

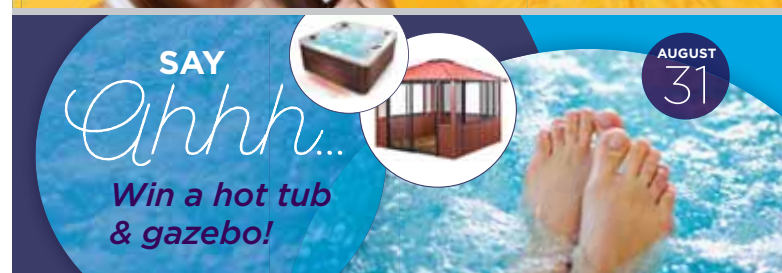


A sweet homecoming for families July 15, as nearly 200 airmen from the 23rd Bomb Squadron returned home to Minot from Guam after a six month deployment.

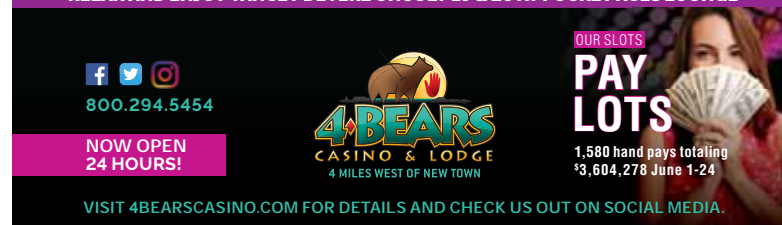

# North Dakota State Fair gears up for Military Appreciation Day

"We just love this time of year" beams Renae Korslien, North Dakota State Fair Manager. Her enthusiastic voice is teamed with a beaming smile when she talks about the 2019 North Dakota State Fair that starts its 9-day run on July 19th. For Renae this is fair #10 as the manager, but this is her 46th fair as an employee, 31 as a full time employee and she worked part-time before that. It is those years of experience that allow her to keep her hand on the pulse of an event that has 46,998 different exhibits.

Tuesday is Military Appreciation Day at the NDSF as they roll out the red carpet and welcome active duty military and dependents. "When they enter the gate they get ½ off their gate admission with a Pepsi product" explains Renae, "As Pepsi is our Tuesday sponsor". "Then there's a free Military Appreciation Beef Picnic from 11 AM to 1 PM, and free carnival rides from 1 pm to 3 pm." In addition, with a coupon (available in the Northern Sentry) military families are also able to get ½ off the Daily Unlimited Ride wrist band, ½ off adult admission to the NRPA Bull & Ranch Bronc Riding event that evening with military ID.

"But really, what we want to encourage people to see what the fair is all about. We say our motto is from Farm to Fork- a way to learn about the food we eat, and the products that come from the farm." A good way to start, according to Korslien, is a visit to the State Fair Center when they can see the crop exhibits. "If it's a hot day, the entire State Fair Center is air conditioned and a good way to take a break" says Korslien. "They can sit in Arena and watch horse shows, or other livestock shows in air conditioned comfort." But there are so many other exhibits, including machinery row with the latest in farm machinery on display. The livestock barns are teaming with activity. "On Tuesday we'll have the barns switched over to our dairy and beef shows. Then there's the sheep shows where kids can actually learn about wool and wool products. "Like me, I am sure they will be amazed at how the young 4-H

and FFA kids handle the livestock. It's really remarkable."

"The NDSF is family friendly. First of all, there are cool, shaded spots where families can just take a break." And as far as events, Korslien listed the Kiddie Land sand box area, The KidSpace near the Bunny Barn is air conditioned, "it's an exploration center for kids with hands on activities."

But those attending the NDSF will have a long list of other highlights. The Pathway to Fishing near the pond will teach kids how to fish, "down to how to put a worm on the hook" chuckles Korslien. "We have the sharks on Free Stage 5, The Fur Traders Rendezvous on the North side of the pond, Free Stage 2 has great music, and there's also an entertaining Karaoke stage for those who like that." And of special interest this year will be the unveiling of a First Issue Stamp commemorating the contribution that State & County Fairs have made over the years. That event is on Thursday, "but people may want to come back because we were chosen from all of the State Fairs who applied to host this event."

