As of March 19, 2021 Mercer & Oliver County will be under a Stage 2 Burn Ban until further notice.

# **RESTRICTIONS:**

The following acts are prohibited until further notice:

- Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire of any type, to include pit, burn barrel and/or a campfire. "Note, this change makes it so no fires at all are allowed in the County. Cities & State Parks will set restrictions in their jurisdictions as noted in Exemptions below."
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three (3) feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials.
  - Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame.
    - · Using an explosive.
  - Operating motorized vehicles off designated roads and trails.

#### **EXEMPTIONS:**

Persons with a written permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act. Persons using a device fueled solely by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels that can be turned on and off. Emergency repair of public utilities and railroads.

Persons conducting activities in those designated areas where the activity is specifically authorized by written posted notice. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty. All land within a city boundary is exempted. "Note: All Cities will set their own Fire Ban Rules as they see appropriate." Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame, with extinguishment capabilities immediately accessible. Other exceptions unique to each agency/tribe.

# AND REMEMBER...

ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES THIS BURN BAN IS GUILTY OF A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR (NDCC 37-17.1-10.1) PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF UP TO \$1500 AND 30 DAYS IN JAIL. THE MERCER & OLIVER COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENTS ARE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE CITATIONS TO VIOLATORS. When the Burn Ban is lifted, we are asking that all controlled burns be reported to the Sheriff's office, 745-3333 (Mercer) 794-3450 (Oliver), when the fire starts and then another call when the fire has been extinguished, Thank You!

# Paulson takes long road to ministry

When Dan Paulson was in grade school, he drew a picture of himself standing by a church.

His vision included leading his own congregation, an imagination that eventually came to fruition. It just took him a while to get there, and he chose a long and bumpy trail.

Fasten your seat belt tightly. The journey is filled with jolts, bounces and

Paulson wouldn't have it any other way. Taking the hard road has turned his ministry into one for which he's proud. He has helped reach people in his flock by being open and honest about his human side.

"In order to be a pastor to people, people have to know who I am so they'll let me know who they are,' said Paulson, who was recently named the interim pastor at Beulah's Zion Lutheran Church. "The story I come from is the story of Christ personified. I was lost and God found me. When people know you're broken and you're healed through faith, they understand you better.'

Paulson grew up in the church - and enjoyed attending and participating in all the youth activities. He told his mom he wanted to

be a pastor.

Then Paulson left home and attended college in LaCrosse, Wis. He began to party a lot. Then a string of family deaths occurred, including his dad's, and Paulson got angry with God and began to drown his sorrows in alcohol. Lots of alcohol.

His marriage broke up and he became estranged from his two children. He owned and operated a screening construction business.

Paulson eventually remarried and he and his wife Kathy have been together for 36 years. Kathy, a Makoti native, came from a broken marriage as well with a son of her own.

Even though Paulson and Kathy were newlyweds, he continued to drink.

"He told me he was an alcoholic and was going to get sober," Kathy said. "He was a happy drunk, so I thought I could live with that. When it started to affect our finances, I told him one day that if you don't stop you're going to come back one day and I won't be

Paulson was sitting in a bar in Southern California, where they were living at the time. He was there during the noon hour when a young man joined him. Paulson's new drinking friend just completed his court-ordered stint at Alcoholics Anonymous because

of a DUI.

"He was talking about these guys at AA, and he said he'd like to have that,' Paulson said. "I said, 'What are you doing here?' He said, 'I don't want it that bad.' But I did. As he was telling the story of these guys at AA, he was telling the story of me."

Paulson reached in his pocket and counted his beer tabs. He pounded down eight barley pops in that hour and it had little effect on him. He had always been paranoid he would drive drunk and hit a child, a vision that often made him shake. With a big splat, Paulson hit rock bot-

Paulson knew he had a problem, and he wanted to rid himself of those demons. Paulson walked out of the tavern and into his van. With tears streaming down his face, he cried out to God. He told God that if He would help him, he would go to work for Him. But Paulson didn't have a ministry in mind.

