# It's tea time for the garden

Soil needs feeding too. We spent a couple of hard-labor days earlier this year hauling in composted sheep manure to add some organic fertilizer to our garden. I'm glad we don't do that every year; it's hard work to shovel a couple of tons or more of compost over the garden before we harrow it for planting. It is necessary to feed your soil, and then the soil feeds the plants so we can all enjoy some fresh tomatoes in a couple of months.

If you have a standard size garden or a couple of pots on your patio, it's simple to add nutrients to feed your plants by holding a tea party – no baking required.

Compost teas are an excellent way to use scraps from your kitchen or weeds from your yard to create enriched water for your plants.

There's a ton of banana peels that we toss in the compost bin in the summer months when smoothies are the breakfast of champions at our house.

Banana peels contain nutrients such as potassium, phosphorus, and calcium. When used as a fertilizer, they help improve overall plant strength, stronger stems, more vigorous root development, and more robust fruits.

If you have a compost bin on your cupboard, you also know that those pesky fruit flies love banana peels. A great way to brew the nutrients out of peels is by keeping a pitcher of water in the refrigerator and tossing your bananas in there until you are ready to feed your plants. After about a week in the water, strain out the liquid for your tea. Compost the peel by burying it around your rose bushes in addition to using the tea to water.

If you are a big-time gardener and need lots of fertilizer, here's a method that makes larger quantities of tea.

Save, or acquire, a kitty litter bucket with a two-part lid. Next, drill holes like a salt shaker in the stationary side. If you are using banana peels for this device, the holes only have to be small enough to strain the peels. If you are using this bucket for a weedy compost tea (keep reading), you can make them smaller and closer together.

Fill the bucket with peels and keep it outdoors in a shady place to stay as cool as possible. After a week, dilute this concentrated liquid solution 5:1 (five parts water to one part tea) and apply to the base of your garden plants — this mixture is suitable for potassium-loving plants such as tomatoes and peppers. Banana tea does not contain nitrogen, so it is not a complete fertilizer.

The good news is aphids hate the smell of bananas, so

you are accomplishing two beneficial practices to your garden or flower bed.

To make compost tea, you can use the same kitty litter bucket. Sift your compost to remove any large items like twigs or stones. Fill the bucket one-third full of compost and add water. Rainwater if you have it. Keep the lid closed and maybe even place

a large rock on top to deter any nighttime visitors. This tea will stink, so keep it away from the house, children and pets. Maybe the smell will keep away the raccoons and skunks. One can hope.

Use your tea as you would water. Place in a watering can and pour around the base of your plants. Use it within a day or two as the mixture doesn't keep.

Some years ago, I worked with a lunch lady named Monica on a Farm to School lunch project near Mandan, and she swore by this method of feeding your plants.

Fill a bucket one-third full of manure and the rest with water. You can use chicken, horse, cow, or sheep manure; however, never use the waste from carnivores, such as cats or dogs, as these can contain harmful pathogens. Let your mixture sit for two to three days, giving it a good stir every day. After it's finished steeping, let the solid particles settle to the bottom of the bucket and strain the liquid into another container to apply to your plants. The leftover solids can be added to your compost pile.

To not overdo it, be sure to dilute your manure tea with water until it resembles the color of iced tea, or it will be too intense for plants. You may have to hold your nose or wear a mask when applying this tea once a week to your garden. But your plants won't mind at all. After all, to a farmer, that's the smell of money.

If you do not have animals on your property, ask around or buy some manure at your local farm store.

As much work as weeding your garden is during the first month or so until the plants overtake any weeds, I'm beginning to learn that weeds are just "plants that are out of place." So, rather than kill them all, I'm leaving some for ground cover and saving the ones I pull for weed tea.

