MINOT AIR FORCE BASE, N.D. -- Special Agents from Air Force Office of Special Investigations, Detachment 813, Minot Air Force Base, North Dakota,

obtained a federal search warrant and recovered an M-240 machine gun reported missing from Minot AFB in an Airman's off-base residence Tuesday, June 19,

2018. The weapon was reported missing May 16, 2018. No further details are available while the investigation is underway.

# Holloman aircraft crash

5TH BOMB WING PUBLIC AFFAIRS

HOLLOMAN AIR FORCE BASE, N.M. (AFNS) -- An A-29 Super Tucano crashed over the Red Rio Bombing Range at approximately 11:30 a.m. MDT today during a training flight as part of the Air Force's Light Attack Experiment. One aircrew member suffered minor injuries and was airlifted to a local hospital. More information on the second aircrew

member will be released when it is available. The crash is currently under investigation, and no cause has been determined at this time. The Red Rio Bombing Range is part of the White Sands Missile Range, a U.S. Army installation and the Department of Defense's largest, open-air test range. Fire and police units from the White Sands Missile Range

Directorate of Emergency Services initially responded to the report of the crash. # Air Force Aid Society provides \$1 million grant to Air Force Enlisted Village

WASHINGTON (AFNS) -- The Air Force Aid Society announced a \$1 million grant to the Air Force Enlisted Village, June 26, 2018, to complete a \$3 million community center renovation project. The grant will be used to fund construction updates to the Bob Hope Village Community Center, which will undergo a complete interior building redesign. The 30-year-old facility has historically been used for social events, fitness and wellness programs year-round for residents. The entire Bob Hope community houses more than 430 senior residents in 350 independent living apartments.

"We are proud to support the Air Force Enlisted Village in their effort to provide quality housing for the surviving spouses of retired enlisted Air Force members," said AFAS CEO and retired Lt. Gen. John D. Hopper Jr. "Providing critical help to Airmen and their families is at the core of our mission at the Air Force Aid Society."

The Air Force Enlisted Village, formerly the Air Force Enlisted Widows Home Foundation, was created in 1967 to provide a home and financial assistance for the widows of retired enlisted Air Force members over the age of 55. In 1968, the organization was incorporated and in 1971 was granted federal tax-exempt status as a 501(c)(3) charity. Today, the Air Force Enlisted Village operates the Bob Hope Village, an independent living community, and Hawthorn House, an assisted living and memory support residence, located on the Bob Hope Village campus.

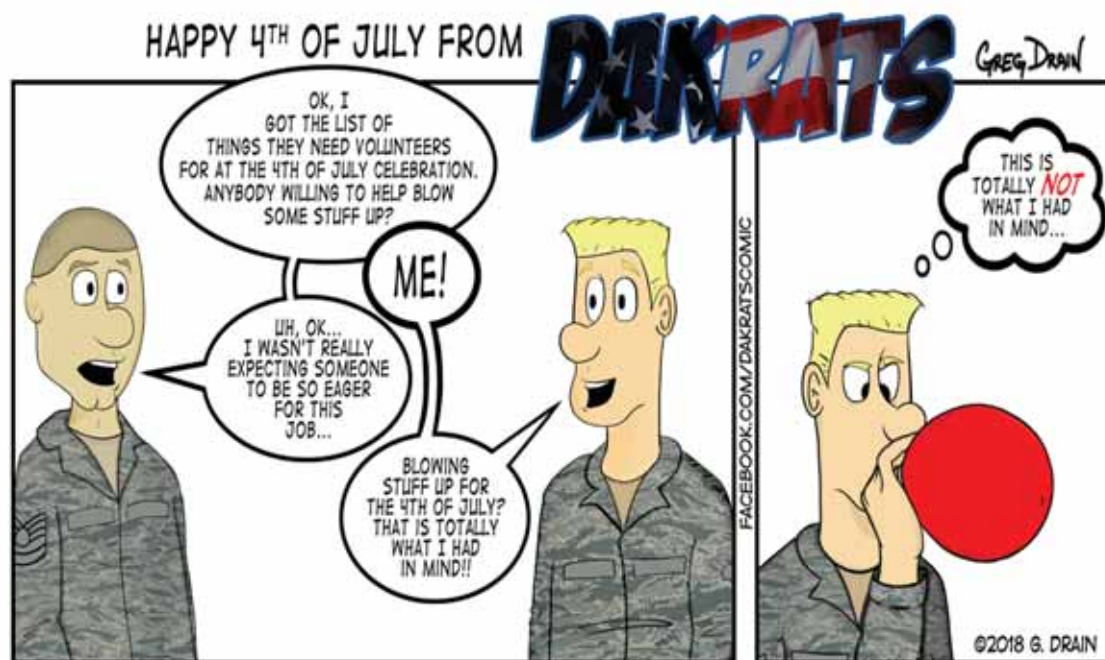
"We are extremely happy to be moving forward on the renovation of our community center. Bob Hope Commons is the hub of our

community and serves multiple functions for our residents and staff," said Air Force Enlisted Village president and CEO, and retired Chief Master Sgt. Brooke P. McLean. "For over 30 years we have gathered in the community center, and with the investment by the Air Force Aid Society, we look forward to continuing this excellent service to our current and future residents."