The NDSF has always taken pride in giving

people a great value for their money. Parking is always free, for those who want to return there is a weekly pass that covers all 9 days of gate admission for just \$25.00.

Or don't look for a parking spot or fight the traffic...instead park at the Dakota Square Mall - South of Penny's and hop on the free bus that runs from 1 pm to 1 am EVERY day of the fair. Drops you off and picks you up at one of the main gates. EASY!!!

So what's new for 2019? "Well when you have over 600 commercial exhibits there is always something new. And we have a new carnival this year" answers Korslien. The carnival will have a wrist band system that allows you to add credit from kiosks on the midway, similar to the larger theme parks like Disneyland.

The slogan line for the 2019 NDSF is "Where the Summer Shines". "We just want to get the word out to our neighbors to the north at the Minot Air Force Base that we do appreciate what they do, and we invite them to experience the North Dakota State Fair," says Korslien.

And oh, by the way, Renae reminds us that "Life is Fair!"

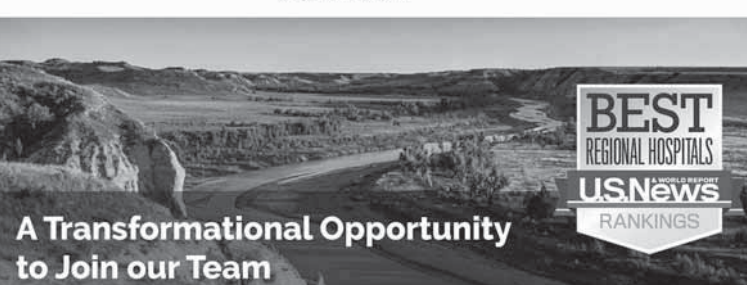

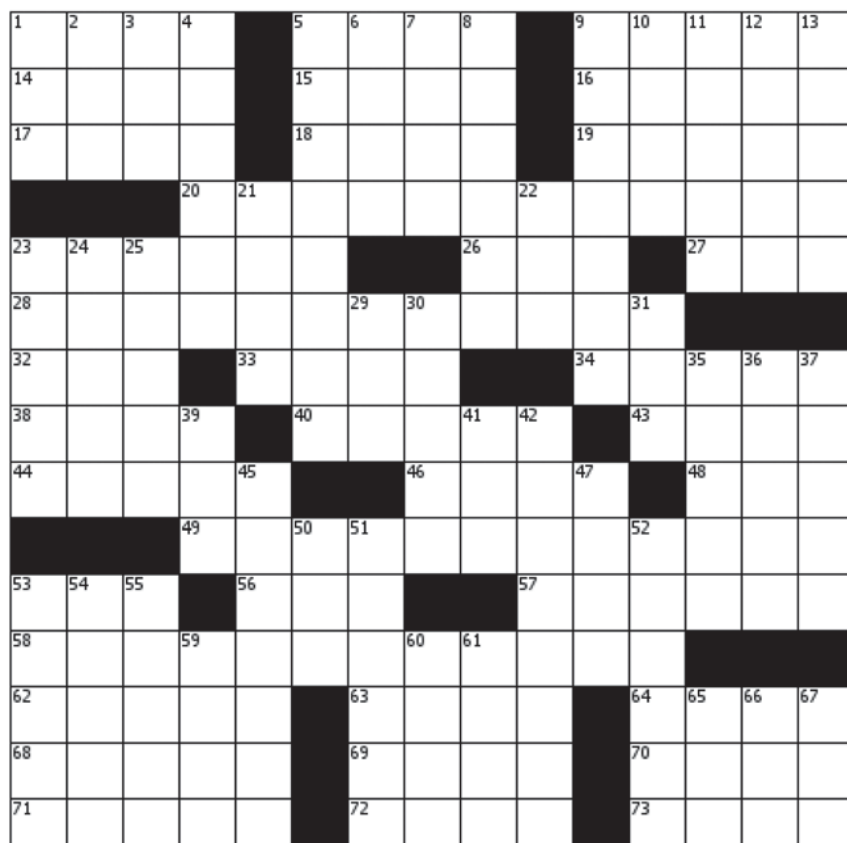

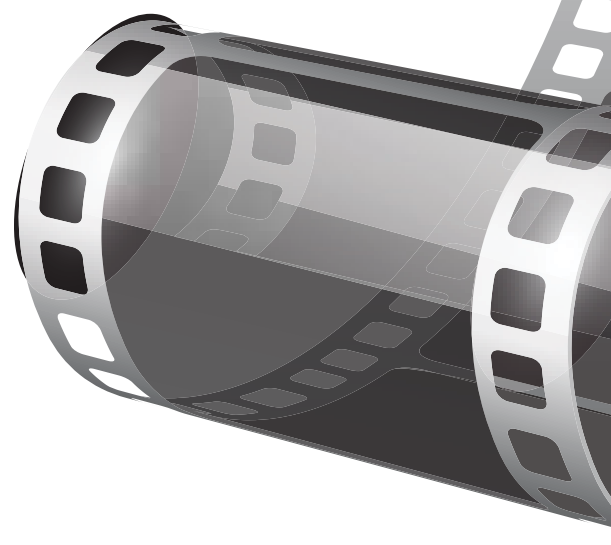

# Buffalo Chicken Pasta Salad

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 16 oz. package pasta cooked
- 1 24 oz package buffalo chicken strips cooked according to package instructions
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes halved
- 2 green onions chopped
- 3/4 cup buffalo sauce
- 1/3 cup ranch dressing
- 1/3 cup blue cheese crumbles optional

INSTRUCTIONS:

• Once the pasta and chicken are cooled, add into a large bowl with celery, tomatoes and green onions. Whisk together buffalo sauce and ranch dressing in a small bowl and pour half into the pasta, stir and then taste. Continue to add dressing until you like the flavor! (Adults may like more of a kick and kids may prefer a more mild flavor.)

• Refrigerate for at least one hour until the pasta salad is cold. Crumble over the blue cheese and serve.

Recipe Notes

• You can use any type of chicken or chicken strips! Even leftover rotisserie chicken, just chop up and let the buffalo sauce add all the flavor!

