Country Kitchen Recipes



Chicken wings

- 2-1/2 pounds chicken wings
- 1/2 cup barbecue sauce
- 1/2 cup honey
- 1/2 cup soy sauce

Cut chicken wings into 3 sections; discard wing tip section. Place in a greased 13x9-in. baking dish. Combine barbecue sauce, honey and soy sauce; pour over wings. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 50-60 minutes or until chicken juices run clear.

Test kitchen tips

Barbecue is made from vinegar, tomato paste and mayonnaise, though it's much tastier than it sounds!

A good alternative to chicken wings is chicken thighs, which are typically cheaper and contain some of the best meat you'll find on the chicken.

Hot bacon cheese dip

- 2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese, cubed
- 4 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup half-and-half cream
- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon dried minced onion
- 1 teaspoon prepared mustard
- 16 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
- Tortilla chips or toasted French bread slices

In a 1-1/2-qt. slow cooker, combine the first 6 ingredients. Cover and cook on low for 2-3 hours or until cheeses are melted, stirring occasionally. Just before serving, stir in bacon. If desired, top with crumbled bacon. Serve warm with tortilla chips or toasted bread.

Banana pudding salad

- 2 (3.4 ounce) packages instant vanilla pudding mix
- 1 cup milk
- 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- 1 (8 ounce) container sour cream
- 1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 6 bananas, sliced

In a medium bowl, combine pudding mix and milk and stir until mix is dissolved. Refrigerate 15 minutes, until partially set. Stir condensed milk into pudding mixture until smooth. Fold in sour cream and whipped topping. Fold in bananas. Refrigerate until serving.

Monster bars

- 1/2 c. butter
- 1 c. white sugar
- 1 c. brown sugar
- 3 eggs
- 1 1/2 c. peanut butter
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 2 tsp. baking soda
- 4 1/2 c. oatmeal
- 1 1/2 c. chocolate chips
- 1 1/2 c. mini M&M's

Preheat oven to 350° F. Cream the butter and sugars together. Add eggs and peanut butter and mix. Stir in vanilla, baking soda and oatmeal. Stir in chocolate chips and M&M's. Put in lightly greased 10x15 pan. Bake for 25 minutes. Do NOT over bake!
