VOTE NO ON MEASURE 2

November 3, 2020, the voters of North Dakota will be voting on Measure 2. A Senate Concurrent Resolution passed by the 2019 Legislature. SCR 4001 will change Section 9 of Article III "Powers Reserved by the People" in the North Dakota Constitution. The Framework for North Dakota citizens to have the power reserved to initiate a petition to amend the century code, the constitution, referendum of a legislative bill, or recall certain elected officials. When an initiative constitutional amendment has been approved by the voters it will no longer be considered enacted. The next legislative assembly will be required to hold Senate and House committee hearings on it before a vote on the final passage by the Senate and House. My biggest concern is there is nothing in SCR 4001 to prevent the legislative assembly from changing the intent of the initiative constitutional amendment. It grants more power to legislators if the majority of them don't like the initiative constitutional amendment approved by citizens of North Dakota. The bottom line is the super majority of legislators have been upset with the citizens of North Dakota for passing Marcy's Law, Medical Marijuana, and Ethics measures that were on the ballot measures in past elections. The legislators do not like the citizens of North Dakota directing them what to legislate. They are going to be telling you about the amount of out-of-state money and out-of-state organizations influencing the process of the initiative petition. The citizens of North Dakota need to ask the legislators why it's okay for them to accept out-of-state PAC money from corporations or organizations for their campaigns. Doesn't it influence how they vote on a Senate or House Bill? Please vote NO on Measure 2



Kilt up and eat haggis

"It's not a skirt. It's a kilt."

The 9th annual Scottish Highland Festival will take place on Saturday. The festival will consist of games, food, and music all of the Scottish variety. The event is free and welcome to all.

It is led and brought to you by Doug Kraenzel. The idea of having a Scottish Highland Festival came randomly to him.

"I used to own a bar and grill in Hebron. And I remember meeting Scott (Solem) there. It was one of those 'you know what would be fun' ideas," Kraenzel said.

The games are a big draw for those who come.

"The main event is the

games. It's all amateur. It's all for fun. We do a men's division and a women's division," Kraenzel said.

There are three events for the games: the hammer throw, the rock put, and the caber toss.

For the hammer throw, competitors swing a hammer in circles and release it to see far it travels. The rock put is similar to the Olympic event the shot put. A rock or a stone is used as opposed to a steel ball. The caber toss requires each competitor to throw a pole as straight as possible after it completes a full flip.

The food will contain authentic Scottish dishes. Haggis is one of them. Haggis contains sheep's or calf's

"We'll have the haggis. It sounds worse than it is. It actually tastes really good," Kraenzel said.

Increased Waterfowl Populations Greet Resident Hunters at Opener

A wet fall of 2019 and abundant moisture which carried over into the start of 2020 primed the pump for a successful breeding season for waterfowl in North Dakota's prairie pothole region. With good recruitment comes increased numbers of ducks for hunters headed out to stake out their favorite slough as the season starts for resident waterfowl hunters on Sat. Sept. 26. Despite drier conditions in the back half of summer, many wetlands remain in good shape, particularly in the eastern third of the Peace Garden State for the upcoming waterfowl hunting season.

"The wetland conditions in the eastern third of the state are quite good for this time of year," reports Dane Buysse, Conservation Programs Biologist for Ducks Unlimited in North Dakota, adding, "as you move further toward the central portion of North Dakota - I was out just this last weekend - and some of those wetlands are drying up out there and you're going to see drier conditions as you move to the northwest part of the state."

North Dakota was unique in comparison to the rest of the nation, as many state wildlife agencies cancelled their spring and summer counts for returning waterfowl and brood surveys due to the Covid-19 pandemic. With social distancing in place, and single-person survey routes drawn up, the North Dakota Game & Fish Department (NDGF) was able to tally the state's waterfowl populations like in previous years, with a little more focus and work by its agents.

"Talking with biologists across the state, it sounds like duck numbers are quite good, I've been seeing great duck numbers on the wetlands I've been driving by," Buysse said of the summer survey results, "it's really cool that we do have data on that, and their mid-July duck production survey showed that you should see a nine percent increase in the number of birds you're seeing this fall, which is pretty awesome," he advised.

In addition to an increased number of temporary wetlands which allowed not only more habitat for territorial waterfowl to spread out on across the landscape, but also for more abundant food sources for nesting hens and growing broods, many acres that were normally planted by producers adjacent to pothole sloughs and other duck-rearing lowlands went unused due to the wet conditions. This in turn helped provide better nesting habitat and more cover for ducks and ducklings.

