# History in the making: final CALCM missile package retired

BARKSDALE AIR FORCE BASE, La. --

The sun has set on an integral component of the United States long-range strategic bombing capabilities as the final Conventional Air-Launched Cruise Missile (CALCM) package was downloaded and disassembled at Barksdale Air Force Base, Louisiana, Nov. 20, 2019.

Initially beginning design in 1974, the CALCM missile has been employed in combat operations to include Desert Storm, Desert Strike, Desert Fox, Allied Force, Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. Decades later, the final missile package was disassembled to become demilitarized.

"It's incredible to see the tail end of a weapons system come full circle," Tech. Sgt. Carlos Solorza, 2nd Munitions Squadron weapons system bay chief said during the final upload of the CALCM weapon system. "I don't think I'll ever be apart of another weapon retirement and the fact that I'm here right now is pretty special."

The CALCM missile is a small, winged missile powered by a turbofan jet engine, able to fly

complicated routes through terrain with the guidance of a GPS aided inertial navigation system.

"I've loaded this weapon system well over 300 times," said retired Chief Master Sgt. Paul LaFlame, former weapons superintendent at Barksdale. "This has been the primary weapon system on the B-52 for decades now."

Although missile design began in the mid-1970s, CALCM

wasn't employed in combat until January of 1991, during Operation Secret Squirrel, a mission in which seven B-52G Stratofortresses took off from Barksdale toward Iraqi targets, launching 35 CALCM missiles.

Opening the first strikes of Operation Desert Storm, the then-new CALCM missiles devastated Saddam Hussein's forces and marked the first time GPS has been used to guide a missile to a target.

Former members of the mission, retired Cols. Trey Morriss and Warren Ward alongside LaFlame were in attendance for the final download of the last CALCM missiles.

"It's awesome to see these young Airmen, it makes me feel young," said Ward. "It's always great to interact with young troops, they're phenomenal. It's great to see the Air Force still moving along seamlessly, with great people who still get the job done," LaFlame added.

