## Telemedicine: Virtual care

Telemedicine, bringing doctors and specialty care to a screen near you.

With a new concept called telemedicine, a virtual care system, the 5th Medical Group can now help Team Minot members from far away.

"When I came here, I saw that we were lacking specialty care," said Maj. Jennifer Pippin, 5th MDG chief of medical staff. "Our patients had to travel two hours to Bismarck or five hours to Fargo just to receive treatment."

Telemedicine opens opportunities by allowing patients to communicate with providers within or across the state line to ensure those needing specialty care can receive it thanks to the DHA (Defense health agency).

"We've been working on this for the past four or five months," said Pippin. "Our first test run was on August 5th and our first group of patients on the 12th." Telemedicine will also combat

long road trips to providers which take Airmen out of the workplace for an entire duty day.

In the past, this lack of care affected the Team Minot mission by increasing patient travel funds, deployment curtailments and an increase in absence for duty.

These effects could prevent families from moving to Minot, however with telemedicine, the 5th MDG would be able to service their needs.

In the future, the 5th MDG plans on adding services such as mental health, neurology and immunizations to telemedicine.

"It wasn't until I got here that I realized what the need was, and I became very passionate about it," said Pippin. "I knew it was going to help our patients, and they would still receive quality health care."

## Sertoma Beer Fest Tickets on Sale Now



Minot, ND - Tickets for Beer Fest, an annual event sponsored by the Minot Sertoma Club, are now on sale at Visit Minot and online.





- 12 oz jalapeño peppers
- (about 12 med) • 2 cups cider vinegar, divided
- 6 cups sugar
- 2 3-oz pouches of Ball® RealFruit™ Liquid Pectin

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Prepare boiling water canner. Heat jars in simmering water until ready for use. Do not boil. Wash lids in warm soapy water and set bands aside.

2. Puree peppers in food processor or blender with 1 cup cider vinegar until smooth. Do not strain purée.

3. Combine purée with remaining 1 cup cider vinegar and sugar. Bring to a boil over high heat. Boil 10 minutes, stirring frequently.

4. Add Ball® RealFruit™ Liquid Pectin, immediately squeezing entire contents from pouches. Continue to boil hard for 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from heat. Add food coloring, if using, and skim foam if necessary.





## **Cajun Bacon**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

2 lb. Thick Cut Bacon 1 lb. Brown Sugar 11/2 tsp Cayenne Pepper

1) In a small mixing bowl, blend brown sugar and cayenne pepper and set aside.

2) Place a layer of bacon in a large disposable aluminum pan. Using a sifter, lightly dust with the brown sugar/ pepper mixture.

3) Add another layer of bacon and repeat until all bacon has a light dusting of sugar mixture. Can be done ahead and refrigerated overnight. A syrup will form.

4) Place on grill and smoke/bake at  $350^{\circ}$  for 20-30 minutes. Flip bacon halfway through and watch carefully as bacon will go from perfect to burned and ruined in a minute or two. Do not allow fat to drip onto an exposed flame

5) Carefully remove and allow sugar to cool before serving.

**Oven baking:** place bacon on a cooling rack and place rack in a lined jelly roll pan.



## **OUTDOOR NOTES:**

#### Fishing:

Lake Sakakawea elevation, Aug. 19, 1,849.77 feet above mean sea level (MSL); 46,600 cubic feet per second (CFS) Garrison Dam average daily releases.

Devils Lake elevation: 1,448.41 feet above mean sea level (MSL). Stump Lake elevation: 1,448.46

MSL. • N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: Antelope Lake slowed with blue-green confirmed. Wash equipment, stay out of the water, and keep dogs away. Clear Lake also confirmed for blue-green algae. No Missouri River System or Devils Lake reports.

• Devils Lake, Ed's Bait Shop, Devils Lake: Devils Lake Continued good for 10- to 14-inch walleye. Try 22 feet with spinners and bottom bouncers, but try other depths, as well, along the Golden Highway, Patience Point, Fort Totten, Birkland's Point, East Bay Campground, Black Tiger Bay old roadbed, or East Devils Lake east shoreline. Also try slip bobbers or lead core in deeper water for larger fish. Try deeper water for larger fish. Work windy shorelines for white bass. Pike remain elusive.

 Devils Lake, Woodland Resort, Devils Lake: Continued good for small walleye. Work 20 to 25 feet with bottom bouncers and nightcrawlers around main lakes bays and sunken roads. Look for larger walleye with artificial bait but fewer numbers. White bass throughout the lake.

• Lake Darling, Karma C-Store, Ruthville: Continued fair walleye success on Lake Darling. Some activity at Grano but no reports on success. Devils Lake OK, at best, for walleve

• Lake Darling, Upper Souris Nat'l. Wildlife Refuge, Foxholm: Lots of boat and shore-fishing but overall success is slow. Lake is also weedy. Beaver Lodge Canoe Trail is low and it's difficult to access the river from the pools.

 Lake Metigoshe, Four Seasons, Bottineau: Fair for some nice-sized walleye along with fair bluegill success.

awea/LakeAudubon, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Continued fair walleye success in 20 to 40 feet along main lake points on the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Try various presentations. Occasional salmon along the south shore but overall it's still slow. Not much for Lake Audubon reports.

6-Mile Bait & Tackle, Garrison: The east end of Lake Sakakawea slowed with weather fronts moving through but look for improving success with stable weather. Work 30 to 40 feet with spinners and nightcrawlers for walleye on Lake Audubon. Sort through small fish for keepers

• Lake Sakakawea, Indian Hills Resort, Garrison: Work deep in 40 to 50 feet for walleye with long snells and nightcrawlers. Remember to keep any fish caught from that depth. Try the south side with several 20-plus-inch fish, a matter of quality more so than quantity. Limited weekday hours.

 Lake Sakakawea, Scenic 23, New Town: Van Hook Arm slowed for walleye. Better success south around Beulah Bay.

• Lake Sakakawea, Van Hook Resort, New Town: Walleye activity slowed. Work deep as 40 feet but also move up shallow less than 10 feet with little success in between. Overall success is spotty. Move around and try a variety of presentations.

River, Scott's Bait & Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River tailrace continues producing walleye in the spillway channel and pond. Try slow death hooks and nightcrawlers or plastics. Also try crankbaits. Overall success is fair to good with best success before 11 a.m. Chutes continue producing a variety of catfish, trout, and walleye using 3-way swivels but limited salmon numbers. Limited shore success during the day with walleye activity at night casting crankbaits. Lake Sakakawea fair to good for walleye but move around to locate active fish. Try 18 to 20 feet with a morning bite around Steinke Bay, 7 Sisters, Wolf Creek, or Douglas Bay with slow death hook and bottom bouncer with nightcrawlers. Also try using Lindy presentation with slow death hook. Salmon remain spotty. Try variety of presentations with best success still around Government Bay to Deadman's but look for a move to the face of the dam in coming