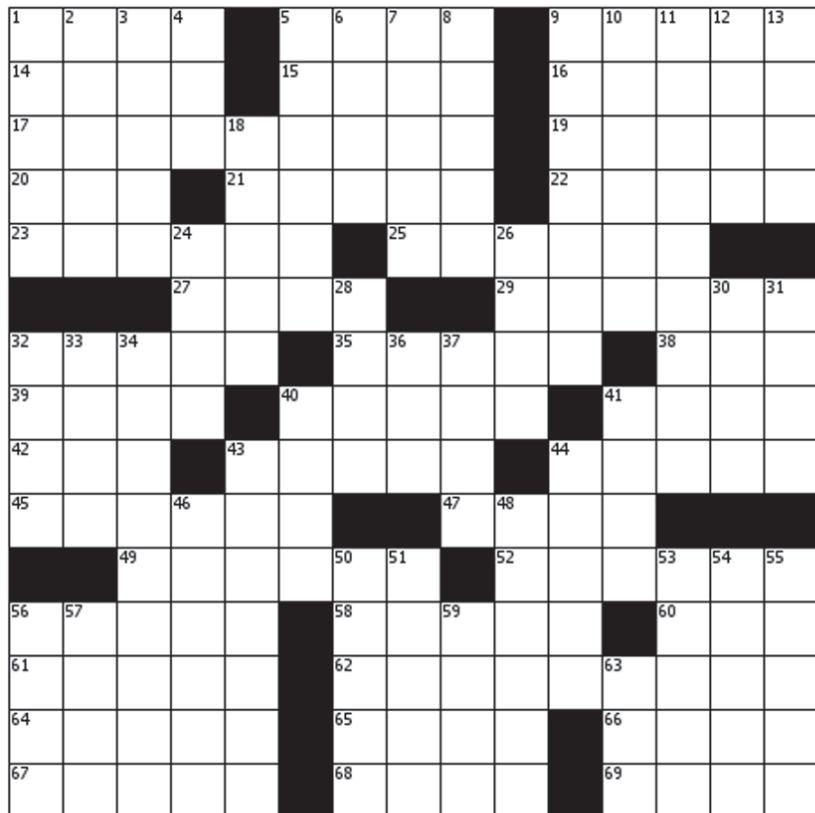

### Sweet Potato Nachos with Chicken Carnitas



#### INGREDIENTS:

- 2 large sweet potatoes sliced into 1/4 inch thick pieces
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 cups chicken carnitas
- 1 cup guacamole
- 1/4 red onion diced
- 1 jalapeno thinly sliced
- 1/4 cup fresh cilantro chopped, loosely packed

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat oven to 400°F/205°C. Place a large, oven safe cooling rack over the top of a large baking sheet. Lay the sweet potato slices across the top of the wire rack. You may need to use an additional baking sheet if there are too many slices. Make sure that the slices are not overlapping. Baking on a wire rack allows for air flow/heat to get under the sweet potatoes making for ultimately, more evenly cooked/crispy 'nachos'. Sprinkle with salt. Place in the oven and bake for 15 minutes. Take the sweet potatoes out, flip them all over and then return to the oven and bake another 10 minutes. The edges will start to pull up and crisp slightly. Remove the wire rack from the sheet. Move the sweet potatoes to a large serving platter or use the baking sheet to serve. Pile the chicken carnitas on to the top of the sweet potatoes. Scatter the onion, jalapeno and cilantro over the top followed by the guacamole.

