







N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: East end of Lake Sakakawea continues producing fair walleye success. Clearing water and improving walleye success south of the Van Hook Arm. No Missouri River or area lake reports.

Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea: Continued fair to good walleye activity on the east end of Lake Sakakawea with good numbers of small fish. No Lake Audubon reports.

Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Hwy. 83 Lawn & Leisure, Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea: East end of Lake Sakakawea producing small walleye around 7 Sisters, Highway 83 embankment, and northeast corner of Mallard Island in 10 to 25 feet. Try plain hooks and leeches or slow death hooks with nightcrawlers. Also try Douglas Bay. Decent walleye bite on Lake Audubon working weed edges with spinners tipped with nightcrawlers or leeches or slow death hooks. Continued smallmouth bass SHICCESS

•Lake Sakakawea, Dakota Waters Resort, Beulah: Try crankbaits in 15 feet along the north shore or nightcrawlers for walleye with generally fair success.

•Lake Sakakawea, Indian Hills Resort, Garrison: Good walleye activity with nice numbers of 18- to 20-inch fish and occasional larger one mixed in. Try 18 to 20 feet with nightcrawlers working throughout the area.

 Lake Sakakawea, New Town: Continued fair to good walleye bite throughout the Van Hook Arm in 10 to 15 feet.

•Missouri River. Dakota Tackle, Bismarck: A few more salmon anglers on the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Try squids, needles squids, or spoons. Lake Audubon OK for walleye.

•Missouri River, Enerbase of Washburn: Hot weather limiting Missouri River reports with most activity on Lake Sakakawea.

•Missouri River System, Scott's Bait & Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River tailrace remains slow to fair from boats for walleye and catfish. Try the blowout or spillway channel for walleye during the day using jigs or Lindy rigs and nightcrawlers with a few in the chutes at night using 3-way swivels, plastics, or crankbaits. Limited trout activity. Also try the tailrace boat ramp at night from shore using live bait with nightcrawlers or jigs and minnows for walleye. Also try casting crankbaits at night along the rocks. Lake Sakakawea remains fair

to good with better success around the north shore. Try 7 Sisters or Steinke and Douglas bays using nightcrawlers with spinners and bottom bouncers, slow death hooks, or Lindy rigs. Work as shallow as 8 feet up to 18 feet and deeper. Best overall walleye success, however, remains west towards Beulah Bay and up into the Van Hook Arm. Some occasional small salmon success on the east end but limited angler numbers.

 McLean Co. area lakes, Cenex of Wilton: Not much fishing activity with hot weather other than fair to good walleye success on Lake Sakakawea.

Sully's Heart River corral DAKOTA DATEBOOK

In July of 1864 General Alfred Sully escorted settlers west to the gold mines of Montana. Throughout the trip Sully was on the lookout for the Yanktonais and Lakotas who had escaped him earlier that summer at the Battle of Whitestone Hill.

A few days into the march, Sully came across the tracks of his adversaries. To launch a more effective attack, General Sully left the settlers at the Heart River, some twenty miles southeast of presentday Richardton on this day in 1864. Following the general's departure, the settlers built fortifications; certain that Sully had been led on a wildgoose chase and the main Indian forces were waiting to attack the supplies Sully had left behind.

Fortunately, no attack ever came. However the remnants of the settler's fortification remain.

Avoid the dreaded garden thugs **DAKOTA GARDENER**

Do you have garden thugs in your landscape? These are garden plants that are overly aggressive and try to take over the garden. They are the equivalent of bullies because they refuse to play nice with other plants.

As a young gardener, I made the mistake of purchasing bishop's weed. The plant looked innocent enough and featured mint green leaves with cream-colored margins. The garden center marketed the plant as a groundcover. That was an understatement! Left unchecked, this garden thug could have covered the entire backyard.

Bishop's weed has characteristics that aid in its aggression. This perennial has rhizomes, underground stems that creep below the soil's surface and send out new shoots as it continually spreads.

You may have your own rhizomatous thugs in the garden. Lily of the valley, gooseneck loosestrife, blue lyme grass and mint can all get

out of control if not carefully supervised.

Garden thugs can also spread by seed. One spring I transplanted eight beautiful tall verbena plants into my flower garden. With its annual life cycle, I didn't anticipate problems. However, the next spring, I discovered 1000 seedlings in the same area.

Other garden thugs that self-seed include shasta daisy, golden marguerite and flowering tobacco.

The best way to avoid garden thugs is to research plant characteristics before buying plants at the garden center. However, even the most astute gardener will eventually introduce an aggressive plant into the garden.

To prevent prolific selfseeding, remove the spent flowers before the seeds fall to the ground.

Rhizomatous plants can be contained by the use of barriers such as sidewalks or deep edging. In the case of mint, many gardeners prevent the root system from spreading by encasing the plant in a pot that is sunk into the soil.

When plants get out of control, gardeners can turn

to herbicides to get the upper hand. Non-selective herbicides that contain the active ingredient, glyphosphate, can kill aggressive plants. Care must be taken to prevent the herbicide from making contact with desirable plants.

All joking aside, one plant is more serious than all of the previously mentioned garden thugs. Purple loosestrife is more like the mafia and is officially a noxious weed in North Dakota, South Dakota, Minnesota and Montana.

This beautiful but dangerous plant was sold in the garden trade for many decades and is still found in home gardens. Purple loosestrife is a super spreader if it escapes into wetlands and areas adjacent to rivers and streams. It has a competitive advantage because it spreads by both rhizomes and seeds. A plant can produce over 2 million seeds each year. In no time, the noxious weed can form dense colonies that will crowd out native vegetation and deprive wildlife of native habitat.


