

Pastor Tom's farewell to Mercer County

"I don't want people to misunderstand...God called us there, that's the only way I can describe it," said Pastor Tom Olson at the thought of leaving his congregations.

Tom has been a pastor for 10 years in Beulah. Throughout the last decade, his work has primarily been focused on Golden Valley, Dodge and Zap churches. Although he is well known throughout Mercer County as a pastor, farmer, rancher, friend, coach, referee and

Tom was 34 years-old when he was called to ministry. He grew up farming with his parents, and when his father went into ministry, he took over the family farm. Just one year later, Tom married his wife Beth, and they began farming together in 1999.

Soon enough, Tom felt the call from God also, just as his father did. However, he began to struggle and said he often asked God if He had the right man. "I like farming. I enjoy it, and He just gently told me 'I don't ask you to understand, just trust me, Tom'," said Tom.

Tom sold all his farming equipment and tools,
packed up his then family of six (Isak, Kelvin, Kiana and Josiah) and moved to Plymouth, Minn. to attend seminary school – Association Free Lutheran Theological Seminary (AFLTS) in 2006.

Tom knew the Bible; he had preached a little and taught Bible school, so he thought he was well prepared for seminary school. Tom said he was very mistaken with that thought.

"You learn how to create good patterns of studying... it was a fantastic time to learn and grow," said Tom. While in seminary school, he and Beth had their fifth child, Karina.

Come March 2009, Tom was assigned an internship in Mercer County, which spanned four churches: Prince of Peace, Beulah; Immanual Lutheran, Zap; Golgatha Lutheran, Golden Valley and St. Paul, Dodge.

His family of now seven packed up their things and started the move to Beulah. Upon arriving Tom said there were people from Beulah, Zap, Golden Valley and Dodge all awaiting their arrival to help them move, unpack and feed them. "We instantly knew we were in a good place," said Tom.

Once in Mercer County,
Beth gave birth to their sixth
child, Jana. Partially through
Tom's internship in the area,
a retirement was announced
for the Golden Valley Parish
and Tom was approached
if he would be the new pastor. However, he had to wait
until his internship was com-

In March of 2010, Tom eagerly accepted their request to be their pastor. Tom said the communities have always been so generous and kind to him and his family. "We've lived here for 10 years in an eight person household, and we have bought meat maybe twice," said Tom in astonish-

ment.

He said there has never been a time they have been without because of the constant bountiful love and support they received.

Although Tom said he and his family knew little to nothing of Beulah and Mercer County, he was able to find a home where he could combine his passions: ministry and ranching.

He has spent his time not only preparing sermons for Sunday church, centennials, funerals or confirmation but also helping ranchers brand, herd cattle, fix fences or bale a field.

He said in his short 10 years, he has seen more people come together in times of need – helping each other – and that is some of the most precious memories for him.

Tom said God is who brought him to ministry and is also the reason he came to Mercer County; and now He is also the reason he is being called to go.

He heard Enderlin, North Dakota come across his ears and it became a constant call. He will be the pastor at Hope AFLC.

Tom said it is hard to leave the people he and his family have come to know and love - the people he has seen their faith grow or come to find Jesus.

"To realize that I am a human man preaching God's word is both humbling and an honor. To be handling the word of God is quite a deal, so yes, there is some trembling there, but at the same time I like to be close to the people," said Tom.

Tom said it is the words that do the work and he just delivers them. He hopes that his congregation that he is leaving behind trusts in those words.

His hope is that whoever comes behind him is seen as preaching from the same Bible as he did. Tom said the one thing weighing heavy on his heart is hoping his congregation and his people are OK once he is gone. He said he is