## OUTDOOR NOTES:

PATRICIA STOCKDILL

### Fishing:

Lake Sakakawea elevation, July 15, 1,852.25 feet above mean sea level (MSL); 46,300 cubic feet per second (CFS) Garrison Dam average daily releases.

Devils Lake elevation: 1,448.9 feet above mean sea level (MSL).

Stump Lake elevation: 1,449.98 MSL.

• N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: Spotty walleye success on the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Continued improving walleye success on Devils Lake with most activity around the Minnewaukan Flats. Work wind-blown shorelines for white bass, which varies daily. Goose Lake slowing down for walleye with lots of recreational boating on north-central lakes.

• Devils Lake, Ed's Bait Shop, Devils Lake: Fair to good walleye success. Try Fort Totten Bay, Golden Highway, or Stromme's Addition. Sort through for the keepers, though, with lots of small walleye. Not as much white bass activity.

• Devils Lake, Woodland Resort, Devils Lake: Continued fair to good walleye success with fish transitioning to summer mode with crankbaits or spinners and bottom bouncers with live bait. Try Fort Totten, Minnewaukan Flats, or Pelican Lake. White bass sporadic but work the traditional highways from shore. Walleye anglers also finding bass schools.

• Lake Darling, Karma C-Store, Ruthville: Lake Darling still producing a few walleye with better success in the morning. Also try Grano area. Lake Audubon slowed for walleye.

• Lake Darling, Upper Souris Nat'l. Wildlife Refuge, Foxholm: Fair walleye success although Lake Darling is starting to green up. Try Grano or Greene for the best shore-fishing activity.

• Lake Metigoshe, Four Seasons, Bottineau: Some nice-sized walleye activity with good bluegill numbers but sort through for the keepers.

• Lake Sakakawea/Lake Audubon, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Continued fair walleye success from Fort Stevenson State Park to Highway 83 on Lake Sakakawea working shallow and moving out to deeper water. Try throwing jigs and plastics or bait up towards the shallow shorelines or 12 to 18 feet along sunken humps with variety of presentations. Work deep along sunken humps on Lake Audubon for walleye, as well.

