

#### The epsom salt myth **BY CALLA EDWARDS** MCLEAN CO. EXTENSION AGENT Epsom salt does not prevent blossom end rot; it promotes it. Many of us have a few tricks we've developed in growing a great garden. One trick is to put a scoop of Epsom salt into each

hole when planting tomatoes.

Some gardeners swear it prevents blossom end rot. It's time to debunk that myth. Epsom salt doesn't stop blossom end rot-it

leads to more of it. Blossom end rot is caused by a deficiency of calcium. Epsom salt contains magnesium sulfate—no calcium at all. Adding Epsom salt to the soil may create more rot since magnesium and calcium ions compete for uptake into the plant. The more magnesium in the soil, the less chance that calcium will be absorbed.

Blossom End Rot occurs due to wide fluctuations in the availability of water in the soil which causes an underdeveloped root system that is unable to get enough calcium from the soil. It could be watering followed by a dry spell and then a heavy application from a rain event or overzealous irrigation that flushes into the developing cell tissue, causing the rupturing of the developing cell walls. This leads to the rot we see on the blossom end of the fruit. Because the water gets there before the calcium does to be a part of a stronger cell wall, the BER develops. It also can be caused by root damage from too aggressive cultivation around the base of the plants. Blossom End Rot is tied in with some tomato varieties being more susceptible to this abiotic problem than others. In my garden, the paste tomatoes used in making salsa tend to be more susceptible to Blossom

So what can we do to prevent blossom end rot?

- Don't focus on the soil. Most
- soils in ND have plenty of calcium. Focus on watering. The
- uptake of calcium depends on the uptake of water.
- Irrigate regularly. Avoid the extremes of waterlogged soil and droughty soil.
- Mulch to maintain consistent levels of moisture in the soil.
- Cultivate shallowly. Don't damage the roots of your vines. We need these roots to absorb
- · Avoid overfertilization, especially with ammoniacal nitrogen fertilizers (ammonium nitrate and most complete fertilizers such as 10–10–10). Ammonium competes with calcium for uptake. Calcium nitrate is a better choice.





not lush. Lush vines are more likely to suffer rot since actively growing leaves take calcium from the vine before the fruits get it. As a general rule, don't side dress a vine until after its first fruits set. Adding extra fertilizer prior to this encourages extra shoot growth and can slow fruit set or bloom time.

It is important to prune your tomatoes to encourage more fruit and less green growth. Determinate tomatoes are also called "Bush Tomatoes" while Indeterminate tomatoes are the varieties that continue to grow potentially up to 10' tall!! To properly prune an indeterminate tomato, prune all suckers from the ground level up to the second flower cluster. Pinch suckers that grow at the base of leaves or where stems connect to the main plant on your determinate tomatoes to the second flower cluster as well to encourage fruit set. Pruning tomatoes encourages larger fruit production at the top of the plant. It also opens up heavy, dense foliage at the bottom of the plant, allowing for better air flow between plants. The open canopy discourages insect and disease populations. Many people are under the impression that suckers do not produce fruit. This isn't so. But by removing the bottom suckers, you remove the fruit that would weigh down lower branches and rot on the



ground. Look for the circles in the picture to show where the suckers grow on your tomato plant.

Calcium sprays might (or might not) help. Mix 4 tablespoons of calcium nitrate per gallon of water. Spray fruits, not leaves, two to three times a week. The key time is when tomatoes are dime-sized or smaller.

With proper watering and care our tomatoes, peppers, squash and other vegetables will be happy and productive throughout the summer. Just a reminder that our office will be closed for the McLean County Fair June 14th, 15th and 16th. 