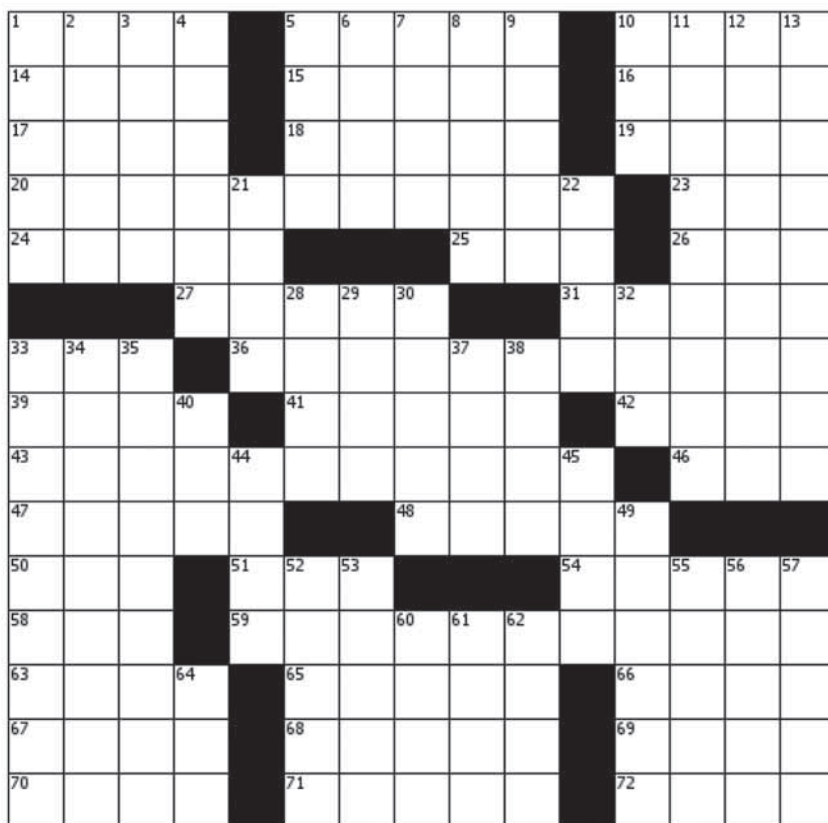

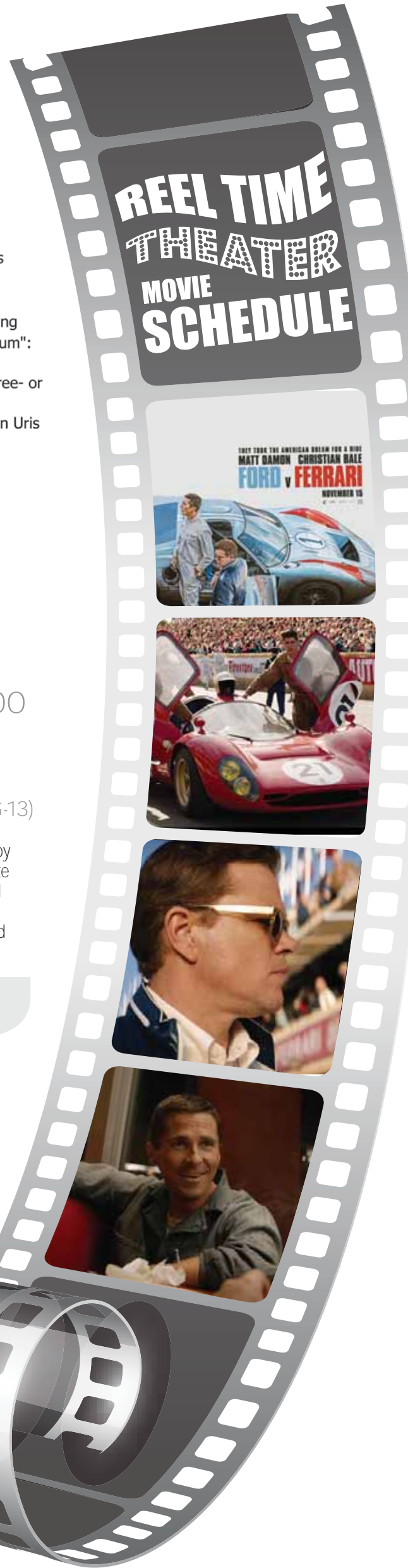

## Hunting Maniacs and Celebrating the North

Thankfully, Eider – the oldest of the two four-legged Hunting Maniacs of the household – hasn't learned how to get on social media.

Otherwise, she would probably be begging for a new hunter she could take afield.

You see, once again, her hunter let her down. Yup, oh-for-two on the lone rooster she worked so hard to entice to exit its safe harbor of thick slough grass. She was meticulous in sleuthing out its scent. She pointed.

It slithered away somewhere beneath the crunchy mass of vegetation.

She found it again. She almost caught it when it panicked and took flight.

And her hunter missed.

Twice.

There was no doubt she was on a bird. There was no doubt her hunter let her down. Again.

To add insult to injury, a couple of days earlier the youngest Hunting Maniac of the household, six-year-old Garnet, not only pointed and flushed a rooster on command, she had the pleasure of retrieving it.

Eider, the 10-year-old liver-and white Brittany, wasn't along on that trip. Thankfully Garnet, the orange-and-white Brittany, didn't flaunt her bird upon her return, so Eider didn't know she missed out on a retrieval opportunity.

However, one of the joys of life in North Dakota is the length of its upland game bird season. With sharp-tailed grouse season opening in early to mid-September and pheasant season in early October, there are opportunities to get the Hunting Maniac's afield by the time seasons close in early January.

And that doesn't even include waterfowl hunting from September into December for some species,

Plus, the Sept. 1 dove season opener gives them a chance to develop patience sitting with their hunter among dove decoys, a few barren tree limbs, and a splash of water.

However, there again, Eider is often tempted to learn how to get on social media and beg for a new hunter. After all, sometimes dove

hunting can be humbling.

