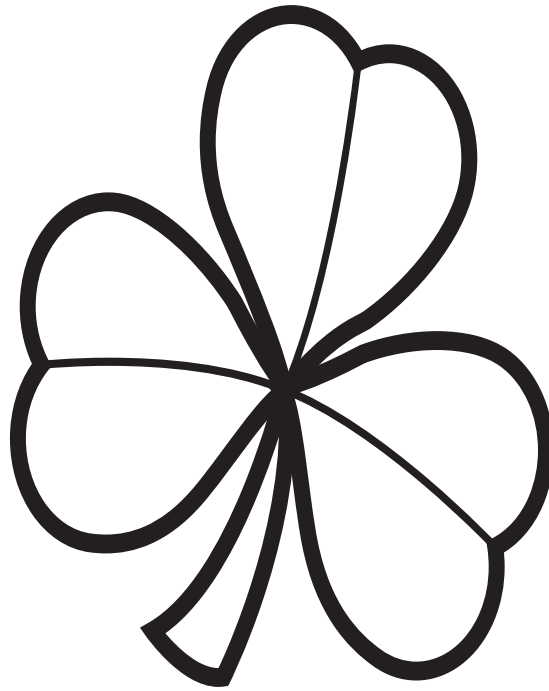



M&M Pet Rescue benefit set for March 15

The Sunday, March 15 event Pancakes for Paws benefitting M&M Pet Rescue is the brainchild of Beulah's Jessica Beck.

The idea stemmed from Beck's love of animals and a recent case in which a mother dog and one of her puppies were shot and abandoned, and the animals ended up rescued by and in care of Mercer County's M&M Pet Rescue.

"When I saw the story on Facebook, I stewed over it," Beck said. "I can't foster a dog and I am limited in what I can do."

Beck began brainstorming and came up with the idea of a benefit for the pet shelter. She subsequently engages the support of Sean Cheatley, president of the Fire & Iron club, West River crew, a motorcycle enthusiast group made up of emergency responders, station 162.

Thus was the fundraiser idea born.

"I wanted to help as best I can," Beck said.

Cheatley said that the event is all about the pets and for the community. "That's what Fire & Iron is all about."

Fire & Iron has helped numerous organizations and individuals in need. Still, Cheatley credits Beck for the initiative.

"This is Jessica's idea," he said.

Still, Cheatley, an avowed animal lover, was touched by the cause. "My first dog after I was diagnosed with PTSD after my military and fire service was very important," he said.

Cheatley has been an enthusiast since, knows Beck and was motivated by social media postings.

"It really touched my heart," he said.

2020-22 fishing regulations set

North Dakota's 2020-22 fishing proclamation is set, with regulations effective April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2022. Anglers are reminded new fishing licenses are required April 1.

The 2020-22 North Dakota Fishing Guide has a new look. The 52-page document offers the same information, but in a much more user-friendly format. Anglers can find the guide online at the state Game and Fish Department website, gf.nd.gov, or in mid-March at Game and Fish Department offices and license vendors throughout the state.

Noteworthy regulation changes include:

- * Lake Ashtabula and Whiteman Dam are added to the list of waters where darkhouse spearfishing is not allowed.
- * The smallmouth bass daily limit is increased from 3 to 5 in the Missouri River and lakes Sakakawea, Oahe, Audubon, Darling, Ashtabula and Heart Butte.
- * Area and time for paddlefish extended snag-and-release days is expanded.
- * Fish may be filleted for transport, unless size limits apply, under the following conditions:
 - Each individual portion of the meat removed from a fish is considered a fillet (fish cheeks and pectoral girdles

(wings) are not considered as fillets and are legal to transport),

- Two fillets are counted as one fish, and
- The packaging of fish must be done in a manner so that the fillets can be readily separated and counted. If fillets are frozen, they must be packaged so that the fillets are separated and thus can be easily counted without thawing.

The 2020-21 fishing licenses can be purchased online by visiting the Game and Fish website. Resident licenses are available March 15, while non-resident fishing licenses are available April 1.

