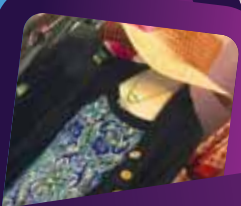

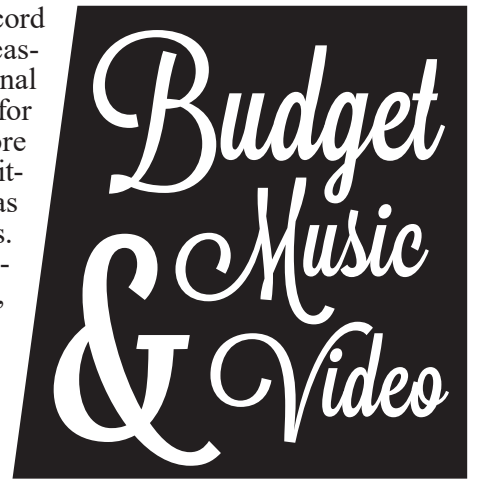
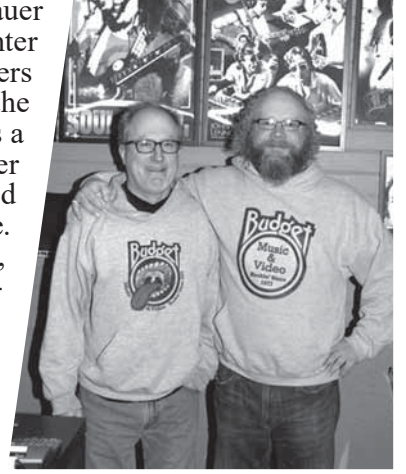

SRB was Minot's first Brewpub & Restaurant to source ingredients from local and regional suppliers, thereby strengthening the community economic base and fostering goodwill across the region.

Located on 32 3rd Street NE, Souris River Brewing is tucked within the outskirts of downtown Minot. The restaurant's interior was designed from reclaimed wood from former North Dakota churches and homesteads. The menu has a variety of different dishes with main entrees featuring North Dakota sourced elk, bison, beef, and walleye. Pairing that with their premium craft brewed beers created in house; Souris River Brewing provides an unprecedented experience that captures

the spirit of the land, people and history of the Great Northern Plains.

Minot Center for Pediatric Therapy



“Any speech or language problem is likely to have a significant effect on a child’s social, academic skills and behavior. The earlier the identification and treatment of a child’s speech and language problems, the less likely they will persist or worsen. Early speech and language intervention can help children with reading and writing and with interpersonal relationships”. - DIANE PAUL, PH.D., CCC-SLP

The Minot Center for Pediatric Therapy is the answer to many who have been diagnosed with speech & language disorders or developmental delays. The center opened its doors in August 2012, with the hope to treat patients and their families with compassion and dignity. Kylee Geer, founder of the center, felt there was a need for more therapy options for children and adolescents with special needs in our community.

Kylee Geer has seen an increase in patients. So the addition of an occupational therapy service was added in 2013, Krisann Miller. Soon

after Geer and Miller added two additional speech pathologists, Cassie Sheppard (2014) and Mackenzie Nagel (2016). They work with children and their families to build a variety of skills: communication, fine motor, daily living, self-care, play, feeding, emotional regulation, and social skills. They work with children and adolescents from birth to age 21. Parents and family members typically observe therapy sessions to help promote skills into their daily activities at home.

Geer stated that during the construction parking will be available but, not necessarily convenient at all times. She recommends clients to allow more drive time getting to your appointment and extra time finding a parking space in case the building’s lot is full.