Or frustrating when you're Eider and her hunter doesn't hold up their end of the bargain. It's easy to read her mind: "Look, I do my job...I find birds when we're grouse and pheasant hunting. I work scent and I point. I sit patiently when we're dove, duck, and goose hunting. I retrieve. Don't forget I retrieve. You're supposed to get me something to retrieve. PLEASE."

OK, really it's not quite that bad. Her hunter – me – provides her with plenty of hunting and retrieving opportunities.

It's just that when you're Eider and Garnet, the four-legged Hunting Maniacs of the household. If things were up to them, they would be afield 24/7. In addition, being afield includes retrieving.

They both love late season goose hunting when the big Canada geese come off the open water of the Missouri River and Lake Sakakawea to field-feed. Admittedly, that's where Garnet draws the line on retrieving, though. She will find them, stand by them, and hold them down if necessary. But she appreciates it if you pick them up.

Eider will retrieve anything, including dead mice and an occasional unidentifiable object, likely something that previously was breathing oxygen. That's OK, as long as she doesn't eat it.

But that's life in North Dakota, celebrating the great outdoors in the north in a hunting family with Hunting Maniacs.

It's a lifestyle that, yes, has its ups and downs with blistering summer heat, widely fluctuating wet and dry cycles, wind – lots of wind – and winter.

Sometimes lots of winter.

Also try Black Tiger Bay for perch. Watch areas of flowing water in the feeder lakes, however, and ice depth varies across all area lakes. 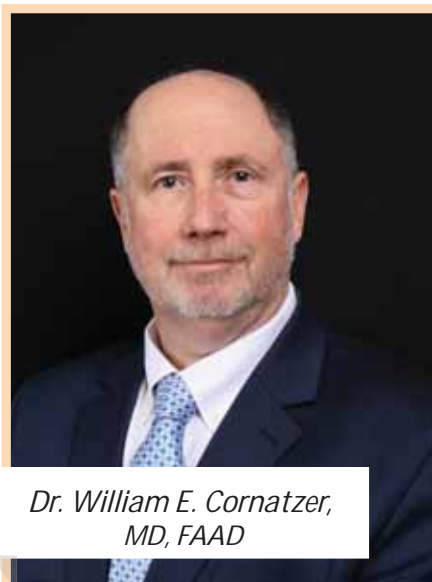

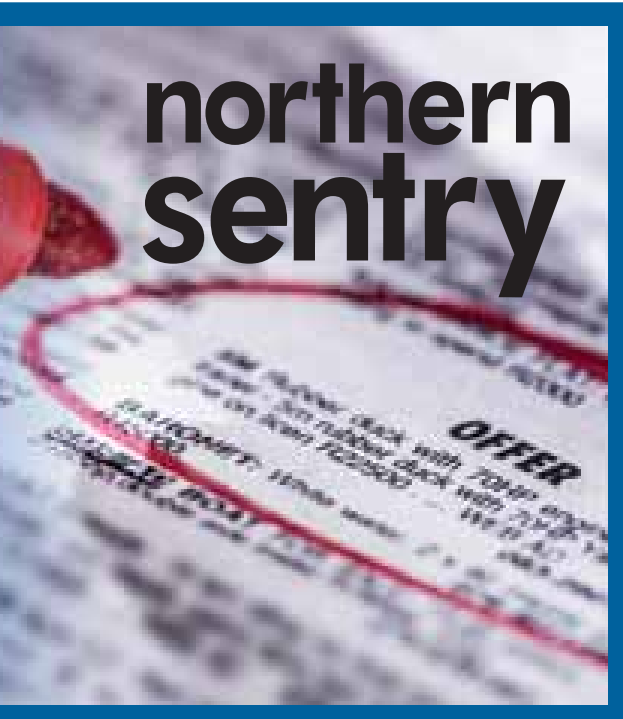

# NDCPD Contract to provide North Dakota Disability Awareness Training for First Responders



The North Dakota Center for Persons with Disabilities (NDCPD), a Center of Excellence at Minot State University, has been awarded a contract from the North Dakota State Council on Developmental Disabilities, to implement a community-based

education program to increase disability awareness within North Dakota first responders.
