

Dakota Recreation Report

Outdoor Notes:

•Hunters reminded to put identification on tree stands and blinds when set up on N.D. Game & Fish Dept. WMAs.

•PLOTS guide now available online at the Game & Fish Dept. website with printed editions also available at vendors.

•Anglers reminded to follow ANS regulations, including draining live wells and removing plugs.

•Applications such as Onyx now have updated electronic posting information for the 2022 hunting season.

•Sept. 16: Youth deer season opens.

•Sept. 17: Youth waterfowl season opens.

•Sept. 24: Resident waterfowl season opens.

•Sept. 24: Sakakawea Pheasants Forever Fall Pheasant Fest, Garrison City Auditorium, 5:30 p.m.

•Sept. 25: Youth deer season closes.

•Oct. 1: Nonresident waterfowl season opens.

Fishing:

Lake Sakakawea elevation, Sept. 12: 1,834.67 feet above mean sea level; 21,000 cubic feet per second (CFS) Garrison Dam average daily releases.

Missouri River gauge height, Stanton: River stage, 7.38 feet.

Missouri River gauge height, Washburn: River stage, 10.1 feet.

•N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: No new reports from the Missouri River System.

•Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: East end of Lake Sakakawea slowed but try working slow presentations in 30 to 35 feet. Also try longlining with crankbaits.

*Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Hwy. 83 Lawn & Leisure, Garrison: Switch to minnows for walleye in 25 to 35 feet on the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Try plain Lindy rigs and 2 minnows. Continued

good smallmouth bass activity on Lake Audubon but walleye remain slow.

•Lake Sakakawea, Dakota Waters Resort, Beulah: OK walleye success with better success along the north shore. Try Nishu Bay in 40 to 45 using Lindy rigs and minnows. Also try nightcrawlers, yet. Look for the fall bite to start soon once the lakes begins turning and fish go on the move. Resort closed after Sept. 25.

•Lake Sakakawea, Indian Hills Resort, Garrison: Bait shop closed but access still available.

•Lake Sakakawea, New Town: Scattered walleye success in the Van Hook Arm and the river portion around New Town. Switch to minnows rather than nightcrawlers.

•Missouri River, Dakota Tackle, Bismarck: OK walleye success on Lake Sakakawea but fish remain deep so keep anything caught in deeper water of 25 feet and more. Look for improving shore-fishing activity for salmon on the east end of Sakakawea.

•Missouri River, Enerbase of Washburn: Some activity on Missouri River and Lake Sakakawea but generally slow walleye success.

•Missouri River System, Scott's Bait & Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River tailrace continues producing walleye during the day from boats with fair to good catfish success. Limited trout and salmon, however. Shore bite remains better at night for a few walleye using crankbaits. Wing walls slow.

East end of Lake Sakakawea still producing salmon in 70 feet and deeper using white flashers and white squids. Try morning hours from shore using spoons, Mepps spinners, or crankbaits as some fish move into shallower water. Look for more shallow success as the spawn begins. Most salmon are still in the 6- to 7-pound range with limited numbers of larger spawning fish showing up yet. Try deep on the bottom in 50 feet for walleye farther west around Beulah and Beaver bays.

•McLean Co. area lakes, Cenex of Wilton: Continued activity on smaller area lakes and Lake Sakakawea. Try a mix of nightcrawlers and minnows.

Hunting:

•Deer: Movement remains slow but look for more evening activity when temperatures cool.

•Dove: Numbers generally remain strong.

•Upland: Mixed success across parts of central N.D. OK grouse numbers in pockets with overall better partridge numbers.

Listen to your gut

PRAIRIE DOC® PERSPECTIVES

People often talk about having a “gut feeling” when they know something is wrong. What feelings come when there is something wrong with the digestive system itself and how do you differentiate between “butterflies” acting up and a serious gastrointestinal problem?

There are many different organs that can cause GI problems and may include the esophagus, stomach, the small intestine, and the large intestine.

The esophagus is the tube that connects the mouth to the stomach. The most common issue people have with the esophagus is acid reflux or “heartburn.” Reflux is a burning sensation in the chest and frequently includes a taste of acid in the back of the throat. Occasional heartburn can be a nuisance, but chronic heartburn can lead to damage to the cells in the esophagus and cause them to change in appearance. This change makes them more likely to develop into cancer over time.

A common stomach issue is ulcers, or an erosion of the lining of the stomach. Ulcers are painful and the pain worsens after eating due

to stomach acid being released during digestion. Ulcers are often caused by the bacteria H. Pylori that your doctor, ulcers can test for.

