The Garrison Diversion Conservancy District will be offering approximately 1,558.8 acres of hayland on the McClusky Canal to the highest bidder during a competitive open bid auction to be held at **10 a.m. on June 11, 2019**. The bid auction site is the McClusky District Field Office located 3 miles west of McClusky, North Dakota immediately south of Highway 200. Thirty individual fields will be bid and hayed separately. Actual figures are subject to change before the bid date.

No haying will be permitted before July 15 or after August 15 and the bales must be removed by October 15. Payment must be received at the date of auction. A taxpayer ID or Driver's License# is required. Bids will be accepted on a per site basis. Minimum bid price is set at \$10 per site and minimum raise of \$10 per site. Bluegrass festival next weekend

For the 29th year in a row, Cross Ranch State Park will be filled with the sound of string plucking and harmonica as the annual bluegrass festival gets underway.

The 29th annual Missouri River Bluegrass Festival is set for June 14 and 15 at the park, with local band Cotton Wood hosting.

Also on the lineup for the event is The Little Bluestems, a family band out of Elgin.

Headlining the festival will be the Clay Hess band and the Edgar Loudermilk band.

Events kick off Friday with both headliners performing in the evening. There will be jam sessions following the concert, with musicians and vocalists welcomed to play together into the night.

Saturday kicks off with an open stage at 10 a.m., with any performer welcomed to step up.

"Anyone is able to perform on the stage with sound and we encourage folks to come out and do some music or gather some friends to play," Organizer Jill Wiese said.

At 11 a.m., the Center Community band and the Pfliger sisters will perform for an hour.

From 1-3 p.m., both headlining bands will lead a free "Learn a Bluegrass song" workshop.

"To get to sit down with such amazing musicians and singers from across the U.S. this year, Alabama and Ohio and learn a couple of songs over the weekend is just priceless," Wiese said.

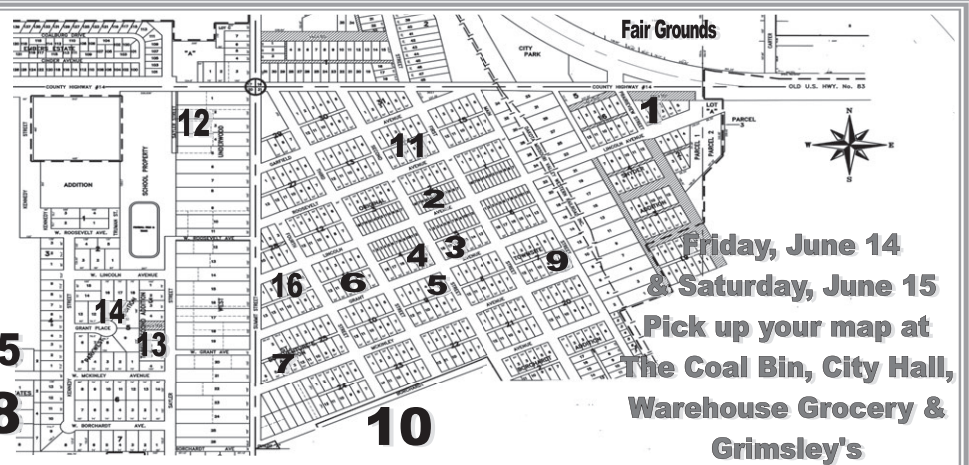
Saturday afternoon is full of music with The Little Bluestems, Cotton Wood and Kristi Goldade.

Gardening Tips

Seeds, the gateway drug to gardening

The tulips are in full bloom and the woodpeckers are drumming on anything they can find that makes noise, including Bunkey's drain pipes. The hummers and orioles are back. It's spring! No matter if it's raining, blowing or cold, this is the time of year a gardener's mind turns to fresh lettuce, corn on the cob, tomatoes warm from the garden, crisp radishes and color. This means buying seeds.

Like the best vices, seed packets offer excitement, gratification and the

desire for more. And naturally, with gratification comes shame and buyers regret; the self-loathing that comes of having too many and then buying more. The temptation is everywhere, in the grocery store, the big boy's toy store, the drug store, and the local nurseries. Then the web sites and catalogs that offer dozens of heritage tomatoes with names like Striped Stuffer, Amish Gold Slicer, Black Plum and Bloody Butcher. People with this vice have been known to, in a ditch, armed with only an envelope discovered under the car seat, collect dried up flower heads in the hope that they will grow in their wild flower garden.

To the unaffected, seeds may seem like nondescript black bits only

distinguishing themselves when they bloom, or a row of radishes pops up where they have been planted. But look closer. Look at a head of dry hollyhocks seed pod. It's a doughnut shape full of papery discs. Or a poppy. The seeds are tiny black spheres. In a mix of flower seeds, most any gardener can pick out zinnia, marigold and calendula[i] seeds by their shape. But as with all pleasures, this one is complicated. The seeds must be properly planted then cared for. The planter must not overlook the packets' stern warnings about overcrowding, damping off, proper cooling, scratching the seed, planting in damp soil, or spacing with say, planting seeds 2 inches apart.

Then of course, where to plant the

seeds. This leads to a collection of pots. Clay pots, plastic pots, glazed pots and naturally, several sizes of each. Then, where to place the pots, sun, shade, a mix? Or if you are planting in a garden, should the rows run north and south or east and west, (the latter naturally). Should the gardener add peat, nitrogen, all purpose fertilizer or none (do a soil test, dummy).

Then there is addict's reward. The planters are lush with blooms. In the garden the corn is 6 feet tall, the lettuce is thick with red, green striped, curly and straight leaves, the melons are full of delightful smelling fruit. Every tomato bush is covered with red, green, purple, who knows what color, tomatoes. All is well in the gardener's world.
