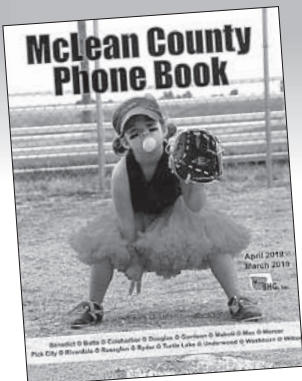

Break-ins reported at Max Post Office

The McLean County Sheriff's Department is investigating a pair of break ins at the Max Post Office last week.

According to a case report, a post office employee contacted the sheriff's department on Tuesday to report a break in and missing property.

Responding officers found that a walk-in door in a public area

of the post office had seemingly been damaged, as had 10 post boxes and three parcel boxes. According to the report, the boxes appeared to be damaged by a pry-bar or similar prying tool, with at least one box pried all the way open.

One package reportedly stolen out of a parcel box during the break-in had an estimated value of \$1,800.

A second break-in at the office

took place just two days later, with five more post boxes being vandalized.

According to the case report, a Max woman arrested last week on drug charges is being investigated in relation to the break-in, but no arrest has been made at this time. Missing items of mail from the Max Post Office were reportedly recovered in the vehicle of Nicole Rogers, of Max, though Rogers has not been charged.

Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over campaign results

134 alcohol- or drug-related arrests and citations

Law enforcement agencies across the state participated in the national enforcement campaign, *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over*, from Dec. 14, 2018, through Jan. 31, 2019, to deter motorists from driving impaired.

A total of 637 citations were attributed to the added enforcement patrols. Of the total citations, 77 were alcohol-related, of which 66 were driving under the influence (DUI) arrests. There were another 19 arrests or citations for other alcohol-related violations such as minor

in consumption or open container and 38 drug-related arrests.

Impaired driving is 100 percent preventable and stopping it can prevent tragedies on North Dakota's roads. Every driver and vehicle occupant in North Dakota can help meet the state's goal of zero motor vehicle fatalities and serious injuries by taking personal responsibility when traveling on the road. This means wearing a seat belt at all times, transporting children in child passenger safety seats appropriate for the child's age and height, driving distraction

free, driving sober (i.e. not under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs) and obeying all posted speed limits.

High-visibility enforcement for traffic safety is one element of a collaborative effort to eliminate motor vehicle deaths in North Dakota.

Add Some International Flair to Your Menus

"Wow, score!" I thought to myself as I reached for a cookbook with more than 1,600 recipes from 17 countries.

Better yet, the book was marked \$3 at the antique store, and all books had an additional 25 percent markdown that day. They were practically giving the book away.

I retrieved my phone and noted the cookbook being sold online for prices ranging from \$5 to \$40, with positive reviews.

The copyright date was 1981. That stung a little. I don't exactly consider the 1980s as antique-worthy, but my kids would.

I began paging through the book on the way to the checkout. I came across a newspaper clipping someone had tucked into the book and chuckled to myself.

The yellowed news clipping was titled "What North Dakota women look for" (in a man). The local interviews were in response to a study that showed honesty, good looks and time for family

ranked ahead of riches when women choose a mate.

Perhaps one of the women pictured in the clipping owned the cookbook. The women cited beautiful eyes, moral values, nice personality, attractiveness and ability to support himself as desirable attributes.

None of the women said "ability to cook and do dishes" as a desirable trait in a mate. They should have interviewed me.

When I set my new cookbook on our coffee table at home, I noticed my husband intently studying the cookbook. I nodded and smiled in his direction.

Food is a way to connect to your own culture as well as a means of exploring other cultures. Cooking also is a fun way to learn with your family.

Traditional recipes use the proteins, dairy, grains, fruits and vegetables characteristic of the region. Here's a little activity for you. I have listed some examples of foods from various parts of the world, but they are not necessarily arranged in menus typically served together.

Can you name the country or area of the world?

Group 1. Stuffed cabbage rolls, cooked potato dumplings, kuchen
Group 2. Tahina-cheese salad, lamb with orange and barley, lovas

Group 3. Ratatouille, brioche, crepes

Group 4. Chicken liver paprikash, blitz torte

Group 5. Peking duck, Mandarin pancakes

Group 6: Turkey in mole sauce,

Group 7: Haddock with dill, rye bread, currant cake

How did you do? Here are the answers, but keep in mind that recipes travel the world, just like people. Group 1. Germany; 2. Middle East; 3. France; 4. Hungary; 5. China; 6. Mexico; 7. Norway.

