

I plan to spend some family time and hit as many squares on the family Monopoly board as I can. And, as my day goes, so shall I be thankful I'm not a turkey. And, Lord, I don't know where you got the idea for turkeys to begin with, but let me just say, "You did good work. And we need to appreciate it all that we can.



started her 2nd term as NDAFP President. Her first term was from 2010 – 2011. She works hard every day and has a passion for family


