Sailer retires after nearly 30 years

Saturday afternoon Bronson's celebrated Connie Sailer's retirement. Sailer started working at Bronson's on September 16, 1991.

She remembers her thoughts when she started her job hunt in 1991.

"My daughter was in third grade and my son was in first grade," Sailer said. "I always thought once my son goes to school, I am going to go find a job. That's what I did. I applied here.'

Sailer applied at Bronson's but didn't get the offer she wanted at first.

"They asked me to be in the bakery/deli and I turned them down. I didn't want that," Sailer said.

"When I started as a ca-

shier that's what I wanted to do. I didn't want to be stock or carry out. I enjoyed being a cashier because I enjoyed customers. That's the one thing I'm going to miss, my customers."

Sailer has worked through three generations of Bronson's leadership. Rich and Karen Bronson hired her, then she worked for Kelly and Kim Kessler and now she finds herself working for Rich and Karen's grandchildren (Logan Kessler and Laken Michaelson).

Over the years Sailer worked all over the store. She started as a part-time worker then transitioned into full-time work. She managed the health and beauty department, worked in the office, and trained numer-

ous cashiers.

"I worked in the back office and eventually I became the HPA manager. Then they took me out of the office because I was cashiering, I was a manager, I was doing HPA and office. Now, I'm just cashiering," Sailer said. "I wore a lot of different

hats and then in January, I went part-time. I went three days a week. After January, I just wanted to work parttime."

Sailer joked and laughed while recounting her time at Bronson's. She said it was always fun to train the high school workers on the till. But she'll miss the interactions with customers most.

"Every day you work here is different. It's always something different, something new. Customers make

you laugh. You become like part of their family. I'm going to really miss that, interacting with people. I'm really going to miss that," Sailer said.

Sailer is thankful for her time at Bronson's. After nearly 30 years Sailer said she is thankful for the chance to work.

"I just want to thank evervone for 30 years. Thirty years of memories and the Kesslers, the Bronsons, and the Michaelsons. I just want to thank them for letting

me work here for nearly 30 years," Sailer said. "I have to say it's been an adventure.'

Sailer will be moving to the Bismarck-Mandan area to be closer to her family and grandchildren. But she admits she'll be on the part-time job hunt in the future.

"I'm retiring for now. But down the road, I would still like to work somewhere two days a week. First, I want to get down there and get settled," Sailer said.

STAGE 2 BURN BAN MERCER & OLIVER COUNTY

As of March 19, 2021 Mercer & Oliver County will be under a Stage 2 Burn Ban until further notice. **RESTRICTIONS:**

The following acts are prohibited until further notice:

• Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire of any type, to include pit, burn barrel and/or a campfire. "Note, this change makes it so no fires at all are allowed in the County. Cities & State Parks will set restrictions in their jurisdictions as noted in Exemptions below."

• Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three (3) feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials.

Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame.

Using an explosive.
Operating motorized vehicles off designated roads and trails.

EXEMPTIONS:


Persons with a written permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act. Persons using a device fueled solely by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels that can be turned on and off. Emergency repair of public utilities and railroads.

Persons conducting activities in those designated areas where the activity is specifically authorized by written posted notice. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty. All land within a city boundary is exempted. "Note: All Cities will set their own Fire Ban Rules as they see appropriate." Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame, with extinguishment capabilities immediately accessible. Other exceptions unique to each agency/tribe.

AND REMEMBER...

ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES THIS BURN BAN IS GUILTY OF A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR (NDCC 37-17.1-10.1) PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF UP TO \$1500 AND 30 DAYS IN JAIL. THE MERCER & OLIVER COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENTS ARE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE CITATIONS TO VIOLATORS. When the Burn Ban is lifted, we are asking that all controlled burns be reported to the Sheriff's office, 745-3333 (Mercer) 794-3450 (Oliver), when the fire starts and then another call when the fire has been extinguished, Thank You!
