

Dakota Recreation Report

Outdoor Notes:

•Anglers reminded to follow ANS regulations, including draining live wells and removing plugs.

•Applications such as Onyx now have updated electronic posting information for the upcoming 2022 hunting season.

•Blue-green algae updates, N.D. Dept. of Environmental Quality: No area advisories or warnings listed but conditions could change daily. Several N.D. lakes have low toxin levels, including Buffalo Lodge Lake, McHenry Co.; Hecker Lake, McLean Co., and Nelson Lake, Oliver Co. Go to the agency website, (deq. nd.gov) for more information.

•Registration now open for the Sept. 16 - 18 Wild Outdoor Women workshop, Lake Metigoshe State Park, Bottineau. Information is available at the N.D. Parks and Recreation Dept. website, (www.parkrec.nd.gov/events/ fall-wild-outdoor-women).

•Aug. 15: Swan applications due.

•N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: Anglers continue finding fair walleye success on both Lake Sakakawea and Lake Audubon in deeper water. Remember to keep fish caught from 25 feet and deeper. South side of Lake Sakakawea around the face of the dam and east producing a few more salmon. No reports from area lakes.

•Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea: Most activity on the east end of Lake Sakakawea focuses around Indian Hills and Deepwater Bay with some success yet farther east. Work points in 25 to 30 feet with slow death

hooks and nightcrawlers.

·Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Hwy. 83 Lawn & Leisure, Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea: Work deep in 25 to 35 feet around Mallard or Alcatraz islands and south shore points towards Expansion Bay on the south side along the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Also try Highway 83 humps on the north shore using slow death hooks with bottom bouncers and nightcrawlers. Decent walleye bite on Lake Audubon in 25 to 40 feet using spinners and nightcrawlers or leeches, if available. Work Highway 83 embankment or weed lines. Continued smallmouth bass activity using drop shot rigs. Some muskie success. Work suspended over deeper water using a variety of presentations. Remember to release all muskie less than 48 inches.

•Lake Sakakawea, Dakota Waters Resort, Beulah: Continued walleye success throughout the area working deeper in 35 feet-plus with some anglers switching back to minnows.

•Lake Sakakawea, Indian Hills Resort, Garrison: Continued fair to good walleye activity in 20 to 25 feet with better success along the north shore.

•Lake Sakakawea, New Town: Walleye success slowed but look for some activity working deeper in 25-feet and more.

•Missouri River, Dakota Tackle, Bismarck: OK salmon success on the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Much of Lake Sakakawea producing nice walleye success.

•Missouri River, Enerbase of Washburn: Continued fair to good walleye success throughout much of Lake Sakakawea. Look for Nelson Lake to produce activity, as well.

·Missouri River System, Scott's Bait & Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River tailrace continues producing catfish from both boat and shore. Try floating jigs and nightcrawlers or smelt pieces from shore by the ramp or spillway area. Boat success remains slow for walleye with best success at night with good catfish activity. Try shore-fishing off the rocks at night for walleye. Lake Sakakawea producing walleye on the east end before noon in 30 feet around the Riverdale Bluffs on the south shore or Douglas Bay on the north side. Try slow death hooks with bottom bouncers and nightcrawlers. Move around and work points. A few walleye from shore back in the bays but generally inconsistent. Salmon slowed a little but try working above the thermocline in 85 to 115 feet using deep presentations



with flashers and squids or herring

•McLean Co. area lakes, Cenex of Wilton: Continued success on Lake Sakakawea. Also try New Johns. Best bait remains nightcrawlers.

A Record Flight

DAKOTA DATEBOOK

On this day in 1929 Dwight "Barney" Zimmerley swooped low over the town of Cogswell, ND. Zimmerley was on a record flight from Brownsville, Texas, to Winnipeg. He flew nonstop for 1,725 miles, easily beating the old record of 758 miles. On his return flight, Zimmerley stopped in Stirum and Cogswell for the night, and residents held a banquet and reception for the new record-holder and former Cogswell boy.