Be sure and pull your weeds before they seed, or you will be spreading weeds when you water. And, never use weeds that have been sprayed with a chemical. You can easily find wild growingnutrient-dense weeds for compost tea like alfalfa, yarrow, purslane, chickweed, dandelions, wild fennel, and

stinging nettle nearly everywhere. Comfrey is another weed used for fertilizer tea, and your tomatoes and other fruiting plants will love it. So, here's how. Weed your

garden and toss them into your kitty litter bucket. Top with water, let sit for up to three weeks. When the tea is black and smelly, sorry, gardens must like stinky fertilizer, strain and apply diluted tea (one part tea to ten parts water) as often as once a week. Simply water around the base of your plants with a watering can or spray it onto your plants as a foliar feed.

We save eggshells separate from our compost bin because of the calcium for our tomato plants. You can easily make eggshell tea to feed your plants indoors and out. Rinse your eggshells and put them in a bucket with a loose-fitting lid. They will not stink, don't ask me why. You can crush them or grind them into a powder and dig that into your soil. If you wish to hurry the process, boil a gallon of water in a large pot with 10-20 eggshells. Turn off the heat and allow it to steep overnight. Strain the liquid, compost the shells and use it to water your plants full strength. If you are dedicated, you can also use the water from boiling eggs, cooking potatoes or other vegetables - don't use salted water and allow it to cool, so you don't cook the plant's roots.


These teas are easy to apply as you would water a plant; however, your fruiting and flowering plants will benefit from spray application of fertilizer tea. Spray on the underside of the leaves where the pores are located using a fine mister. Since we are in a drought, you can do this twice a week, early in the morning before the sun and the wind stresses the plants. Never spray or water at night because plants are more easily susceptible to diseases and molds if the leaves are wet for a long time.

Save some money on fertilizer this year and hold a tea party for your plants. They won't need a second invita-

## County burn ban reduced to Stage 1

During their meeting last Wednesday, the Mercer County Commission unanimously approved a motion to return the county to a Stage 1 Burn Ban.

The request for the change came from Carmen Reed, Mercer County **Emergency Response Coor**dinator, who said she had spoken with local fire chiefs and was giving this recommendation.

"We have green up," Reed said. "There's still concern with the subsoils, but as long we had green up, they were OK with it."

Reed said the hot weather, if mixed with other conditions like further extended

dryness or strong winds, could result in the Stage 2 Burn Ban going back into ef-

Stage 1 restrictions include prohibitions of campfires outside of developed recreation or improved sites, but allow most other types of regular fire activities. The ban is tied to North Dakota's state fire danger warning system and mapping, with certain restrictions in place if the county is considered at a high level of fire danger.

At this point, the county commission has not made a final determination about whether fireworks will be allowed. They plan to discuss this and make a decision at their upcoming June 16 meeting.

# STAGE 1 BURN BA

As of June 10, 2021 for Mercer County which includes all Cities within the county, will be under a Stage I Burn Ban ONLY WHEN the ND Fire Danger Ratings Map shows high, very high, extreme and/or a Red Flag warning has been issued for Mercer County. You can see the ND Fire Danger Ratings Map if you go to the following website & scroll down to the middle: https://www.ndresponse.gov/burn-ban-restrictions-fire-danger-maps

#### A STAGE I BURN BAN MEANS:

No controlled burns, no large pit fires and no burning garbage of any kind. No throwing cigarette butts or anything out in a grassy area or any area that may start to burn. No Special burning permission will be given for any reason.

You can have a Campfire in a developed recreational site or improved site, while always keeping an eye on it. You can use grills and units that have an on/off switch in an area that you can safely operate without starting a fire.

Remember even though you are allowed some options to burn this doesn't absolve an individual or organization from liability or responsibility for any fire started by the allowed activity.

#### AND REMEMBER...

ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES THIS BURN BAN IS GUILTY OF A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR (NDCC 37-17.1-10.1) PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF UP TO \$1500 AND 30 DAYS IN JAIL. THE MERCER COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENTS ARE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE CITATIONS TO VIOLATORS.

Stage 2 Burn Ban until further notice.