Try something new to inspire your menus with the flavors of other cultures.

Thanks to the internet, we have the world of recipes at our fingertips.

However, I still enjoy paging through cookbooks. I noted a picture-based guide to making crepes, with appreciation to "The Creative International Cookbook" edited by Charlotte Turgeon. I had promised the kids in our 4-H club that I would teach them to make crepes using my electric crepe maker. They were very successful crepe makers, and they consumed the entire batch with fresh fruit, whipped cream and a thin drizzle of chocolate sauce.

Basic Crepes

3 large eggs

1/8 tsp. salt

1 1/2 c. all-purpose flour

1 1/2 c. milk

2 Tbsp. melted butter

1 tsp. sugar (for dessert crepes)

Oil

Fillings for dessert (fresh fruit, sweetened whipped cream, pudding)

Filling for savory (chicken and sauteed vegetables such as asparagus and mushrooms with a light cheese sauce)

Blender method: Combine all ingredients in a blender. Blend for one minute.

Scrape bowl and blend for 15 seconds until smooth.

Mixer or whisk method: In medium mixing bowl, combine eggs and salt. Gradually add flour alternatively with milk. Beat until smooth, then beat in melted butter and sugar (if making dessert crepes).

Let batter stand about one hour. Add 1 Tbsp. oil to a crepe or omelet pan over medium-low heat. Heat until oil is hot, then tip oil out of pan into a container. (Alternatively, brush pan with oil.) Return pan to medium-high heat.

With one hand, pour in 2 to 3 tablespoons of batter from a large

measuring cup or other container with a spout. Lift pan above heat and quickly tilt and swirl batter in all directions so batter forms a thin layer on bottom of pan. Return to heating unit and cook until the bottom slightly browns. Slide a knife or spatula under the edge of the crepe and carefully turn with a spatula. Brown for a few seconds and slide crepe from the pan. These can be stacked. If the batter is too thick, add a small amount of milk and stir again.

Crepes have an "inside" and an "outside." The side that cooks first is the "outside" of the crepe. Flip crepe and fill the "inside" with desired fillings.

Makes 30 crepes or 10 servings. Each three-crepe serving (without fillings) has 135 calories, 5 grams (g) fat, 6 g protein, 18 g carbohydrate, 0 g fiber and 90 milligrams sodium.

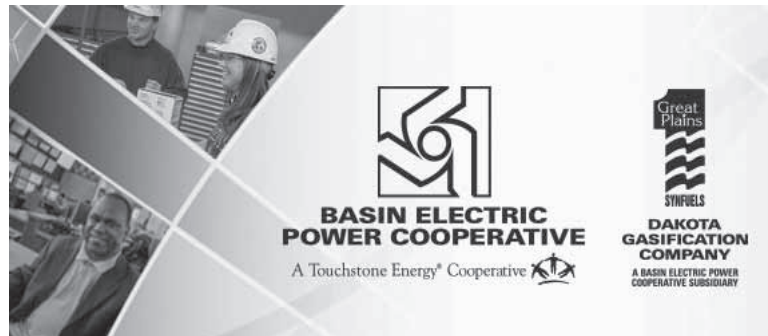

County eyes road upgrades

Two projects estimated at \$1.08M

The McLean County Commission moved forward last week with two local road projects estimated to cost a little over a million dollars total.

During the Feb. 5 county commission meeting, commissioners approved a construction maintenance agreement for a milling and overlay project on County Road 33, north of Mercer. Mike Rivinius of Wold Engineering told commissioners that final plans have been submitted, with the total cost to the county estimated at \$585,000.

Commissioner Doug Krebsbach made a motion to approve the North Dakota Department of Transportation construction maintenance agreement. Barry Suydam provided second and the motion passed unanimously.

County Auditor Les Korgel said the commissioners retained the right to refuse bids if they came in too high.

Commissioners also gave

the green light to advertise for another road project, set to take place near Falkirk. The chip sealing of County Roads 22 and 29, along with the Falkirk Mining Road, was estimated to cost the county \$493,858, with \$83,594 covered by Falkirk Mine.

Krebsbach and Suydam motioned to advertise for bids and scheduled a bid opening for March 19 at 9 a.m.

Rivinius said the combined cost to the county for both projects would be around \$1,078,858.
