# Lauderdale of North Dakota, Zip to Zap

In 1969 North Dakota wanted to host spring break. An article was written in the The Spectrum newspaper, a paper distributed by North Dakota State University. This article made waves and was nabbed by the Associated Press and spread throughout the U.S.

The North Dakota springbreak event was to be "Zip to Zap a Grand Festival of Light and Love.'

It is estimated that 2,000 to 3,000 college students made their way to the little town of Zap. As the alcohol and food began to deplete so did the attitudes of the temporary "springbreakers".

The event became a riot and the National Guard was alerted to help Zap and Mercer County remove the college students from the area.

The students were woken by guardsmen with bayonets that went tent to tent waking the hungover students and urging them to get moving. It was said that beer cans were piled high throughout Zap and that too, is something people came to see - to witness the aftermath of what was a historical moment in North Dakota's history.

### THE LEAD UP TO ZIP TO ZAP, 1969

Editor's note: These are excerpts from local newspapers in 1969

"Located in the valley of the scenic Knife River, Žap has thrown open its arms to students. The beautiful burg's 250 residents welcome us to their shores. Shall we say no to this truly fine gesture of western hospitality? Of course not. On May, 10, we and students like us from all over the Midwest will flock to Zap, the Lauderdale of the North ("Where did you get your suntan, Miami?" "No, Knife River").'

"Hunger may be kept at bay by stopping at the Zap cafe. Headlining the menu is the Zap Burger (I swear that's the name) for only 40 cents. Juke box music at the cafe is particularly exciting. Some of the town favorites on the juke box are Heartbreak Waltz, Swinging Benny Polka naturally recorded by Swinging Benny and his polka band, Cousin Tizzy and the Jolly Huntsman." "An honest-to-God rock dance featuring the Outcasts from Minot is scheduled for that Sautrday night. In addition to these events, a full program of orgies, brawls, freakouts and arrests is being planned. Do vou dare miss it?" "Our kids in North Dakota are a lot different from those who come from the heavy populated areas. Our kids are out for a good time and a good time to them means a beer bust, laughter, songs and what have you, not destruction. We believe that by opening our town and hearts to these young adults who just want to get away from the college grind for a few days, we will make some long and lasting friendships that profiteering rest camps have never or will ever make."

'Nothing has changed in Zap - not prices... not attitudes ... nor our belief that young people are the hope for tomorrow.'

"The gravity of the situation multiplied since student organizers at North Dakota State University say they are not planning to bring their own, but rather looking forward to the 'ocean full' of suds promised them in a letter from Zap Mayor Norman Fuchs."

"Zap is going to run out of beer! From an informed source





close to the pulsebeat of activity in Zap, The Forum learned that the town's two bars are being too conservative in preparing for the thousands of thirsty college students who are going to zip into Zap Saturday. 'We've got a couple of deadhead bartenders. They're just not stocking up,' informed source said. Does it really (gulp) look serious?'

"Zap mayor, Norman Fuchs, at first was quite concerned by the posibility of an influx of students. But now he and the city's 250 residents are getting into the spirit of things and are welcoming students to Zap and offering them the use of their sleeping facilities. (a small town park)."

An adult and kid treasure




