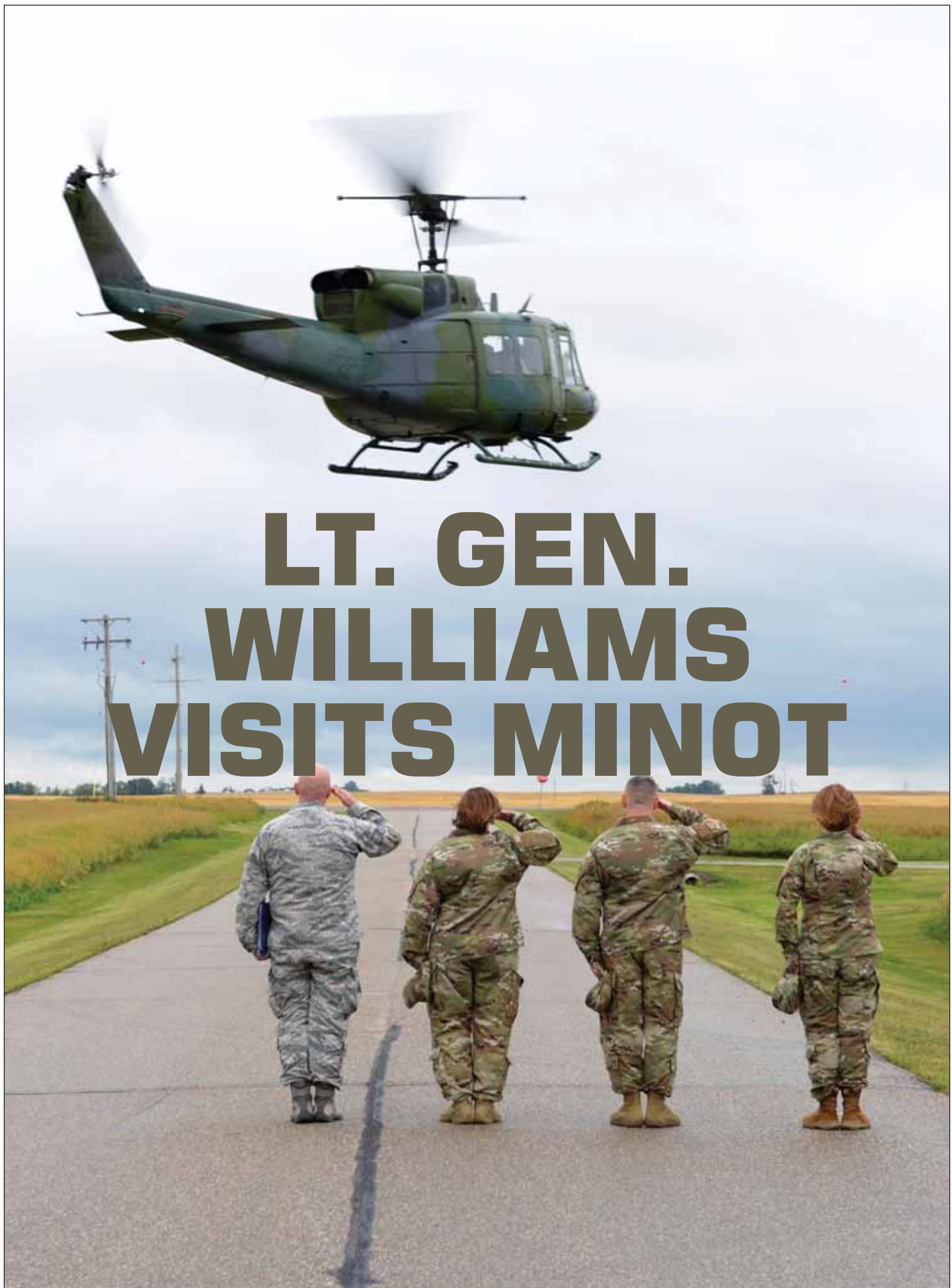

AFGSC wins Air Force Organizational Excellence Award

By direction of the Secretary of the Air Force, Headquarters Air Force Global Strike Command has been awarded the Air Force Organizational Excellence Award for the period of Jan. 1, 2016 to Dec. 31, 2017.

The Air Force Organizational Excellence Award recognizes the achievements and accomplishments of various Air Force activities and organizations. It is awarded to Air Force internal organizations that are entities within larger organizations.