"Those wet conditions last fall carried over into spring and provided an incredible buffet for all those hen mallards and other species of ducks that were coming up to nest here, so they had ideal food sources going into the spring," Buysse explains, adding, "there's also a 2.5 million acre prevent-plant count for this year, so that had some additional nesting cover for those birds being those acres weren't disturbed...which is unfortunate that farmers were unable to plant it, but it does provide some additional habitat for them to nest in."

For those watching the migration, Buysse is hearing good things from Canada, as production remained good north of the border. Despite it being closed to human travel, again due to the continuing pandemic, it is likely Canadian waterfowl will begin making their way south in earnest in the coming weeks. When they do, North Dakota's hunters will likely see more migrants than in previous years.

"The adult male blue-wing teal were heading south this past week and it sounds like hunters [in southern Canada] with those early teal seasons were having some incredible success," he relays, "those birds are beginning to move south, they had decent production up in Canada and it will be interesting to see those birds - as the weather patterns continue to change - how many of them move down into the Dakotas," Buysse concludes.

More information on the migration, along with events and habitat efforts the organization is carrying out for North Dakota waterfowl can be found at the Ducks Unlimited website: ducks.org. The North Dakota general resident waterfowl season opens Sat. Sept. 26 and runs until Sun. Dec. 6 in the High Plains (1) and Low Plains Units. Nonresident waterfowl seasons are delayed one week and open on Sat. Oct. 3. For more information on waterfowl hunting, visit gf.nd.gov/hunting/ducks.

Coloring Up

As the leaves turn their yellow, gold, red and brown, another change in color signals the shift toward fall. In the morning, along any given gravel road, should the conditions be just right and a recently-harvested field be available in pheasant country, it's easy to see the transition in the bird population as the newest crop of roosters begins to ditch the buff hues shared with their young-of-the-year sisters, and instead don the bronzes, golds, reds and maroons of adulthood. It is a sign, much like the quickly departing leaves on the trees, that autumn has arrived and pheasant season is just around the corner.

For many new hunters, the pheasant season and particularly the youth pheasant weekend of Oct. 3 and 4 in North Dakota and youth pheasant week from Sept. 26 to Oct. 4 in South Dakota, provides a chance for them to don a new color as well and join our orange-clad culture. Helping novices make the transition from their spring or summer hunters education courses to those exciting moments behind a field dog in pursuit of roosters in the coming weeks is perhaps the best spent time in the outdoors for an experienced hunter passing on the tradition. What follows are tips to make the most of it and set new hunters on the path to a life-long pursuit.

FOCUS ON SAFETY

In a controlled environment, say at the patterning board or behind a trap thrower, safety rules are generally easy to recall and enforce. Add in the elements of a chilly morning, a stiff breeze, a running dog or one in an adrenaline-inducing point, and things can become overwhelming for new hunters. Be certain to remind them that not taking a shot is okay. Whether they know it isn't safe when a bird doesn't get up high enough, they just couldn't click their safety over in time, or perhaps just didn't feel right about the shot for another reason, letting new hunters know that the shot is theirs to take – or not – is key in taking the pressure off of each outing. Additionally, share the idea that not only is blaze orange a perennial fashion color this time of year, it serves a purpose as well. Stress that more of the safety color is better, and be certain to model that behavior by wearing your vest and hat, and share one or two of the dozens you likely have accumulated over the years to

help reinforce the idea that visibility equals safety.

PREPARE FOR THE SHOT

Before the hunt, explain to a new shooter how your dog will work the field. Is it a flusher, a pointer, maybe a little bit of both, depending on the birds? Talk about cues from the way the dog moves when it is on scent to the time it goes on point or puts a bird in the air. Before entering the field, explain that "ground pounding" roosters is a big no-no, and letting them get airborne with blue sky behind them is the best possible scenario. Address the commands that are common when in pursuit of pheasants – from "whoa" to "go" – so that everyone is aware as to what is going on. From those cues, be they from a circling flushing dog to a hard-holding pointer, new hunters will learn what to expect leading up to the shot. When the moment comes, help make the call of rooster or hen, and let a first timer take his or her shot at the bird in flight as they identify it, mount their shotgun and squeeze the trigger. Especially in the

early youth season, these moments are the ones that help cement new hunters and future conservationists into the sporting fold.

JUST THE START

These days in the early season are only the beginning, not just for the three months of hunting ahead, but for a lifetime. A mentorship doesn't end with just a day in the field but continues throughout the fall and for years to come, particularly until a young hunter is capable of heading out to the field alone. With each day as the season progresses, remember how birds adjust to pressure and the elements and share those tips and suggestions and the lessons learned along the way. As birds become brightly colored and winter sets in, it's likely that a young hunter will be gaining the experience necessary to predict and adjust to these changes. With a little help and a focus on safety, how things work in the field and what's to come throughout the season, that process will seem to happen as quickly as a bird takes to the wing.