"I was in a church where my wife was active, and I was going there to appease her," Paulson said. "What I meant by that was I could become more involved around the church."

After Paulson cried out to God, he drove drunk to that same club the man in the tavern talked about. The club had an AA meeting every hour on the hour, 24 hours a day, 365 days a week. Paulson said he was going to go home to sober up and he would come

Paulson kept his promise to God and God to him. He never missed a meeting that first year and there

were times he'd hit three meetings in a day. He's been sober for 32 years and has repaired his relationship with his children.

"I credit AA and God's grace," Paulson said. "I know I was led there. It started at that bar stool, sitting next to that kid. I've talked about this guy for years, and I don't know his name. He did something to save my life. By the grace of God, I'm alive. I know if I did it again, I'd die."

Paulson went to his pastor while he was getting sober and got the support he needed.

"I said I knew I had a problem, and he said, That's great, that's great. You know who you are,' Paulson said. "People who go through addiction like that and come out the other side do get a pretty good picture of who they are."

While Paulson was getting sober, it was put on his heart to go into the ministry. He attended Luther Seminary in St. Paul, Minn., and was ordained when he was 50. At 74, he's now retired, but has taken on interim assignments for almost nine years.

"You have to pick up a congregation and get them headed in the right direction," said Paulson, who lives in Lincoln and commutes to Beulah. "It's a good ministry. I don't have to be committed for a really long time.

Paulson thrives on helping the broken find their way, especially addicts. He was active in Stephen Ministries in California, becoming trained to help people who are facing a crisis in their life. Paulson has seen and helped those who have faced the darkest sides of

"The 25 years I've been doing this has been about the Good News, understanding our brokenness and how the Good News affects us," Paulson said. "No matter where we are, no matter how good or bad it is, God's love is always there. I don't think I could have done as much with my ministry without this.'

Paulson makes sure he announces to each congregation his jaded past to help his flock see his human side and to give him accountability. Like any addict, the temptations can creep up any time.

"If I can announce that I'm broken too, then that relationship starts," Paulson said. "They know me. When I go into a town, I can't go into a bar or liquor store without getting caught. It helps me. I'm still an alcoholic. I'm vulnerable.

"I have this moniker of a pastor," Paulson continued. "People are resistant about opening up. Some are afraid that you're there and will lord over them. I'm a faithful child of God who falls short for the glory of God."

Paulson encourages those with addictions, or any issues, to come to him for help. Zion hosts AA meetings, which was done by Zoom during COVID. At last week's meeting, nobody showed.

"I tell people if you want to drink, that's your business, but if you want to stop I'll help you," Paulson said. "That's my business. I haven't had anybody come forward yet, but I know they are out there. I have no problem with people drinking, but when it takes

over your life that's when there's a problem."

Paulson also ministered in the oil patch when he lived near Arnegard and first retired. He worked briefly for an oil company and workers found out he was a pastor through people he had confirmed.

"I'd get calls from guys who would say 'Hey Dan, do you feel like talking about Jesus for a while?'" Paulson said. "I'd get phone calls from guys who were living in their trucks. They hadn't been home or seen their wife and kids for a year and they were working 14-hour days. They were exhausted emotionally, physically and spiritually. Most were people who were displaced and they came to a place where they could pay their mortgage or child support. They had marriage problems, real stuff ... real stuff. I enjoyed that part of the ministry. There aren't many pastors around the oil field."

Paulson can give off the impression that he's drunk. He suffers from neuropathy, which causes numbness in his feet that stemmed from back problems.

"I might act like a drunken sailor, but I'm not," Paulson said. "If I fall down I'm too big to pick up. I'll just crawl and find a way to get up. I tell people, don't try to pick me up.'

No matter what life throws at Paulson, he just can't seem to hang up his ministry. After all, there could be somebody out there who might need his guidance in handling the obstacles life throws at them. Paulson has been equipped with the armor of God to handle any situa-