"I am exceptionally proud of the hard work and contributions

our Strikers make every day," said Gen. Tim Ray, Air Force Global Strike Command commander. "We are all very fortunate to have such outstanding professionals tackling these challenges each day in such a strategic capacity, they make it look easy."

The citation accompanying the award states that Headquarters AFGSC distinguished itself by exceptionally meritorious service over the two-year period. During this time, the command

- Broadened the nation's Nuclear Command and Control Communications systems portfolio,
- Diversified global bomber

operations,

- Made significant strides in nuclear enterprise security,
- Seamlessly assumed responsibility for all E-4B aircraft from Air Combat Command
- Established the 595th Command and Control Group, meeting the Secretary of the Air Force and Chief of Staff's objective of aligning Nuclear Command and Control Communication systems under a sole authority,
- Returned the B-1 Lancer to United States Pacific Command, landing bombers on the Korean peninsula for the first time in 20 years,
- Met an emerging threat to

nuclear security by becoming the first organization within the Department of Defense to field an unmanned aircraft system detection and defense system.

Additionally, Headquarters Air Force recognized AFGSC staff as the Analytic Team of the Year for critical analysis resulting in a mission essential 60 million dollar investment in the B-52H Stratofortress brake system.

According to the award citation, "the distinctive accomplishments of Headquarters AFGSC reflect great credit upon the command's and the United States Air Force's mission."

