Timothy LaPointe, Regional Director, BIA, Great Plains Regional Office, has made the decision to keep the grazing rental rate for allotted lands on Fort Berthold Indian Reservation at \$14.34 per AUM. This decision may be appealed to the Interior Board of Indian Appeals, 801 North Quincy Street, Suite 300, Arlington, Virginia 22203, following 43 CFR, 4.310 - 4.340.

Your notice of appeal must be signed by you or your attorney and must be mailed within 30 days of the date it is posted. It should clearly identify the decision being appealed. If possible, attach a copy of the decision. You must send copies of your notice of appeal to (1) The Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior, 1849 C Street NW, MS-4660-MIB, Washington, D.C. 20240; (2) each interested party known to you; and (3) this office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Great Plains Regional Office, 115 4th Avenue Southeast Ste 400, Aberdeen, S.D. 57401

Your notice of appeal sent to the Interior Board of Indian Appeals must certify that you have sent copies to these parties.

If you file a notice of appeal, the Interior Board of Indian Appeals will notify you of further appeal procedures. If no appeal is timely filed, this decision will become final for the Department of the Interior at the expiration of the appeal period. No extension of time may be granted for filing a notice of appeal.

Add the chicken, salt, pepper and garlic to the slow cooker. Mix it up then flip the chicken skin side up. Sprinkle on the brown sugar. Cook on low for 8 hours or on high for 4 hours.

ONE POT TACO PASTA

Ingredients

- 1 cup Cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 cup Monterey Jack Cheese, shredded
- 4 oz. Velveeta cheese, cut into cubes (equal to 1/3 cup)* can sub with 3/4 cup shredded cheese
- 1 lb. Ground Beef, 85% lean
- 1 Tablespoon Butter
- 2 cloves Garlic, minced
- 1 oz. packet Taco Seasoning
- 1 Tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 2 Tablespoons Tomato paste
- 1 cup Beef broth
- 1 cup Chicken broth
- 1 cup Whole milk, at room temp
- 1 (10 oz.) can Rotel Tomatoes with green chilies, undrained
- 1/2 lb. Medium pasta shells,

Directions

Shred the cheddar and Monterey Jack cheese from a block and set aside. It should be near room temperature when added to the pasta sauce. Cook and crumble the ground beef over medium-high heat in a high-walled pot or dutch oven. Drain grease. Melt the butter in the same pot and add and garlic. Cook for 1 minute. Add all remaining ingredients except the cheese and pasta. Stir to combine. Bring to a gentle boil. Add the pasta and submerge it in the liquid. Cover and cook according to package instructions. Slide a silicone spatula along the bottom of the pot halfway through to lift any ingredients that may be settling to the bottom. Remove cover and ensure the pasta is sufficiently cooked. Taste-test a noodle for doneness before proceeding. If needed, cover and cook longer, until your desired doneness is obtained. Turn heat to low. Gradually stir in cheese until melted. There will be plenty of sauce but it will thicken upon standing and the pasta will continue to absorb it. Serve once desired consistency is obtained.

DAKOTA DATEBOOK

April 1, 2022 — Today marks the day that genetic researcher-turned entrepreneur Cy Ludovicianus started his ranch west of Betruzen in Dupřr County. There he does not raise the usual cattle or horses – or even bison or emu. Instead he is raising prairie dogs. But these are bioengineered prairie dogs whose fur has been genetically modified to emulate the hooks and loops of – Velcro!

According to Dr. Cy, as he's called, he has engineered the

males to have the Velcro hook fur and the females to have the loop type. One problem, so far, has been that the animals become fastened to each other. The scientist says it's quite a sight to see them running around in tandem, but the fact that they can't get through their burrow entrances while, as he calls it "hooked up" has caused an increase in predation that is troublesome. Nonetheless, he hopes for a bright future for this newest North Dakota industry.