• Lake Sakakawea/Lake

Audubon, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Continued fair walleye success from Fort Stevenson State Park to Highway 83 on Lake Sakakawea working shallow and moving out to deeper water. Try throwing jigs and plastics or bait up towards the shallow shorelines or 12 to 18 feet along sunken humps with variety of presentations. Work deep along sunken humps on Lake Audubon for walleye, as well.

• Lake Sakakawea, Indian Hills Resort, Garrison: Bouncing weather patterns creating inconsistent walleye success. Try the south flats or work north shore points but there isn't much consistency to success. Look for improving success with leeches but most anglers still using nightcrawlers.

• Lake Sakakawea, Scenic 23, New Town: Walleye success slowed although anglers finding lots of non-keeper 8- to 10-inch fish.

• Lake Sakakawea, Van Hook Resort, New Town: Walleye success remains somewhat tough. Try extremely shallow pitching jigs into the trees and weeds or deep in 35 feet or more with spinners and nightcrawlers.

• Lake Sakakawea/Missouri River, Scott's Bait & Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River producing some walleye activity from boats but spotty success. Try the spillway channel or spillway inlet but nothing consistent. Good catfish success, however. Better numbers from the channel during the day. Some walleye success down river using jigs or Lindy rigs but fish are scattered. Most anglers are focusing on the spillway inlet.

Some success in the chutes for a mix of species. Look for shore success in the morning or evening casting crankbaits from the rocks. Lake Sakakawea remains inconsistent with some walleye success on the east end. Try slow death rigs with nightcrawlers or plastics. Bite is light so also try Lindy rigs. Try Riverdale Bluffs, east end of Mallard Island, Wolf Creek, 7 Sisters, or Douglas Bay. Try pitching jigs up towards shore with larger fish in the weeds in Douglas. Try 80 feet with variety of presentations for salmon from Riverdale Bluffs to Deadman's Bay. Also try the face of the dam.

• Lake Sakakawea/northwest N.D. lakes, Scenic Sports, Williston: Improving water clarity on the upper end of Lake Sakakawea with better success as far west as Hofflund Island. Lots of 12- to 14-inch walleye. Work 20 to 30 feet

with deep-diving crankbaits. Missouri River fair to good for catfish where access is available with high water elevations. Trenton Lake closed again until water recedes. No new reports from smaller area lakes.

# 10th Anniversary Celebration of Ronald Reagan Minuteman Missile State Historic Site

STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF NORTH DAKOTA

COOPERSTOWN, N.D. – Ronald Reagan Minuteman Missile State Historic Site will celebrate its 10-year anniversary of opening to the public on July 19-21. Ownership of the former U.S. Air Force property was transferred to the State Historical Society of North Dakota in December 2007. Following work to preserve and prepare the site for public viewing, the modern-day site opened to the public in July 2009.

Friday through Sunday, visitors can drop 50 feet below ground for a view of the launch control center during site tours from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. "Leave Your Mark: Oscar-Zero Anniversary Poster Giveaway" encourages missileers, maintainers, and

others connected with the Minuteman missile program to autograph special edition posters to be given away during the weekend. On Sunday, former missileer Warren Tobin will relate his Air Force experiences and his role in the preservation of the Ronald Reagan Minuteman Missile State Historic Site.

Additional weekend activities include a free film showing, a visit from a Minot Air Force Base UH-1N Huey helicopter and crew, outdoor games, walking tours, and kids' activities. For a complete schedule of events visit [www.history.nd.gov/10anniversary](http://www.history.nd.gov/10anniversary).

The Ronald Reagan Minuteman Missile State Historic Site consists of two sites telling the story of the Cold War years in North Dakota:

Oscar-Zero Missile Alert Facility and the November-33 Launch Facility. They are the last remnants of the 321st Missile Wing, a cluster of intercontinental ballistic missile launch sites that were spread over a 6,500-square-mile area around the Grand Forks Air Force Base.

The Ronald Reagan Minuteman Missile State Historic Site is managed by the State Historical Society of North Dakota. Summer hours are 8 a.m.-5 p.m. daily.

Admission is \$10 adults and \$3 youth. For more information or to arrange a group tour, contact Site Supervisor Robert Branting at 701.797.3691.
