

Hunters don't even have to go online to search for their lottery results nor do they have to wait patiently – or impatiently – for the license or, sadly, the refund.

As if these reasons haven't convinced every hunter to apply for the upcoming deer gun season via online lottery applications, there is yet one more reason: Data can be processed faster when more applications are done online. Paper applicants still require someone at the Game and Fish Department to enter all of the information into the lottery system and that means the potential for human error.

With online applications, the only human error is if the human making the application enters the wrong information.

However one applies, deer gun and muzzleloader applications are due June 1.

## S'no Go

Muddled 'Snow White' prequel-sequel mash-up can't find its way

Hey Snow, where'd you go? In 2012, Snow White and the Huntsman gave the age-old fairy tale a sassy new action-y feminist twist, with Kristin Stewart as the feisty, fair-skinned maiden—foretold by the Magic Mirror to be the loveliest in the land—and Chris Hemsworth as the evil queen's "huntsman" ordered to take her into the woods and kill her.

Of course, things didn't quite work out that way—and now we have The Huntsman: Winter's War, a sequel. Actually it's a prequel. Well, I think it's a little of both, and a mash-up of several other things, too, and quite a bit of an all-around muddled mess.

And Snow White seems to have wisely decided to steer clear from it all. So there's no Snow in this Huntsman, unless you count the times she's mentioned by name. But the movie certainly isn't hurting for other talent. Hemsworth is back, and so is Charlize Theron as the wicked monarch Ravenna. Emily Blunt is newly aboard as Ravenna's sister Freya, turned into a cruel "ice queen" by an act of heartless treachery. Jessica Chastain is Sara, who like Hemsworth's rebellious Huntsman, grew up as an abducted child soldier forced to serve in Freya's army of marauders.

British comedic actors Nick Frost and Rob Brydon, shrunk to wee size by the modern magic of digital effects, play a pair of dwarf brothers who provide most of the chuckles in this otherwise dull and dreary

trek through a disjointed plot that feels like someone threw bits of Game of Thrones, Disney's Frozen, Lord of the Rings and The Wizard of Oz into a blender with some crushed ice, black goo and gold flecks, then set it to puree.

If you're into ornate costumes, you might dig the over-the-top duds in which Blunt and Theron get to vamp. In the couple of scenes they're together, I kept wishing Cher would suddenly appear—maybe descending from the ceiling—for a full-on Las Vegas revue.

The storybook decor is lush and quite lovely, especially when the Huntsman, Sara, the two dwarves and their special-effect dwarf dates (Alexandra Roach and Sheridan Smith) take a day trip to Goblin Land, or something like that, to retrieve the purloined Magic Mirror, which looks like a huge polished cymbal from a music store. Some of the location filming was done in England's Windsor Great Park, although I'm pretty sure you won't find any big, blue ape-men, giant moss-covered snakes or tiny fluorescent flying fairies there.

Not campy and gonzo enough to be real fun, nor dark and dangerous enough to qualify as truly grim, this is instead a drab, disjointed stab by a first-time feature director who, bless his heart, can't seem to find his target in all the icy, FX-laden glop. The best—and most amazing—thing about it by far is its all-star, A-list cast, all of whom who gamely give it their best in the service of something clearly less than "the fairest of them all."

## Hawaiian Chicken Kebabs



### INGREDIENTS:

- 1/3 cup ketchup
- 1/3 cup packed dark brown sugar
- 1/3 cup low-sodium soy sauce
- 1/4 cup pineapple juice
- 4 Tbsp olive oil, divided, plus more for brushing grill
- 1 1/2 Tbsp rice vinegar
- 4 garlic cloves, minced (4 tsp)
- 1 Tbsp minced ginger
- 1/2 tsp sesame oil
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 1 3/4 lb boneless, skinless chicken breast, chopped into cubes
- 3 cups fresh cubed pineapple (about 3/4 of 3 lb pineapple)
- 1 1/2 large green peppers, diced into 1 1/4-inch pieces
- 1 large red onion, diced into 1 1/4-inch pieces

### INSTRUCTIONS:

In a mixing bowl whisk together ketchup, brown sugar, soy sauce, pineapple juice, 2 Tbsp olive oil, rice vinegar, garlic, ginger and sesame oil. Stir in 3/4 tsp pepper and season with salt if desired. Place chicken in a gallon size resealable bag. Reserve 1/2 cup of the marinade in refrigerator then pour remaining marinade over chicken. Seal bag and refrigerate 3 hours (meanwhile soak 10 wooden skewer sticks in water for 1 hour). Preheat a grill over medium heat to 400 degrees. Meanwhile, drizzle remaining 2 Tbsp olive oil over red onion, bell pepper and pineapple and toss. Season red onion and bell pepper with salt and pepper, then thread red onion, bell pepper, pineapple and chicken onto skewers until all of the chicken has been used. Brush grill grates with olive oil then place skewers on grill. Grill 5 minutes then brush along tops with 1/4 cup of remaining marinade. Rotate to opposite side and brush remaining 1/4 cup of marinade on opposite side and allow to grill about 4 minutes longer, or until chicken registers 165 degrees in center on an instant read thermometer. Serve warm.

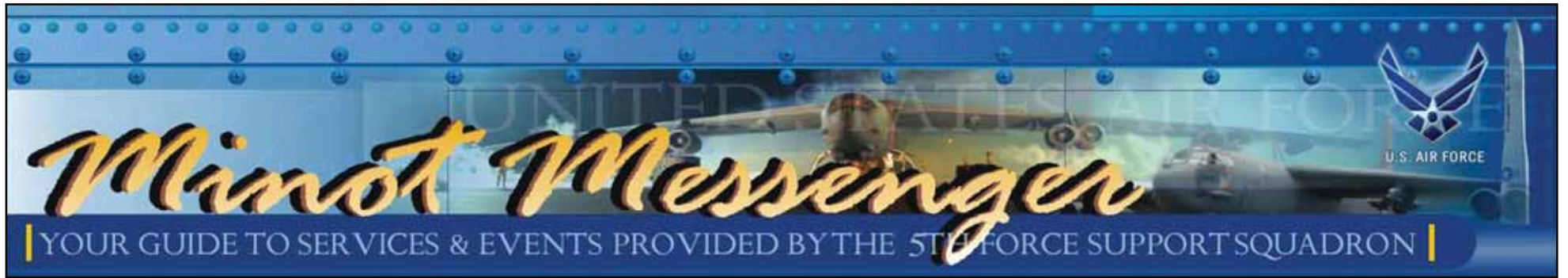
