

didn't check to see if I was old enough to be walking around with a beer, his only objection was to holding it in the street. We were actually on the step of the bar, but it was one of those deals where jail house lawyers advise about splitting hairs.

All in all, I have been thinking that a movie about my life wouldn't amount to much. It sure wouldn't make it to the Hallmark Channel. It would probably be musically co-scored by Woody Guthrie and Hank Williams, Sr. with maybe a cameo by the Doors. Booze, drugs, sorrow and insanity along with more fun than anyone should have all covered there.

If I were lying on a couch, talking to a shrink, I'd prob-

A clear and pleasant night turned dark and stormy in an instant, which is the normal time it takes for things to go bad. I suspect that not one life but many lives are now changed for ever.

If anyone were to stop and reflect what could have been done differently, the dangers polled, the response would most likely have been, "Of course, it won't". Of course, now everyone knows otherwise.

In the event you have lived a life where danger traveled beside you and you're still alive, odds are some others weren't as lucky. Someone always gets the leftovers from the party and the guilt of being a survivor can be quite a burden. It will leave you with picture shows that flash around in your head at odd times.

When someone asks why you are the way you are, will you be honest or lie? Of course, you will. Stories don't all start and end the same way. They are always, our stories.

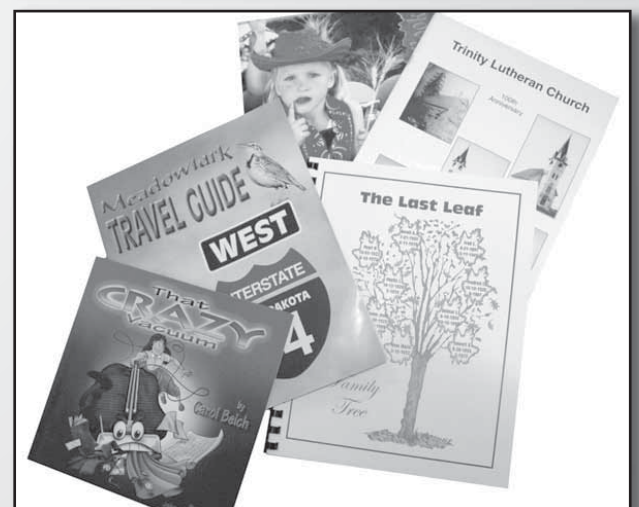

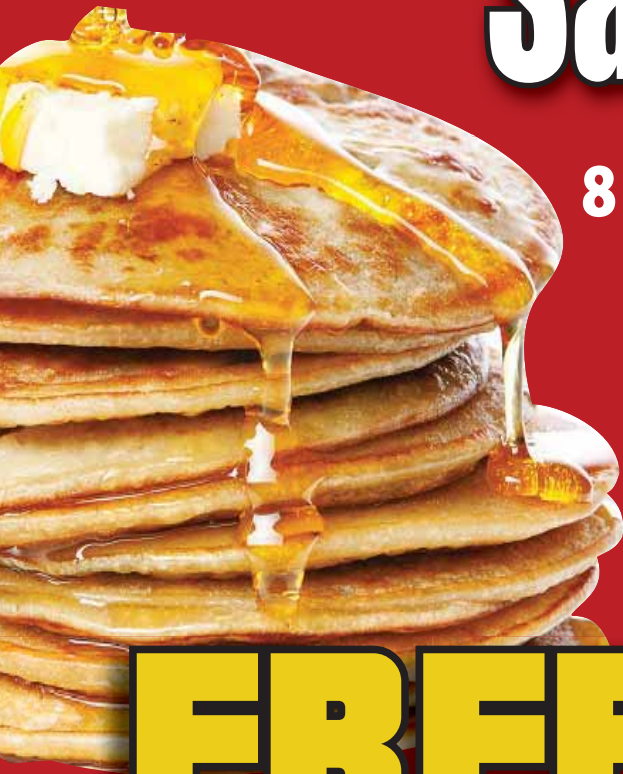