Mouse River Players

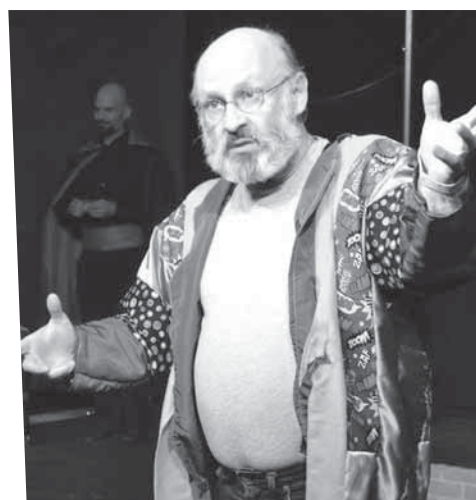

The Mouse River Players is Minot’s oldest community theatre beginning in 1971. Other performances listed for the season include; “The Best Christmas Pageant Ever” by Barbara Robinson which is a classic youth performance; “Boom” by Peter Sinn Nachtrieb; “Plaza Suite” by Neil Simon; and the hilarious revue paying tribute to the celebration of the mating game with “I love you, you’re perfect, now change” by Joe DiPietro with music by Jimmy Roberts. They buy and sell gently loved clothing up to children's size 12, maternity clothing sizes small to 3XL, and infant related items. Toys, books, games, bassinets, swings, play pens, baby gates, activity centers, changing tables, etc. All things are trendy and modern. This is not your grandma's attic.

Items can be dropped off Monday through Friday 10-6 Saturday 10-4. January through June - spring/summer clothing. July - drop offs will NOT be accepted - summer clothing sale. August through November - fall/ winter clothing items. December - drop offs will NOT be accepted - winter clothing sale.

To help us evaluate your gently loved items and ensure that your drop off evaluation goes as quickly and smoothly as possible, follow the guidelines listed here.

1. First time drop off is limited to two containers.
2. Clothing items MUST be freshly laundered and ready to hang. They MUST be free of smoke

odor and pet hair/dander. If not, they will be returned without evaluation.

3. If applicable, outfits need to be together, we will not match items for you.

4. All non-clothing items, toys, strollers, walkers, etc, must be clean and wiped down.

5. ALL items with rummage/garage sales tags will be returned without evaluation.

6. Seasonal clothing items only -

7. Client will be notified by phone when drop off is complete. Payment will not be made until items are picked up. Items must be picked up within 3 days of notification ~ items will be sold and/or donated at the discretion of Grow With Me after the 3 days. Payment is via check or store credit. Store credit is given an additional 20%.

Items we DO NOT accept include but are not limited to the following: Men and women's clothing, used socks, under garments, used baby bibs, burp cloths, stuffed animals, inflatable water toys, sun faded toys, receiving blankets, bedding, car seats.

For some women the surprise of an unplanned pregnancy can be a scary and difficult road to face. Since 2013 Dakota Hope Clinic has been here to help young women emotionally, physically and spiritually, helping to empower women to make the best decision. They provide services such as personal options education, referrals for prenatal care, pregnancy testing and limited ultrasound exams with state of the art Ultrasound equipment; by trained professionals. All services are confidential and free of charge to anyone regardless of income, race or religion.

Nadia Smetana, Interim Director at Dakota Hope Clinic, shared that many young women do not know where to go to discuss what their options are. There was a need in Minot for a central place for someone who is feeling scared and alone with an unintended pregnancy; a place where they wouldn't be told what they should do, but instead be educated on what the best decision is for them.

Kristi, Nurse Manager, provides medical testing for confirmation and dating of the pregnancy. Providing education and counseling to individuals throughout their pregnancy until their child is a year old. Clients earn points by attending educational meetings; these points may be spent on materials needed for the mother and the child the baby store. Prenatal medical care is referred to local obstetricians and

community resources.

Churches, schools and other groups are welcome to request Dakota Hope Clinic's services to provide community education for sexual health.



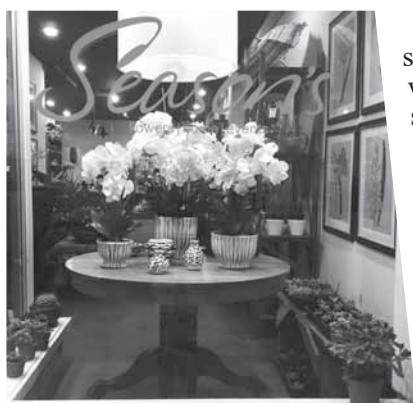