Residents reminisced about Zimmerley's earlier feats in Cogswell. He'd been the first to have an automobile, and according to the Cogswell Enterprise, this is how he got the nickname "Barney."

"Frightening horses and careening his machine through the streets, he soon acquired the name of Barney, for it was at that time that Barney Oldfield was at the peak of his glory as a pilot of high-speed machines," said

the Enterprise. It was a fitting nickname for Zimmerley, who proved that he, too, was a master pilot of high-speed machines when on this day in 1929, he claimed the record for the longest nonstop flight.

Take steps to keep your digestive system working

"What is the topic of your grant proposal?" I asked the person sitting next to me on a

Our conversation occurred nearly a decade ago, but I still remember it. She was a medical doctor working in gastrointestinal research.

"It's a new line of research," she said. "We are investigating fecal transplants as a way to treat infections."

I looked at her with raised eyebrows.

"Did I hear you correctly?" I asked.

"Yes, they are called 'poop pills' in some of the literature, she said with a chuckle.

My traveling acquaintance certainly did not offer me a pill containing a freeze-dried 'sample."

I may have needed a parachute if that were the case.

In 2022, the pills are still being investigated for safety and effectiveness in treating tough infections. Researchers were compiling results to submit to the Food and Drug Administration this year.

What we eat and drink affects our health. Healthful food intake and regular elimination are key parts of the equation.

You may be familiar with the term "gut microbiome." This term refers to the different species of microorganisms living in our intestines.

The pills being investigated are designed to "re-colonize" the gut with healthy bacteria. Antibiotic treatment for serious bacterial infections can lead to changes to gut bacteria.

According to some estimates, our large intestine, or colon, is home 100 trillion "friendly"

make certain vitamins such as vitamin K. These bacteria help break down extra food residue in the small intestine. This process in the colon is known

as fermentation.

Our bacteria can become imbalanced due to stress, diarrhea, changes in diet and antibiotics. Consuming fruits, vegetables, whole grains, nuts, probiotics and prebiotics can help our bacteria stay within a healthy balance.

Most people experience some digestive issues from time to time. Sometimes travel and a change in diet can affect our gut functioning, leading to the discomfort of constipation.

Choosing healthful foods and drinking enough fluid help keep our gut functioning.

You may be familiar with the terms "probiotics" and "prebiotics." The good news is that they are readily available from foods and beverages.

"Probiotics" literally means "for life." Probiotics produce lactic acid in the gut. They slow the growth of disease-causing bacteria, compete with diseasecausing bacteria and break down toxins.

We can get probiotics from foods with "live and active cultures." Yogurt, kefir (a fermented product sold in the dairy case), buttermilk and sauerkraut are among the readily available sources.

"Prebiotics" help the good bacteria in the colon grow. They act as a food source for the bacteria. Some of the best sources are raisins, plums, wheat, dry edible beans and garlic.

Take care of your digestive system with these tips.

Consume a balanced diet with plenty of fiber from grains, fruits and vegetables. Stay hydrated, not only in the heat

of summer months but all year. Eat smaller, more frequent meals instead of large meals.

Accumulate 30 minutes of moderate physical activity on

Place the seasoned radishes on a baking pan or in a cast iron skillet. Roast for 20 minutes, tossing occasionally, until tender and caramelized. While the radishes are roasting, place the cannellini beans in the same mixing bowl and add 1 tablespoon olive oil, lemon juice and garlic powder. Season with salt and pepper to taste. When the radishes are done roasting, add them to the bowl with the beans and add

parsley. Sprinkle with feta cheese and adjust seasonings as necessary. Serve warm.

Makes eight servings. Without added salt, each serving has 120 calories, 5 grams (g) fat, 6 protein, 14 g carbohydrate, 4 g fiber and 190 milligrams sodium.