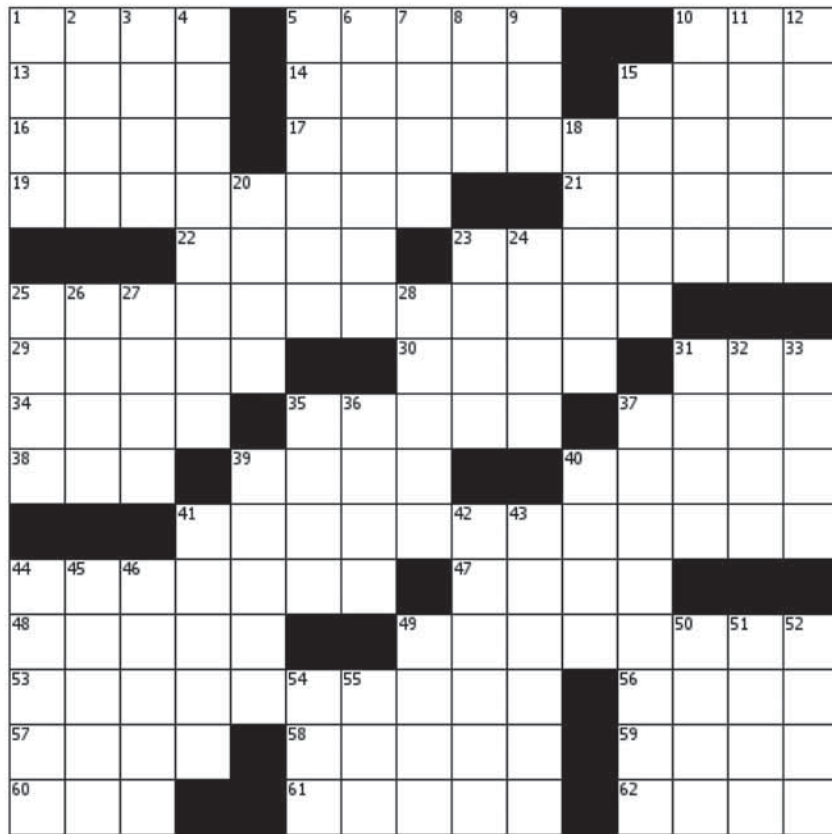

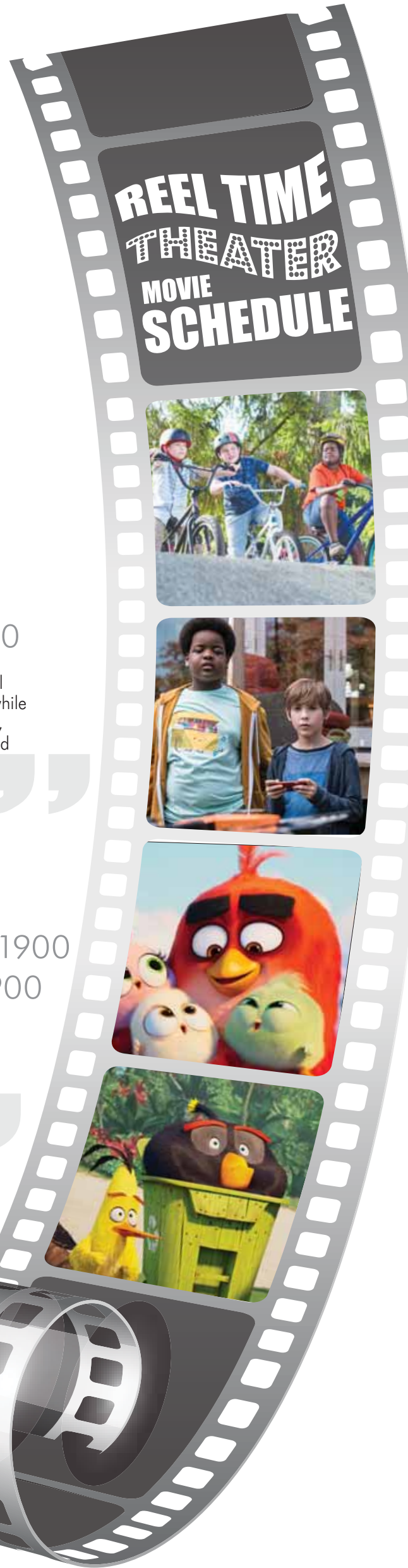

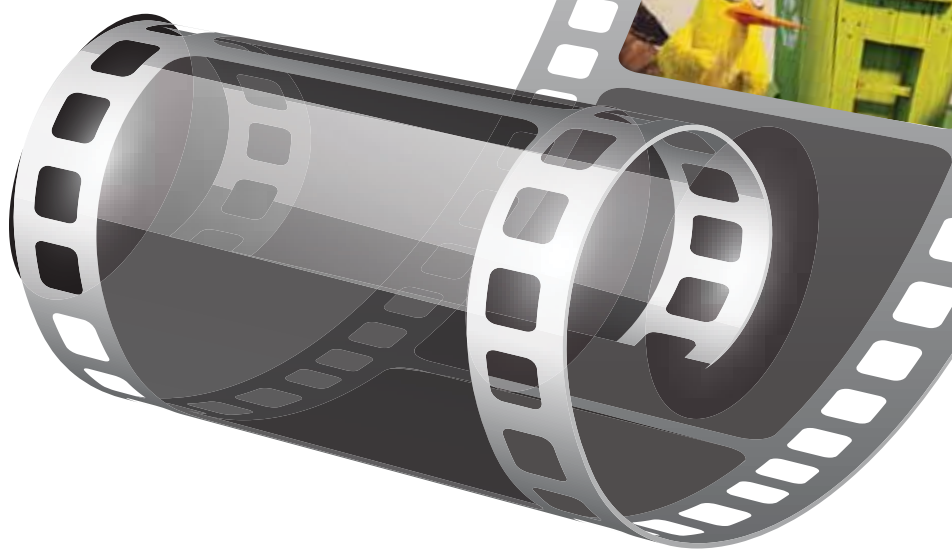

Autumn Cookies Recipe

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, softened
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 1 egg
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 3 heaping tablespoons of vanilla instant pudding mix
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- Pinch of salt
- 1/2 cup fall colored mini M&Ms
- 1/2 cup mini chocolate chips

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Pre-heat oven to 350F. Line baking sheet with parchment paper.
- In a large mixing bowl cream together the butter, brown sugar and granulated sugar.
- Beat in vanilla and egg until smooth.
- In small bowl combine flour, instant pudding mix, baking soda, and salt.
- Add to butter mixture and stir until well combined.
- Add the chocolate chips and M&Ms last and mix.
- Scoop cookies by spoonful onto a prepared baking sheet.
- Bake 10-12 minutes

Meet Miss Norsk Høstfest 2019

NORSK HØSTFEST

The title of Miss Norsk Høstfest passed to a new young lady on September 7 when Sidni Kast, 21, of Minot, North Dakota, was crowned during a ceremony at Elevation restaurant, Minot, which sponsored the pageant space, refreshments and lunch.

- N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: East end of Lake Sakakawea producing occasional walleye. Work deep. North-central area lakes generally quiet, including Lake Metigoshe. Look for catfish in deeper mid-river holes along outside bends of the Red River. Using frozen suckers or frogs. Once locating an area, anglers tend to get a couple of catfish. No reports from Devils Lake.

