

Keep Your Home Healthy

Carbon Monoxide

Is a gas produced during combustion that you cannot see, taste or smell, which can cause severe side effects or even death.

Radon

Is a naturally occurring invisible, odorless, tasteless radioactive gas that increases the potential for lung cancer when exposed to at elevated levels.

Carbon Monoxide

Fuel-powered devices can provide wonderful benefits when used properly. But they also underscore an important necessity in the home: the need for a carbon monoxide alarm. Carbon monoxide poisoning can results from faulty furnaces or other heating appliances, portable generators, water heaters, clothes dryers, or cars left running in garages.

Young children are especially vulnerable to the effects because of their smaller bodies. Children process carbon monoxide differently than adults, may be more severely affected by it, and may show signs of poisoning sooner.

> Symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning include: Headache • Nausea • Dizziness • Drowsiness • Fatigue

<u>Top Tips</u>

- 1. Make sure your home has a carbon monoxide alarm. As with smoke alarms, install a carbon monoxide alarm on every level of your home, especially near sleeping areas, and keep them at least 15 feet away from fuel-burning appliances.
- 2. Carbon monoxide alarms are not substitutes for smoke alarms, and vice versa. Combination smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are available.
- 3. Don't use a grill, generator or camping stove inside your home, garage or near a window.
- 4. If you need to warm a vehicle, remove it from the garage immediately after starting it. Don't leave a car, SUV or motorcycle engine running inside a garage.
- 5. If using gasoline-powered devices, store gasoline in a locked location where children cannot access it. Keep only small quantities in an approved container that has child safety features.
- 6. Keep gasoline away from any source of heat, spark or flame. Even common household appliances such as water heaters and clothes dryers can start a gasoline fire. Be sure to store gasoline away from anything that could ignite it.

Radon

Radon has been found at elevated levels in homes across the country. The highest concentrations are usually found in basements and crawl spaces that's because they're located closest to the rocks or soil that are the source of the radon.

Radon exposure does not cause any short-term effects, such as coughing, trouble breathing or other respiratory symptoms. But its long-term effects can be serious.

Test your home for radon. The testing device, normally a charcoal canister kit, is set in the lowest habitable space (usually the basement during heating season when the house is kept closed) for a few days and then sent in for analysis.

If the reading exceeds the recommended level of 4 piocurries per liter of air, further testing will be needed to determine if sufficient radon is in the living space to required action to reduce the level.

Test kits are available from some hardware stores, your local public health district or the American Lung Association.

Reducing radon levels requires a combination of subslab suction using a fan, a sand or gravel layer under the concrete floor and basement floor crack sealing. Consult your extension service for more information.

Having carbon monoxide and radon detectors are important for everyone's safety. You can purchase these detectors at most hardware and do-it-yourself stores.

Keep your home healthy through proper home construction, maintenance and operation.