The small intestine connects the stomach and the large intestine and is the longest part of the digestive system. This organ is also where most of the nutrients from your food are absorbed. Issues with the small intestine can lead to diarrhea, malnutrition, and bleeding which could result in anemia. Problems with the small intestine cannot only result in discomfort, but also contribute to nutritional problems which can affect the rest of the body.

Celiac disease, Crohn’s disease and small intestine bacterial overgrowth all affect the small intestine. These disorders can cause abdominal pain, severe diarrhea, fatigue, weight loss, and malnutrition.

The colon or large intestine can suffer from irritable bowel syndrome. Irritable Bowel Syndrome (IBS) is not fully understood but is thought to

be at least partially caused by an abnormality in the brain-gut interaction. It can lead to diarrhea, constipation, or a mixture of both. It also causes cramps, bloating, excessive gas, and abdominal pain. Another large intestinal issue is Diverticulitis which results when “pockets” in the colon called diverticula become inflamed and infected. Often individuals with Diverticulitis have left lower abdominal pain, fever, nausea and vomiting.

As you can see there can be many different complex conditions that can cause your gut to give you “feelings” and many of these conditions have overlapping signs and symptoms. If you have any concerns regarding your gastrointestinal tract, you should talk to your primary care doctor. They can help direct you for further testing which may include a referral to a gastroenterologist or surgeon. Most importantly, remember to listen to what your gut is telling you so you can start feeling better soon.

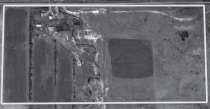

Brussels sprouts, re-evaluating a detested vegetable DAKOTA GARDENER

As a child, I wouldn’t eat vegetables for over a decade. My poor parents spent countless hours at the dinner table trying to convince me to eat a variety of foods. After becoming a teenager, I finally discovered the joy of eating freshly grown garden produce.

Despite turning over a new leaf, I avoided trying Brussels sprouts for over 30 years because of their reputation as a stinky, mushy and bitter vegetable.

One day, I was dining with a client at a restaurant in the Twin Cities. The chef served roasted Brussels sprouts in a balsamic glaze as a side dish. I gingerly tried this detested vegetable and proceeded to clean my plate.

Brussels sprouts have a bad reputation for a couple of reasons. First, many people don’t know how to prepare to optimize their flavor. The stereotypical cooking method is to boil them into a gray, soggy mess. A more flavorful method is to roast them in the oven in a little oil with your

favorite seasonings such as garlic salt and parmesan. They become crispy and caramelized when baked.

Another reason that Brussels sprouts have a bad reputation is that older cultivars used to taste bitter. In the 1990s, Dutch scientist Hans van Doorn isolated the compounds responsible for the bitter flavor. As a result, seed companies were able to breed and select cultivars that contained less of these compounds.

Fall is a great time to give Brussels sprouts a first try (or a second chance) as they will be coming into season at farmers markets around the region after the first frost. Exposure to frosts enhance the flavor of the sprouts.

If you discover that you adore the complex flavors as much as my family does, consider growing them in your garden next year.

Brussels sprouts are a long-season crop that are timed to mature after the first frosts. Most gardeners in the region transplant seedlings into the garden in late May or early June but this is dependent upon the cultivar’s days to

maturity. Transplants may be purchased from local nurseries or seeds sowed indoors 4 to 6 weeks before transplanting.

To achieve a bountiful crop, irrigate the plants during dry spells and fertilize before sprout formation. It is normally a low-maintenance crop with the exception of insect pests.

The dreaded cabbage worms and loopers are the biggest pests. Brussels sprouts are in the same plant family as cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower, and kale. Consequently, they attract a lot of the same pests. Fortunately, these insects can be sustainably managed using products that contain *Bacillus thuringiensis* (B.t.).

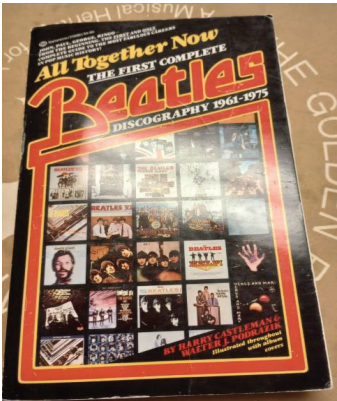
Harvest after frost exposure when the individual sprouts are firm when pinched. Picking can continue until the temperature reaches the mid-twenties. Also keep in mind that bigger is not better. The ideal sprout size is in between one and two inches.

Happy gardening! I double dare you to eat and grow this delicious crop.
