Gardening Tips

An exotic hedge

Each spring the greenhouses bloom with tropical hibiscus. They make great pot plants, blooming like mad all summer long. Some people bring them in, in the fall where they will continue to bloom on the buds formed outdoors. They may start blooming again in the spring if cared for properly. However pretty as they are, wouldn't be nice if you could just leave them in the garden in the fall and have them pop up again in the spring. You can, you know, if you get the hardy types. Unlike the tropical's, the hardy hibiscus can top 6 feet. The blooms are huge, commonly 8 to 12 inches across. And the colors! They come in shades of red, rose, lavender, and white often with contrasting edges and "eyes". The petals can be ruffled, overlap or look like pinwheels. Like their tropical cousins, the flowers only last a day, but once they start to bloom the buds just keep coming until frost puts an end to their season.

Gardeners usually buy hibiscus in pots, but seeds are available for the DIY gardener. Hardiness has been limited to the southern part of the state so far, but now with climate change and good mulching they should manage our middle of the state winters too. Don't panic if you don't

see sprouts when other winter hardy plants are starting to pop up. They are usually 2 to 3 weeks later than most perennials.

Now about that hedge. Can you imagine them as a back drop for your shorter perennials? Even the shorter 3 footers are taller than most of our usual summer bloomers. For a large mass planting, space them about 18 inches apart. If you want bushier or more spreading plant, leave 3 feet from the middle of one to the middle of the next. For a bushier plant, pinch an inch back from each growing tip when it is about 8 inches long. If you have leggy mums, pinch them back about July 4, when you thin your apples.

These plants aren't fussy gals. They do like a mildly acidic soil, so add a bit of soil

sulfur or peat moss to the soil before planting them. They also like ample organic matter and moisture. They actually will grow under either dry or moist conditions. Because they are moisture tolerant, they are a good choice for rain gardens. They become more drought resistant once they have become well established. They do like a bit of fertilizer as other flowering perennials do. Don't feed them again in mid-summer unless the leaves are a lighter green than they should be.

Although the snow has finally melted and you are itching to get outdoors and do something, DON'T RAKE!! Probably the yard is a mess, full of branches, all the treasures the dog dragged home over the winter and other assorted debris. Go ahead and pick it up but leave the rake in the shed. Until you can sit or if you are fussy, kneel on the lawn and not get wet, don't rake the grass. All you do is dig holes in the soil giving weeds a place to sprout and uprooting your grass. If you must fertilize, either water the grass or do it just before a rain. Corn gluten meal is an organic way to kill crabgrass and add nitrogen to your soil put this on when the daffodils just start to color up and again when the lilacs first show color. This is an easy way to tell when the soil is the proper temperature for weed seeds to germinate. Enjoy the cooler weather. Sweaty work days are coming.

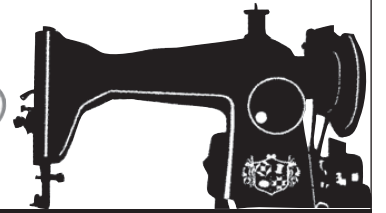

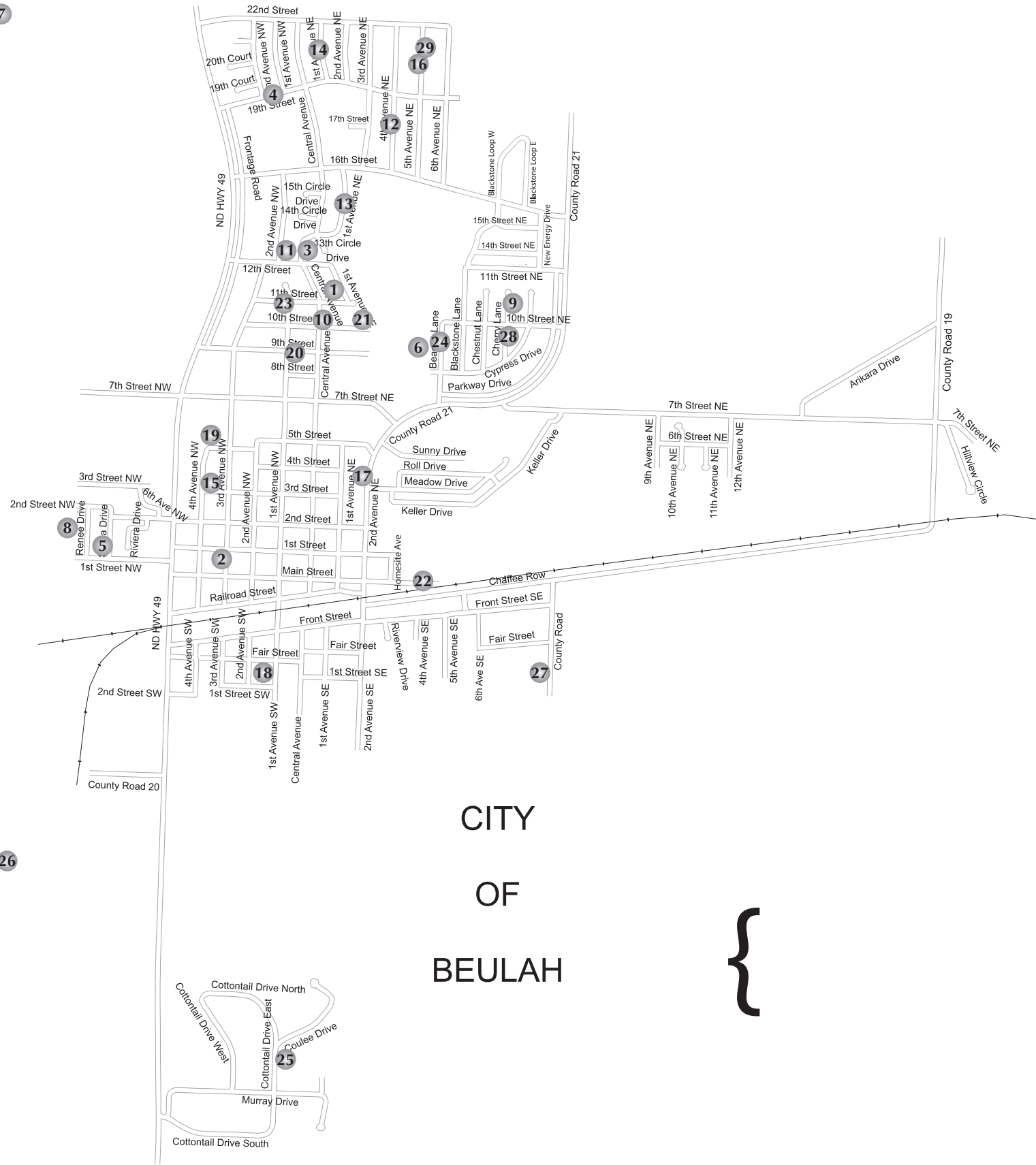

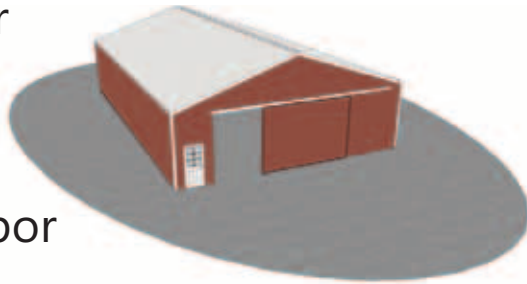
