NDSU Extension energizing entrepreneurs conference goes to Garrison

Energizing Entrepreneurs, a statewide conference for entrepreneurs in rural communities, is designed to inspire and provide resources for anyone who wants to start or support a small business in their rural community.

The conference, hosted by North Dakota State University Extension, will be held October 1-2 in the community of Garrison, North Dakota.

What's special about this conference is that it takes place in a rural community and is designed to help rural entrepreneurs or anyone else with an idea and passion to make their opportunities right where they are," says Jodi Bruns, NDSU Extension Leadership and Civic Engagement Specialist.

"If you already own a business, are thinking about starting one, or you want to learn more about how to help small businesses succeed in your community, this conference is for you," Bruns continues.

On the first day of the conference, keynote speaker Annie Carlson of Mercer, will share real life advice from a real life entrepreneur.

Carlson and her husband, John, own and operate Morning Joy Farm, located in central North Dakota. The farm is a third generation, pasturebased, local-market farm with a commercial kitchen and food truck that specializes in homemade catered meals for special events, bulk family meals, cooking classes and helping their customers know where their food is grown.

In her keynote address, Carlson will discuss her experiences in a Fortune 500 Company and running a one-woman show, and share what she has learned from her successes and failures.



On day two, Chappy Windsor, founder and chief executive officer of Dakota Chappy, will share her passion for serving women and changing lives.

Windsor, a North Dakota native, is an inventor, entrepreneur and small business champion. Her desire to increase mobility and utility in women's clothing has put her at the forefront of change in the fashion industry. Windsor is the creator of one of fashion's first all-in-one shaper garment, the Dakota Chappy Total Tight. She is a frequent fashion correspondent on North Dakota Today, as well as the host of her own show Chappy TV.

In addition to the keynotes, participants will be able to attend breakout sessions that focus on four tracts:

• Encouraging a Thriving Economy in a Rural Community

• Marketing to the Masses • Getting Creative to Make

a Living • Real World Small Business

Family meetings can include a variety of components, depending on your family situation. You may wish to start small when children are young. Simply designate a time to meet all together each week. Bacon ranch skewers

1/3 cup ranch dressing

1 teaspoon hot chile paste (such as sambal oelek) 4 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves - cut into 1 inch

pieces

24 (1-inch) pieces red onion

12 slices thick cut bacon

salt and black pepper to taste

12 (6 inch) bamboo skewers, soaked in water for 2 hours

Whisk together ranch dressing and hot chile paste in a large bowl.

Mix in chicken pieces and toss to evenly coat. Cover the bowl with plastic wrap and marinate in the refrigerator for 1 to 3 hours.

Preheat an outdoor grill for medium-high heat and lightly oil the grate.

Remove chicken from the bag and transfer to a plate or baking sheet lined with paper towels. Pat chicken pieces dry with more paper towels.

Thread a piece of onion about 1 1/2 inches down the skewer.

Thread the end portion of one strip of bacon onto skewer so the rest of the strip is hanging down. Skewer on a piece of chicken; thread on the next portion of the bacon. Turn the skewer so that the long end of the bacon is again hanging down. Repeat this process of skewering and turning until the entire strip of bacon is threaded, using 4 to 5 chicken pieces.

Thread a second piece of onion onto the end of the skewer. Repeat steps 5 through 7 for all twelve skewers.

Season chicken skewers with salt and pepper as desired.

Cook the skewers on the preheated grill, turning every 3 to 4 minutes, until nicely browned on all sides and the meat is no longer pink in the center, 12 to 16 minutes total per skewer. Serve with ranch dressing as a dipping sauce.



of the year to improve your lawn. You can lay sod now and know it will survive the winter. Reseed any bare spots making sure they are damp until they are well sprouted. This is the perfect time to kill Charlie and dandelions. Be sure to read the label of the can before you apply it. Check to see that it kills the weeds you want dead. Charlie is also known as ground ivy. Dandelions have no other name than a pain in the grass. Aerate any spots in the yard that are hardpan or all clay. Leave the hunks of dirt on the soil. They will melt in the rain. If you enjoy mowing grass, apply fertilizer now.

If you want lots of fall color, plant Minnesota hardy mums now. Another showy although large plant is the perennial aster. It gets about 4 feet tall and wide. It Is covered with small purple blossoms that attract butterflies. The plant, in full blooms, looks as though it is moving because of all the butterflies feeding on it.

If you need more trees in your yard, now is a great time to plant them. Not only will they

September is the perfect time on sale! Don't fertilize them, but water the snot out of them. Keep watering, an inch a week until the ground freezes so hard the water stays on top of the soil. Protect the trunks from bark eating critters and the south and east sun. Remove the protection in the summer as it can get so hot inside those tubes that the sap literally boils. This is not a good thing. If you want to boil sap, take it out of the tree first.

If you have had a problem with sowbugs or millipedes in your house, spread an 18 inch band of chlopyrifos (the chemical name) around the foundation. Forget killing wasps now. They will die at the first hard frost. Only the queen lives through the winter and she is difficult to find. If you have been hip deep in gophers and moles, now is a great time to trap them. It will reduce the population in the spring.

Bring in house plants when the nighttime temperatures drop to 45. Don't panic if they drop leaves. The light in the brightest window isn't as bright as outdoor shade. Give them a good hosing off being sure get a good start now, they are to get under the leaves. This

should knock off any bugs that would like a nice warm winter vacation in your house. If the pots have holes in the bottom and have been sitting on bare soil, dump them out and check for angle worms. Your plants don't need worms squirming around in their roots. It's a good time to repot too. You can get as messy as you want outside and the plants will appreciate some fresh soil and a bigger pot if they have gotten too big for the one they are in.

If you have apple trees, pick your Honeycrisp and any other early apple before a frost. The hardier ones can withstand a temp down to 28 without major damage. Don't touch a frozen apple as this will damage it. Wait until they thaw to pick them.

Pick a warm day to plug any holes in your foundation, siding, or around windows. Lady bugs, wasps and other creepy crawlies love to spend the winter with you. They can fit into the smallest crack, as can mice. None of them are ideal housemates. Get out and enjoy the outdoors now. Snow is on the horizon. Bev Johnson M.G.