- Devils Lake, Ed's Bait Shop, Devils Lake: Weather pattern slowing success, especially for larger fish. Continue using spinners and bottom bouncers but sort through fish for keepers. Try leeches, if available. Work old roadbeds, flooded timber, and rocky structure in 25 feet and as deep as 40 to 50 feet. A few more pike showing up, however.

- Devils Lake, Woodland Resort, Devils Lake: Continued small walleye success using spinners and bottom bouncers with minnows or nightcrawlers. Work along the highways in 20 to 30 feet. White bass mixed in with walleye but pike remain elusive.

- Lake Darling, Karma C-Store, Ruthville: A few anglers going to Lake Darling, weather permitting, but limited reports. Try off the bridges at Grano.

- Lake Darling, Upper Souris Nat'l. Wildlife Refuge, Foxholm: Little activity with cool, wet weather.

- Lake Metigoshe, Four Seasons, Bottineau: Weather slowing activity but those going continue finding walleye success. A few bluegill from the docks.

- Lake Sakakawea/Lake Audubon, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Limited activity with wet and rainy weather.

- Lake Sakakawea/Lake Audubon, 6-Mile Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Weather permitting look for a fair walleye bite in 35 to 45 feet on the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Try jigging minnows or jigging Raps. Work the buoy line in 35 to 40 feet for walleye on

- Beware of blue-green algae, watching for discoloration on lakes and wetlands. Stay out of the water, wash equipment, and keep dogs away.
- Release any fish caught deeper than 20 feet because they won't survive coming up from deep water.
- Reminder: It's illegal to hunt waterfowl from a moving watercraft.

SRT and Full STEAM Ahead Launch Minot's First Lego League Junior Program

Minot, N.D. – SRT announced September 10th that they are supporting Full STEAM Ahead's First Lego League Jr. program for children ages 6 to 10. This inaugural program in Minot will allow even more children to get involved with Full STEAM Ahead's robotics programs. The program kicked off Tuesday, Sept. 10th at 4:30pm, which was held on the 3rd floor atrium of Swain Hall on the Minot State University campus (500 University Ave. West, Minot).

Teams of six will work together for 12 weeks and follow a curriculum based off the 2019-2020 theme called "Boomtown Builders". Each team will explore the growing needs and challenges of people in the community and try to solve a problem that makes life easier. Through exploratory research, hands-on construction, and use of LEGO elements, each team works toward building a model and creating what's called a "Show Me"

poster for a presentation at the end of the program.

Pizza Bites

INGREDIENTS

PIZZA DOUGH

4 1/2 cups Bread Flour, plus more for dusting
1 1/2 tbsp Sugar
2 tsp Instant Yeast
3 tbsp Extra-Virgin Olive Oil
15 oz Lukewarm Water

PIZZA FILLING

1 cup Mozzarella
8 oz Pepperoni cut into thin strips
1 Egg for egg wash

1.) For the Pizza Dough: Combine flour, sugar, salt, and yeast in food processor. Pulse 3 to 4 times until incorporated evenly. Add olive oil and water. Run food processor until mixture forms ball that rides around the bowl above the blade, about 15 seconds. Continue processing 15 seconds longer.

2.) Transfer dough ball to lightly floured surface and knead once or twice by hand until smooth ball is formed. Divide dough into three even parts and place each into a 1 gallon zip top bag. Place in refrigerator and allow to rise at least one day.

3.) At least two hours before baking, remove dough from refrigerator and shape into balls by gathering dough towards bottom and pinching shut. Flour well and place each one in a separate medium mixing bowl. Cover tightly with plastic wrap and allow to rise at warm room temperature until roughly doubled in volume.

4.) When ready to cook, set the temperature to 350°F and preheat, lid closed for 15 minutes.

5.) After the first rise remove the dough from the fridge and let come to room temperature. Roll dough on a flat surface. Cut dough into long strips 3" wide by 18" long.

6.) Slice pepperoni into strips.

7.) In a medium bowl combine the pizza sauce, mozzarella and pepperoni.

8.) Spoon 1 TBSP of the pizza filling onto the pizza dough every two inches, about halfway down the length of the dough. Dip a pastry brush into the egg wash and brush around pizza filling. Fold the half side of the dough (without the pizza filling) over the other the half that contains the pizza filling.

