Reading a seed packet or catalog

Many people read novels during winter's cold months. Nothing better than sitting in front of the fireplace and enjoying the latest Stephen King horror story. I'm currently reading Louise Erdrich's latest novel, from 2020, "The Night Watchman."

And, just for fun, I read seed catalogs like some people read cookbooks. If you have never learned how to read a seed catalog or, for that matter, the back of a seed packet, it's a clue to your garden success.


There's been an increase in the number of gardeners willing to go out on a limb and try a new variety of tomato or pepper this year. That's the fun of growing your transplants. There are so many seeds available from hundreds of seed companies online.

Every year I discover yet another company to purchase unusual seeds from. This year, I found an Oregon company called SiskIyou Seeds on my hunt for Hidatsa squash seed. And I discovered my squash seeds.

It's essential to read your seed catalog or packet because, as you may or may not know, North Dakota is a Zone 4 state. That zone was designated by the USDA based on our frost dates. We can almost always expect a frost from May 1 to the 31, which is why many gardeners wait until Memorial Day weekend to plant.

I've been bitten, even waiting until May 31 to plant by frost the first two weeks of June. Gardening, like farming, is a crapshoot no matter how many years you have under your bibs.

Some gardeners like to put their tomatoes out early, in April even. That never pays off. Sure, you have bragging rights, but only until that last frost kills those tender transplants. Oh, yes, if you are clever, you can use water tubes, or cover

WILD WITTLEF Carvings and Landscaping them, or put a smudge pot in your back yard, it matters not. Those warm-weather plants will wait until the night time temps are above 50-degrees to start growing. All you are doing is making more work for yourself early in the season and only harvesting what all smart gardeners who waited until after the chance of frost will harvest from their efforts.


Back to packets. As you can see in the photo, there are quite a few ways to present the following information. You can find this same information in the seed catalog before you order your seeds.

Here is an abbreviated version of the information on a seed packet.

1. Days to Maturity

This number represents the number of days it takes for the plant to go from seed to maturity. North Dakota's growing season is from the middle of May to about the middle of October, or about 90 days, give or take. That means you should select varieties that mature in less than 90 days.

2. Days to Germination Some seeds take weeks to germinate, while others take only a few days. Remember peppers take up to 10 days to germinate, whereas tomatoes can be up in a couple of



days. 3. Planting Depth and Seed Spacing

Also noted on most seed packets is the proper seed planting depth and seed spacing for that variety. Usually, if a vegetable can be spaced four inches apart, you can plant rows about four inches apart, taking advantage of all the space you can in a French intensive or square foot gardening situation.

4. Timing

Seed packets will also tell you the best time to start seeds of that particular variety and where best to do it. Often indoor seed-starting directions are provided on the packet, noting details like whether you should start your seeds four weeks before spring's last expected frost or 12 (or any number of variations of those details). As noted above, seed packets will also tell you whether direct seeding or indoor seeding is best. The Old Farmers Almanac website has a handy calculator to help you figure this one out.

5. Number of Seeds in Packet or Number of Seeds per Ounce

Knowing how many seeds are in a packet is critical. This is only important if you plant lots of row crops. Most seeds are 25 to a pack. Yes, I have been known to count them out as the price of seeds has exponentially grown with home garden popularity.

6. Special Instructions When learning how to read a seed packet, gardeners forget to pay attention to special growing notes. This may be a clue as to what you need to do in addition to watering and watching them grow.

Be brave, my friends, try some new garden vegetables this year. Remember to keep a good garden journal to remember next year whether you had success with your plants.


