bore. What we knew about that we heard from the guys who made it back. And that was a mixed bag of news. There were the guys who admitted to being scared most of the time and the adrenaline junkies who loved all the more the worse it got.

When the promotion list came out, my superiors couldn't believe it. I was doing the work for someone two to three pay grades above me. They said, "How do you screw that up?" I said, Well, I guess you'd have had to be there." I went back up a few months later, same lady Major. This time, she asks, "How long have you been in the Amy, Sergeant?" I was already a Sergeant but only an "acting" one because they had to put stripes on me so I could do the jobs they sent me to do. I smiled at her and said,

"Ma'am, I have 60 days left." She asked if I would be reenlisting. I smiled, gave myself a treat, although it would cost me, and said, "There's no way I see that happening. Ma'am."

Back at the fort, when the list came down, the superiors looked, and said, 'Guess we'd have had to be there. Right?"

Simple point. We survive in spite of goofy leadership because many of the people who serve us continue to do their duty as long as they're signed on to do it and are untouched by the games. You have the job, you get the money, just do the work.



# Stanton gears up for celebration

It's the second year of the Two Rivers Festival, and the hope is to build upon the successes of last year's event.

In 2018, Stanton held its first Two Rivers Festival, a revised version of the traditional Knife River Days event held annually in the city. The festival, which runs the first weekend in August, is one of the largest events of the year for the small town.

There is one major difference from last year's event, however. This year, there won't be an "Old Man and Kid" fishing derby Sunday. Although that derby has never been officially part of the festival, being its own event, it has for many years been held the same weekend.

'While [the festival] is pretty much the same, they're not having the fishing derby this summer, which is kind of sad," Wanda Knutson, one of the organizers of the Two Rivers Festival, said.

As usual, the Saturday festivities begin bright and early with a 7:30 a.m. walk/run starting at the Stanton Park. Throughout the morning after the walk, there will be a bake

sale put on by Our Savior's Lutheran Church from 9 to 11 a.m. and a horseshoe tournament at the park from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

"The horseshoe event is a pretty good thing for those that follow the circuit," Knutson said.

At 10:30 a.m., kids can gather along Main St. (Harmon Ave.) for the annual bike races. The kids are divided into groups based on their age.

'The kids look forward to bringing their bikes to the races," Knutson said. "Most of them wear their helmets, and that's a good thing."

Starting at noon, there will be inflatables at the city park, while the ranch rodeo begins at 1 p.m. at Two Rivers Arena, including both kids and adult

"That's something we started doing last year,' Knutson said. "That's pretty entertaining.

From 2 to 5:30 p.m., another recent addition to the event, the Garden Tractor Pull, will be held at the Pad, west of County 37. Knutson said it is surprising how many people get involved in putting that on, and said she is pleased with how well the event has been received.



There will be minnow races at 2:30 p.m., followed by a BBQ Beef meal at the Stanton Civic Center from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m. The parade lineup starts around 5 p.m., with the parade itself at 6, and Knutson said she hopes some of those involved in the tractor pull will also join the parade.

In the evening, a bingo tournament starts at 7 p.m., ending shortly before

the start of the free street dance on Harmon Ave. at 9 p.m. This year, the entertainment for that concert will be provided by Boom-

"We're looking forward to that, and see what kind of performance they provide," Knutson said, adding Boomtown is a new band for the event. "They play oldies and some of the new stuff, and a little coun-

try. But really it should be a good variety."

The event concludes on Sunday with an all-denomination community church service at Leon's Place next to the civic center at 10:30 a.m., followed by a potluck at the same location at 11:30 a.m.

'Come out and support the community," Knutson said. "Come out and just have a good time."