9.) Press down between each pizza bite slightly with your fingers. With a ravioli or pizza cutter, cut around each filling- creating a rectangle shape and sealing the crust in.

10.) Transfer each pizza bite onto a parchment lined cookie sheet. Cover with a kitchen towel and let them rise for 30 minutes.

11.) When ready to cook, preheat the grill to 350 F with the lid closed for 10-15 minutes.

12.) Brush the bites with remaining egg wash, sprinkle with salt and place directly on the sheet tray. Bake 10-15 minutes until the exterior is golden brown.

13.) Remove from grill and transfer to a serving dish. Serve with extra pizza sauce for dipping and enjoy!

*Cook times will vary depending on set and ambient temperatures.

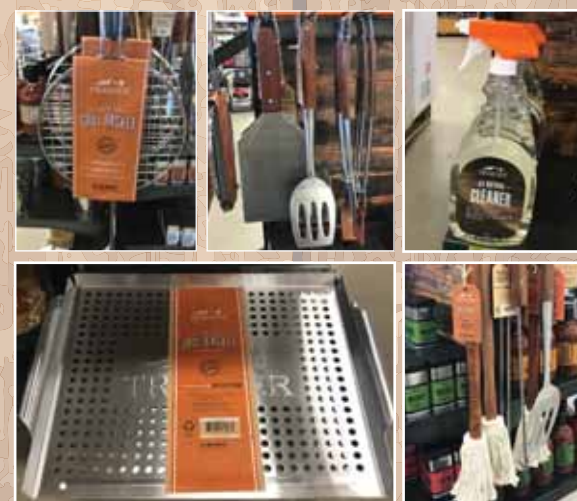

to be a part of it. To the men and women of the North Dakota Air National Guard, to the best of my ability and as long as I can, I am going to give you everything I got."

In 1993, Schulte earned a direct commission in the U.S. Air Force's Biomedical Science Corps and served three years with the 55th Medical Group, Offutt Air Force Base, Omaha, Neb. Following active duty service, he was assigned to the 934th Airlift Wing, U.S. Air Force Reserve, Minneapolis, Minn. In 1999, Schulte transferred to the North Dakota Air National Guard and served as a physical therapist and later commander of the 119th Medical Group, 119th Wing. As the senior medical officer, he supervises, directs the use of base medical resources and advises the commander on medical issues in support of the wing and the remotely stationed 219th Security

Forces Squadron, Minot Air Force Base. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in physical therapy from Chicago Medical School, Illinois, and Doctorate of Science from Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions, Provo, Utah. In his civilian profession, he's an associate professor, Physical Therapy at the University of Mary, Bismarck.

After North Dakota's general officer was welcomed, audience members bid farewell to Brig. Gen. Bob J. Becklund during a retirement ceremony and paying tribute to his 37 years of service to the National Guard. During the ceremony, Dohrmann presented Becklund with the Distinguished Service Medal in recognition of his military achievements.

"Bob Becklund is a talented pilot and a great leader. He led the Happy Hooligans through one of the most difficult transition periods in its history, and he did

so with composure and vision," said Dohrmann. "Bob is an approachable and humble leader, his top priority has always been to take care of the Airmen and Soldiers of this organization. Congratulations on an incredible career; it has been a distinct honor to serve with you."

"I can't believe that nearly 38 years has gone by so fast. "I have one simple message, and that is a message of thanks," Becklund told the audience of Guard members, family and friends. "There isn't a person in this room that hasn't had an impact on me, from my mentors to the youngest Airmen. No one gets here on their own and I am very grateful for the opportunity to serve these outstanding Airmen in the 119th Wing."

Becklund enlisted as a flight simulator technician in 1982, he received his commissioned through Airman and culminated his career as the North Dakota

National Guard Joint Force Headquarters chief of staff for Air and as the full-time deputy adjutant general for the North Dakota National Guard.

From 2004 to 2009, he served as the commander of the 119th Fighter Wing. During his command, the wing went through an unprecedented change from manned to remotely piloted aircraft. His leadership solidified the paradigm shift in the North Dakota Air National Guard, broadening the mission focus which includes intelligence, targeting and nuclear security missions, placing the Happy Hooligans at the forefront of innovation expertise in military remotely piloted aircraft operations. His counsel and leadership has been a driving force to the continued excellence of the North Dakota Air National Guard.
