NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, the Underwood Fire/Ambulance District, 208 Grant Ave, Underwood, ND will meet at the Underwood Fire/Ambulance Building on October 8th, 4:00 pm CT, for the purpose of opening bids for the furnishing of materials, labor and skill needed for the construction of building modifications, as more fully described in the plans for said modifications. Modifications consist of addition of a commercial kitchen and sleeping rooms within current building. 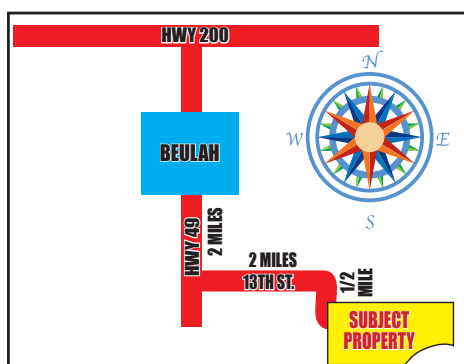

GARDENING TIPS

George's garden tips

Bunkey's neighbor George has the most spectacular flower garden in his town. He is constantly being asked for tips. Here are a few of his tips any gardener can use.

He designed his garden so all but one corner is in full sun all day. The odd corner is in filtered shade. Almost all flowering plants require 6 to 8 hours of sun a day. A few like filtered shade and only a very few will do well in full, dark shade. The shady area is home to a few hybrid lilies, several astilbe, a bleeding heart and one wild lily that he has not been able to identify or remember where he acquired it. In the sunny areas, plants are spaced so that they have good air circulation around them. This prevents almost all powdery mildew, even on the most susceptible phlox. He mulches quite heavily between the plants. This keeps the moisture in so he

doesn't need to water except in very dry weather. Mulching keeps weeds to a minimum and easily removed--- with the exception of quack grass. It also keeps roots cool in hot weather so they seldom wilt during the hottest part of the day. Gardeners often panic when they see a garden full of droopy flowers in mid day. They usually perk up by the end of day when the temps drop. Mulching will help prevent that. He keeps an eye open for end of season sales; especially on perennials although he has been known to buy a flat of annuals that look as though they will go belly up on the ride home. With a good hair cut, more root room and lots of water, they will spring back to life and fill a bare area left by tulips or other spring bloomers. He may let them go to seed. Next spring the new babies will be perfect size to transplant where ever he needs them and all they cost were pennies and a little TLC.

His gardens are designed with color, shape, texture and size in mind. He usually plants 3 or 5 of the same plants and

in such a way that they draw your eye in a certain direction. His flower garden has most of the taller plants at one end, although there are a few here and there for accent. He groups similar colors together with a color accent either near them or mixed in. For instance, he will use a tall purple accent with round yellow or orange blooms; a fluffy plant to accent a tall skinny one. He has an artist's eye for color and shape.

Take a good look at your garden. If it lacks appeal it may need a bit of IBM; that is "I've been moved". This is a good time to do that as we have at least 6 weeks before hard frost. The plants will be well established before it snows. Any spring bloomers can and should be moved now. Fall bloomers are moved in the spring. It's a great time to buy perennials to add the color, shape or texture you need as they are on sale now.

These tips may be helpful but if you are happy with your garden, to heck with anybody else. Put that fluffy pink bloom next to a bright orange one. It's your garden after all and if you like that combo, do it. Gardens are as individual as their gardeners.

Fall chores

Sorry, but fall is right on our heels. There are always jobs to do before those "unassembled snow men" start to cover the grass. For instance, if you planted winter squash, how do you know they are ripe and what the heck do you do with them after you pick them? Squash and pumpkins need to be picked before a hard frost or a cold snap that is followed by an extended period of rain. Both can cause your fruits to decay prematurely. Squash and pumpkins are ripe when you can't stick a fingernail in the skin and the skin has gotten slightly dull. Cut the stem, leaving a few inches on the fruit. If you break the stem off, you have a large area exposed to rotting. Wipe the skin with a damp cloth to remove any debris. Put them in a warm, 75 to 80, sheltered spot to cure. This will harden the skin and help any small scratches to heal.

Your squashes and pumpkins should keep well into the winter with this care. Of course, if the thought of eating either of these except in pie, turn your stomach, you can use them as fall decorations. Outside they will keep until they freeze and then turn into a yukky mess.

If you have been thinking about planting a tree on your estate, now is the time. They are usually on sale this time of year and it is more than 6 weeks to the first hard frost, the cut off time to plant. Dump the tree out of its pot and shake or wash the soil off. Do this on a cardboard or blanket. You want to put the soil in the planting hole as it has various "critter" that help feed the roots and generally help the tree to flourish. Now that you have the naked root exposed, pull them apart and remove any that are wrapped around the trunk. Dig the hole ½ as wide as the width of the spread-out roots, shallow, not deep. Plant the tree with the top root no deeper than 2 inches below the soil. Water the snot out of it, giving it at

least an inch of water a week until the soil is so frozen that water stands on top of the soil. Mulch with about a foot of leaves, straw or shredded bark. The trunk should be protected against sun scald and sharp toothed critters that think fresh bark is a great lunch. The tree won't do a darn thing this fall but will be ready to take off next spring.

Remember to look up before you plant a tree. If it is under an electric line, the electric company will make it really ugly by cutting off its top when it gets in the lines. Too close to the house and its summer leaves will make the inside of the house look like it is haunted, dark and gloomy. With so called foundation trees and shrubs, the trees love to cover up the front of the house on the way to lifting shingles as they grow too tall. Not only that, the roots will start to invade the foundation. You really don't want to surprise a guest when a tree root pops out of the wall in his bedroom. (Yes, that has really happened). There are more fall chores, but these should keep you busy until next time.
