

Social security scam hits area

McLean County residents have been the unfortunate recipients of phishing calls lately, with locals reporting a social security number scam that is making the rounds.

Several individuals in the

Washburn area have reported being called by out-of-state numbers and told that there is an issue with their social security number. Individuals are then prompted to provide personal identification information and/or money.

The caller reportedly tells individuals that they are in legal trouble because of fraudulent activity associated with their social security number.

The McLean County State's attorney's office is aware of the scam but said it is not aware of any individuals in the county losing money to it.

Hot bacon cheese dip

2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese, cubed

- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon dried minced onion
- 16 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled

Tortilla chips or toasted French bread slices

In a 1-1/2-qt. slow cooker, combine the first 6 ingredients. Cover and cook on low for 2-3 hours or until cheeses are melted, stirring occasionally. Just before serving, stir in bacon. If desired, top with crumbled bacon. Serve warm with tortilla chips or toasted bread.

Chicken wings

2-1/2 pounds chicken wings 1/2 cup barbecue sauce

1/2 cup honey

1/2 cup soy sauce

Cut chicken wings into 3 sections; discard wing tip section. Place in a greased 13x9-in. baking dish. Combine barbecue sauce, honey and soy sauce; pour over wings. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 50-60 minutes or until chicken juices run clear.

Barbecue is made from vinegar, tomato paste and mayonnaise, though it's much tastier than it sounds!

A good alternative to chicken wings is chicken thighs, which are typically cheaper and contain some of the best

meat you'll find on the chicken.

- 4 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup half-and-half cream
- 1 teaspoon prepared mustard


