Socially-distant Memorial Day graveside service planned

Although the nature of the service will look notably different this year, the Clark Legion Post 189 of the American Legion still plans to honor those who gave their lives for this country on Monday.

Hazen's Memorial Service will consist solely of the graveside ceremony, without the presentation at the high

school gym that precedes the cemetery service in normal years. The graveside service will begin at 10 a.m. at the Hazen City Cemetery north of town along County 27.

The public is encouraged to attend while practicing social distancing. Those who wish can stay in their cars and view the service through the windows.

Stanton will not be hold-

ing a Memorial Day service this year due to the pandemic, but the Stanton American Legion Auxiliary plans to decorate the cemeteries with flags, which people can view when driving through.

Unlike Veterans Day in November, which honors all current or past veterans of the American Armed Forces, Memorial Day is a day to remember and honor those who have given their lives to defend this country and its liberties. The solemn and sacred ceremony includes an invocation by a pastor, a gun salute, the playing of Taps and the raising of the American flag at the cemetery.





Mercer County Weed Control will soon begin spraying for noxious weeds in the county, state and township road Rights-of-Way. The Mercer County weed control equipment and staff will be spraying road ditches within the county. The spraying operations will be conducted over the course of the spring, summer and into the fall.

Landowners and livestock owners wishing to hay road ditches are advised that some of the herbicides used may have haying and/ or grazing restrictions, requiring a certain amount of time after application before haying or grazing is permissible, according to label requirements. Owners/Operators with questions on these limitations can contact Mercer County Weed Control officer Brad Seifert at 870-0595, for further information.

The general public is also advised to be watchful for equipment working on the road shoulders and in the ditches.
