

## NDSU's First Building DAKOTA DATEBOOK

Dakota Datebook written by Merry Helm

May 5, 2022 — It was on this date in 1945 that a Japanese bomb balloon claimed the lives of six people in Oregon. They were the only casualties of World War II in the continental United States. Two of them were the children of Grand Forks railroad engineer, Frank Patzke: 13-year-old Joan and 14-year-old Dick.

Reverend Archie Mitchell and his young expectant wife, Elsie, were hosting an outing for five adolescents who attended Sunday school at the Bly Christian and Missionary Alliance Church. The plan was to have a picnic and do some fishing in the mountains. According to reports, Reverend Mitchell found the main road to the Fremont National Forest blocked by equipment, so he pulled off the road at a different spot where they could fish in a creek.

Mrs. Mitchell and the children got out while Archie was either parking the car or unloading food or both. He heard Joan Patzke say, "Look what I found!" and saw a gigantic balloon she'd discovered caught on some tree branches.

Just a few weeks earlier, one of the other kids, 13-year-old Jay Gifford, had found a weather balloon. He had returned it to the weather station in Klamath Falls, where he was praised for his action. Now, here was another balloon. Someone tugged on one of the balloon's ropes and an on-board bomb detonated. The explosion instantly killed all but the Reverend.

During the previous six months, thousands of hydrogen-filled bomb balloons had been launched from a seaside beach in Honshu, Japan. Each was 33-feet across and carried five bombs – four that would cause fires and one that was meant to kill. Traveling in the jet stream, the balloons crossed the Pacific in approximately three days.

The experiment was short-lived, because censorship in the U.S. kept the enemy from learning whether these weapons were doing their job. It was also expensive.

Originally, the balloons were made of rubberized silk. Then, someone thought of using a special waterproof paper traditionally used for making stencils for textile design. The technique for manufacturing the paper was long and laborious; after the paper was

made, it was waterproofed by soaking in mulberry juice that had been aged many months.

The government had ordered 10 thousand balloons, and one can only imagine how laborious it was to construct them. Individual sheets of this paper were only about the size of a piece of gift wrap, and they had to be spliced together and laminated three to four layers deep. The paste used was derived from a tuber called "devil's-tongue" and was often eaten by hungry workers on the sly.

Final construction required auditorium-size work spaces, but a bigger problem arose when American B-29 bombers took out two of Japan's three hydrogen plants. Without hydrogen, the balloons were grounded.

# The End to the Unicorn Toothbrush

I hear more than normal “dinging and clanging” in the bathroom where my three-year-old is brushing her teeth. For some reason, I feel the need to run in there.

When I get to the door, my three-year-old is “big-eyed” and holding her toothbrush in the air.

“Mom, I dropped my toothbrush in the toilet, and I dug it out, and now I think I need to wash my hands,” she says while still holding her toothbrush in the air.

“Did you brush your teeth with your toothbrush after digging it out of the toilet?” I ask, not sure I am ready to hear her answer.

“No, I didn’t, Mom,” she says. “I brushed my teeth and I was putting the toothbrush away when I dropped it in the toilet.”

I am completely relieved, as we have not had to have the “don’t use a toothbrush after it falls in the toilet” conversation yet.

My daughter throws the toothbrush in the garbage and washes her hands.

This unfortunate end to my daughter’s favorite unicorn toothbrush brought up some questions for me as a parent. How often should my three-year old be brushing her teeth? Should I be helping with all of the brushing?

I took a look at the American Dental Association recommendations for children ages 0-6 and how to take care of their teeth. Here is what I found.

Starting a few days after birth, parents can wipe their baby’s gums with a wash cloth or gauze pad. The average age babies start to get teeth is six months. As soon as babies pop their first tooth, caregivers can start using a toothbrush to clean their

teeth. The American Dental Association recommends scheduling your child’s first dental exam around their first birthday.

Children ages 0-3 can use a “rice” sized amount of toothpaste, while children 3-6 can use a “pea” sized amount when brushing in the morning and at night. The ADA also recommends flossing your children’s teeth as soon as they have teeth that touch each other in their mouth.

As for help with brushing, parents and caregivers can keep assisting as long as they feel their child needs it. An option is to have the child start brushing and then have the parent do some brushing afterward. The child can choose a simple nursery rhyme for caregivers to sing while brushing their teeth.

As for me, I am going to do a better job assisting with teeth brushing for my three-year-old so we don’t have another unfortunate loss of a toothbrush and we are planning to up our teeth brushing from just brushing at night to brushing morning and night.

### Not out of the woods for dry summer

Roughly two feet of snow provides some reprieve for parched land in the area, but not everywhere, and not for long.

“It’s kind of a mixed bag,” Mercer County Extension Agent Craig Askim said of last week’s blizzard and the effects of the snow in the area. “Obviously any kind of moisture we can get is a good thing ... but it depends on where you’re at for how much of a benefit this will be.”

Askim said that the heavy snowfall provides the equivalent of up to three inches of rain throughout Mercer County and the surrounding area. But unlike rainfall, moisture provided by snow is scattered and inconsistent.

“With the wind, snow didn’t stay in one spot,” Askim said. “Sheltered areas, trees and dugouts will benefit. But there are a lot of areas in the county where there is now snow cover whatsoever.”

### Assistance available for ranchers

“I’m expecting it to be some losses, but I don’t really know,” Craig Askim, Mercer County agent with the NDSU Extension Service, said. “I did hear from a couple ranchers where the storm was so bad they couldn’t even reach their cattle.”

### Blizzard leaves Oliver buried

Two county records for snowfall were shattered in last week’s blizzard as more than 20 inches of snow blanketed the area.

According to the National Weather Service, a pair of snowfall records was broken and one 25-year-old record tied in Mercer County last week.

A two-day snowfall record of 18.1 inches, set in March of 2011 in Beulah was broken as 24 inches of the white stuff was recorded just southeast of Hazen between April 13 and 14.

The same site also broke the three-day snowfall record of 21 inches, set in November 2016, with a total of 24.6 inches between April 13 and 15.

The one-day record for snowfall in the county was tied last week as 18 inches fell in Hazen, mirroring the amount that hit Zap in April of 1997.
