

Allen Mettler

DAKOTA DATEBOOK

The remains of tens of thousands of American POWs and MIAs ranging from World War Two to the Gulf War have yet to be located and identified. Leading the charge to search for these servicemen and women missing in action is the Joint POW/MIA Accounting Command. Known simply as JPAC, it's staffed by 400 civilian contractors and military personnel from all branches of the Armed Forces working towards the JPAC motto, "Until they are home."

With fifteen Recovery Teams and the largest forensic anthropology laboratory in the world, JPAC recovers and identifies on average six MIA Americans each month. To date, over 1,400 Americans have been identified.

Among those successfully recovered and identified by JPAC was North Dakota native, Corporal Allen Mettler.

Born in Morton County in 1930 Allen L. Mettler graduated from Mandan High School in 1948 before serving in the Korean War as a Light Weapons Infantryman. On February 11, 1951, Mettler's Army unit was overtaken by enemy soldiers. One of the few to survive the ambush, Mettler was marched to a POW camp where he died shortly after his capture. Mettler's family was informed two years after his death that he had died of malnutrition.

Over 40 years later, after an agreement with North Korea, the remains of several unidentified American servicemen were transported to Hawaii. With the assistance of family members, the remains of Allen Mettler were positively identified in 2006.

Fifty-five years after leaving home for the Korean War, Corporal Allen Mettler finally returned to North Dakota. On this day in 2006, Mettler's body was laid to rest with full military honors in the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery south of Mandan. Over thirty family members attended the ceremony including Mettler's mother and

step-brother. Also in attendance was Korean War veteran, John Schafer. For Schafer, who witnessed Mettler's capture in 1951, the ceremony brought back a lot of memories. "I still have nightmares..." Schafer recalled at the ceremony, "So, it brings back those memories, but it's part of healing."

For Allen Mettler's family and friends, the Joint POW/MIA Accounting Command was able to bring a sense of closure after more than fifty years. But their work goes on, pledging to continue searching "Until they are home."

DAKOTA RECREATION REPORT

Outdoor Notes:

- Hunters reminded to put identification on tree stands and blinds when set up on N.D. Game & Fish Dept. WMAs.
- Waterfowl hunters reminded to follow ANS regulations when hunting from boats.
- Applications such as Onyx now have updated electronic posting information for the 2022 hunting season.
- Oct. 1: Nonresident waterfowl season opens.
- Oct. 1 & 2: Youth pheasant season.
- Oct. 7: Elk season opens for lottery license holders in units E1, E2, E6, and E1W.
- Oct. 7: Moose season opens for lottery license holders in units M5, M6, M8, M9, M10, and M11.
- Oct. 8: Pheasant and fall turkey seasons open.
- Oct. 15: Audubon Nat'l. Wildlife Refuge Fall Festival in celebration of Nat'l. Wildlife Refuge Week. Hosted by Refuge Friends organization.

Fishing:

- Lake Sakakawea elevation, Sept. 26: 1,834.09 feet above mean sea level; 14,200 cubic feet per second (CFS) Garrison Dam average daily releases.
- Missouri River gauge height, Stanton: River stage, 6.69 feet.
- Missouri River gauge height, Washburn: River stage, 8.3 feet.
- N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: Not much

Missouri River System activity.

- Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Limited activity on the east end of Lake Sakakawea but those anglers going out continue finding some walleye success. Salmon moving into shallower water with the spawn getting underway.

- Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Hwy. 83 Lawn & Leisure, Garrison: Lake Sakakawea still has some deep water walleye activity on the east end but fewer anglers on the water. Try Lindy rigs and bottom bouncers. Try morning hours for salmon. Work 30 to 40 feet on Lake Audubon for walleye, as well. Continued good smallmouth success.

- Lake Sakakawea, Indian Hills Resort, Garrison: Bait shop closed for the season.

- Lake Sakakawea, New Town: Continue working deep water for an occasional walleye. Not many anglers out.

- Missouri River, Dakota Tackle, Bismarck: Missouri River tailrace producing a mix of trout, salmon, and walleye. Try Mepps No. 5 or spoons for salmon in morning and evening low light hours on Lake Sakakawea in Scoria Bay.

- Missouri River, Enerbase of Washburn: Little activity on the Missouri River or area lakes.

- Missouri River System, Scott's Bait & Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River tailrace remains slow for walleye and salmon but good catfish success continues from both boat and shore using a variety of presentations. around working points. Salmon moving shallow with a bite from top water down to deep water. Try a variety of presentations. Lake Audubon improving for walleye success but limited angler numbers.

*McLean Co. area lakes, Cenex of Wilton: Activity slowing on the river and area lakes with hunting seasons underway. Anglers switching to minnows with nightcrawlers unavailable now.

Hunting:

•Doves: Birds bunching up with increasing numbers moving out.

•Upland: Fair ruffed grouse numbers in the Turtle Mountains woods.

•Waterfowl: Fair numbers around the east end of the Missouri River System but not many wetlands surrounding the midsection of Lake Sakakawea with limited waterfowl numbers. Northwest

and north-central N.D. have fair to good local duck numbers. Wetland conditions remain fair in north-central N.D., as well. A slight movement of northern birds, including scattered snow geese, into the northern tier of the state. Central N.D. has nice duck numbers with generally fair opening weekend success. Good local duck numbers in the northeast.