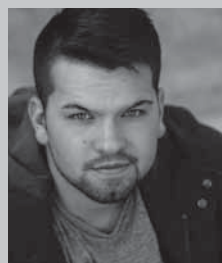

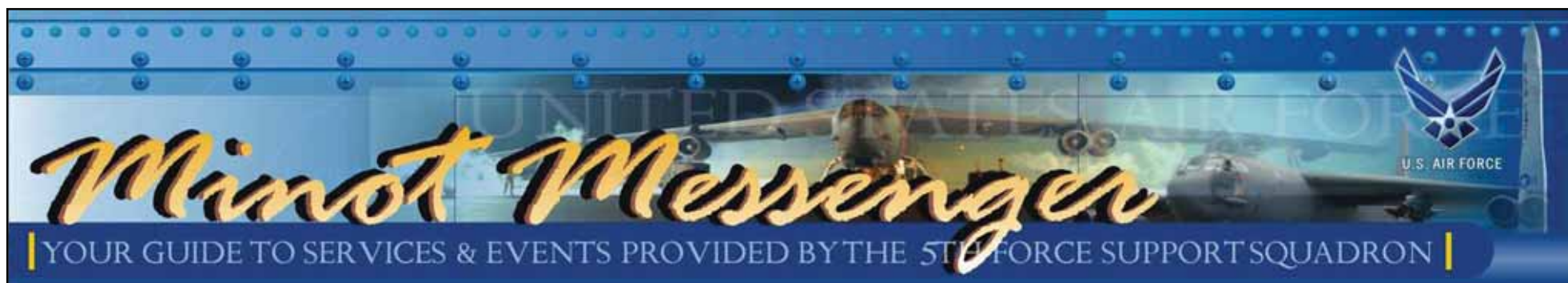

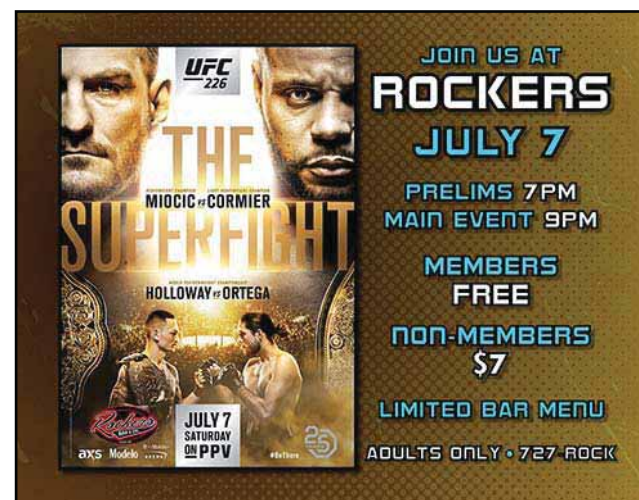

Club members receive FREE admission to the UFC 226 pay-per-view event at Rockers Bar & Grill on Saturday, July 7. Non-members price is only \$7.

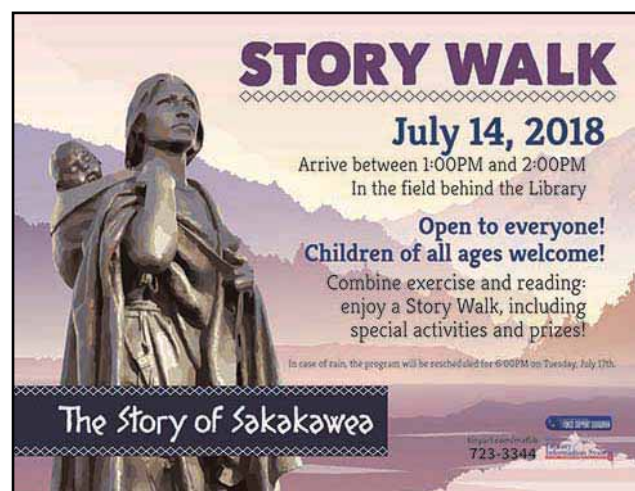

## Enjoy Whitewater Rafting & Horseback Riding Trip To Montana

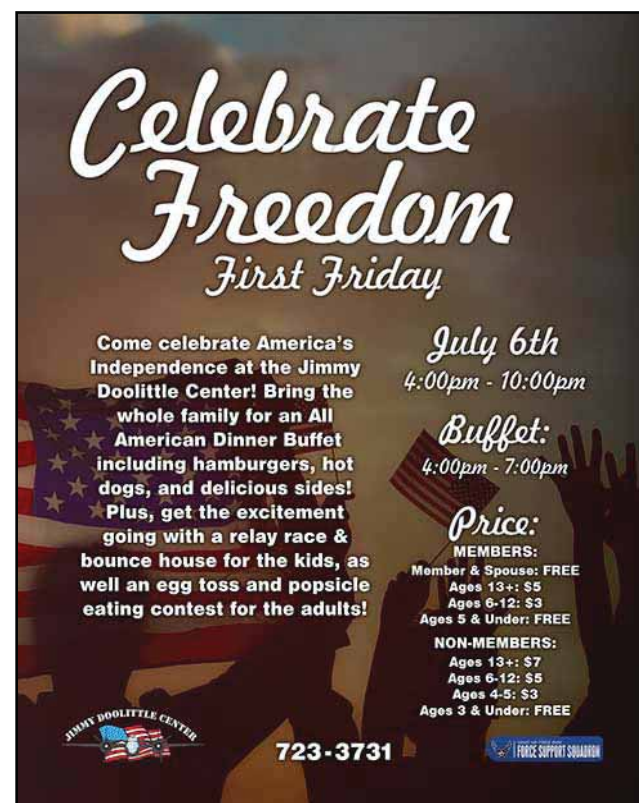