In addition, Senate Bill 2293, passed by the 2019 state legislature, created an aquatic nuisance species program fund in the state treasury. Along with an ANS fee on motorized watercraft that went into effect Jan. 1, this state law also establishes a \$2 surcharge on each resident fishing license and combination license, exception for the resident 65 years of age or older license, permanently or totally disabled license, or a disabled veteran license; and establishes a \$3 surcharge on each nonresident fishing and each nonresident waterfowl license. The ANS surcharge on licenses is in effect with the 2020-21 license.

NONRESIDENT ANY-DEER

BOW LICENSES

The North Dakota Game and Fish Department will have 780 any-deer bow licenses available to nonresidents in 2020.

Applicants can apply online beginning March 15 on the Game and Fish website, gf.nd.gov. The deadline for applying is April 15.

Up to five hunters can apply together as a party. A lottery will be held if more applications are received than licenses available. A total of 1,209 people applied in 2019.

The number of nonresident any-deer bow licenses available is 15 percent of the previous year's mule deer gun license allocation.

Pronghorn hunting season statistics

Hunter success during last fall's pronghorn hunting season was 74 percent, according to statistics provided by the North Dakota Game and Fish Department.

Game and Fish issued 1,324 licenses (877 lottery and 447 gratis), and 1,167 hunters took 859 pronghorn, consisting of 786 bucks, 59 does and 14 fawns. Each hunter spent an average of 2.7 days afield.

The 2020 pronghorn hunting season will be determined in July.

White Shield moves to four-day school week

Once approved by the state, White Shield school will move to a four-day week in August.

After a survey of parents, trips to other four-day schools, a school board unanimous vote and a community meeting, Superintendent Wayne Fox filed the request of the state Feb. 27. The deadline to file with the state is this week.

White Shield will join 12 other schools in the state who are on a four-day work week. In South Dakota, 34 schools – or 23 percent of the districts – are on a four-school week. In Montana, there are 62 school districts on the four day school week, or 13 percent.

Six school districts were on the four-day week before this school year: three in McKenzie County – East Fairview, Horse Creek and Alexander; Invitation Hill Adventist School in Stark County and Dunseith Public Schools and Turtle Mountain Community High School in Rolette County. This year, six more tried it for the full year or joined partway through this school year: Marmath, Billings, Holiday, Marmot, Wing and Hazelton-Moffit-Braddock.

Fox said, "White Shield has gone to great lengths to change." He said test scores are up and instructional methods continue to focus on how to provide students a good education.

After a team of administrators visited Alexander, Dunseith and Belcourt, they learned that it was worth tak-

ing a look at.

"Let's try something new, to keep ourselves relevant," he said.

He said the change doesn't come without awareness that there will be some challenges.

Students will be required to be at school at 8, instead of 8:25. School will dismiss at 3:40, instead of 3:15. That combination gives the required instructional minutes set by the state.

Joel Cote-Kanning, counselor at the school, said longer class periods may seem counter intuitive to learning, but he said the longer periods will provide a greater chance to engage the students in their learning.

Fridays will be a catch up, one-on-one instructional time for struggling students.

Fox said the school district will work with the local Boys and Girls Club to provide Friday activities, which would lessen the burden on parents needing daycare.

He said he hopes the district will follow other state's schools and have special activities on Fridays, like STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) activities and language and cultural training.

"Currently we only have a

half hour to teach language and culture for the whole week," he said. "That's not enough time to focus on that," Fox said.

He said the plan is to have "enrichment" on Friday mornings and then a partnership with the Boys and Girls Club in the afternoon.

Fox hopes it helps to attract teachers to the district.

"Being in a small rural area, we have a hard time retaining our teachers and recruiting some of our teachers," he said. "We thought this would be a main attraction for some."

He said other schools are reporting application numbers are up under the four-day school week.

"We found this would be a main attraction for some teachers to come teach at White Shield," he said.

He also said there has been an increase in enrollment in some of those schools.

Fox said teacher contracts will not be impacted because they will still have to work the required number of minutes.

"It really doesn't affect our teacher contracts," he said.

The bottom line for Fox and his team of administrators is how to positively impact students.
