

# DAKOTA RECREATION REPORT

**Outdoor notes:**

- It is illegal to chase, harass, and pursue any wildlife species, including coyotes, with snowmobile or tracked vehicles.
- Reminder that most roads and trails closed to hunting if posted on both sides.
- Hunters reminded to put identification on tree stands and blinds when set up on N.D. Game & Fish Dept. WMAs.
- Nov. 29: Dove season closes.
- Dec. 1: Snowmobile N.D. trails open, snow conditions permitting. Go to their website, (snowmobilend.org) and click “Trail conditions” for information.
- Dec. 4: Low Plain duck, merganser, and coot seasons close.
- Dec. 5: N.D. Game & Fish Dept. public advisory meeting, New Rockford Eagles Club, 7 p.m.

**Fishing:**

- Devils Lake elevation: 1,449.24 feet above mean sea level (MSL).
- Stump Lake elevation: 1,449.29 MSL.
- Lake Sakakawea elevation: 1,832.99 MSL; 15,300 cubic feet per second average (CFS) Garrison Dam daily releases.
- N.D. Game & Fish Dept. Dist. game wardens: No reports.
- Devils Lake, Ed’s Bait Shop, Devils Lake: Smaller area lakes iced over but no access recommended yet.
- Devils Lake, Lakeview Lodge, Minnewaukan: No new reports.
- Devils Lake, Woodland Resort, Devils Lake: Bays icing over but unsafe for access yet.
- Foster County area lakes, Dry Dock, Carrington: Area lakes iced over but walk-on activity not recommended yet.
- Jamestown Reservoir, Pioneer Bait & Tackle, Jamestown: Little activity on area lakes.
- Jamestown Reservoir, Sooper Stop, Jamestown: No new reports.
- Lake Ashtabula, The Hungry Pelican at the Crossing, Luverne: Lake icing over but access not recommended.
- Lake Ashtabula, Bayshore, Valley City: Lake icing over

with variable ice depths. No access advised yet.

- Lake Sakakawea, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Back bays on the east end of Lake Sakakawea icing over but unsafe for any walk-on fishing activity.
- Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Hwy. 83 Lawn & Leisure, Garrison: Lake Audubon and back bays of Lake Sakakawea icing over but no walk-on activity yet with unsafe ice conditions.
- Lake Sakakawea/Lake Audubon/Missouri River, Scott’s Bait and Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River tailrace remains quiet. No activity on Lake Sakakawea with back bays icing over but unsafe for access.

- Pheasants: Snow pushed birds into heavy cover.
- Waterfowl: Snow geese moved out with some Canada geese on the open water of Lake Sakakawea and Missouri River yet as long as they can get to fields to feed.

# Minot’s Japanese Americans in World War II

## DAKOTA DATEBOOK

The Japanese attack at Pearl Harbor on Sunday, December 7, 1941, plunged the U.S. into World War II. Congress declared war on Japan the following day, December 8.

On that same day, the Japanese-American residents of Minot placed an advertisement in the Minot Daily News to tell of their loyalty to the U.S., entitling it: “A Statement By the Japanese People Of Minot.” It read: “Japan has made a cowardly attack upon the United States. Her military leaders have plunged Japan into a conflict in which the inevitable end for her is a crushing and deserving defeat. The United States is OUR HOME, OUR COUNTRY. She must and will end this war which was not of her choosing. Eagerly we await the opportunities to prove the

sincerity of these words, and our loyalty to America. Count us in, we ask, in the task that lies ahead to smash forever the military machine which stabbed without warning.”

Despite this pledge, on the very next day, Tuesday, December 9th, U.S. Treasury Department agents, assisted by F.B.I. agents and local police, marched into two Japanese-owned restaurants in Minot, asked all customers to leave, and informed the two owners that the government was taking over the properties.

The owners, Roy Yanagita and Tom Toyama, also had their Minot bank accounts frozen by the Treasury Department. Both Yanagita and Toyama faced background investigations, but were allowed to re-open their restaurants on December 20 following an eleven-day shutdown.

On the evening before the re-

opening, Tom Toyama bought another ad to tell his customers that he was truly thankful for their patronage and treatment he enjoyed from the people of Minot for the twenty-six years he had served them in his Caf . “Everything I have in the world,” Toyama wrote, “is in Minot.” He gave heartfelt thanks to the hundreds who expressed sympathy for the recent closing, and he was grateful for the support he had been given in what he called the darkest moment of his life.

## Lung cancer screening saves lives

This year nearly 250,000 patients will be diagnosed with lung cancer and 130,000 will die from it. In SD, 660 people will be diagnosed and over 400 will die from the disease. Lung cancer accounts for the most cancer deaths in both the US and in SD.

Smoking is the most important risk factor for lung cancer and accounts for 80% of lung cancer deaths. Although smoking rates continue to decline in the US, in SD there are many rural and tribal communities where the smoking rates are still 20-40%. These patients continue to be at risk for developing and dying from lung cancer. The Lakota Sioux have the highest lung cancer death rates in the nation at 95%.

Lung cancer screening with low-dose computed tomography (LDCT) has been demonstrated to reduce lung cancer death rates by detecting earlier stages of cancer with relatively high cure rates – similar to other screen detectable cancers such as cervical, prostate, breast and colorectal. An LDCT is a five-minute, outpatient CT scan performed without IV contrast and has minimal radiation exposure. The current recommendations are for healthy adults ages 50-80 with a 20 pack year smoking history or who have quit within the last 15 years.

Unfortunately, many SD patients are at risk, and are unaware of the value of an LDCT. In SD, there are at least 30,000 patients who are eligible for this test.

If patients are diagnosed with early stage lung cancer, surgery is the standard treatment with high cure rates. If patients are not surgical candidates, they can be safely treated with 4 to 5 radiation doses, called stereotactic ablative radio-surgery, with essentially no side effects and also very high cure rates. This specialized form of radiation is offered at most cancer centers in SD.

To address the high lung cancer death rates among the Lakota Sioux, we implemented a lung cancer screening navigation program on the west river reservations in an attempt to lower these death rates as part of an ongoing program called Walking Forward that has been in existence since 2002. This is a community-based program based in Rapid City with staff who live and work in their communities of Pine Ridge and Rosebud. The overarching program goal is to lower cancer death rates for Lakota Sioux, through patient navigation, access to cancer screening and early detection and state of the art cancer treatments. To date we have referred over 420 patients for an LDCT with

over 335 completed scans.

So, if you are a smoker: 1) try to quit; 2) if you are a candidate for lung cancer screening talk to your primary care provider about an LDCT, and 3) for the younger generation – don't start smoking!

Bottom Line: lung cancer can be successfully treated if caught early – get screened if you are eligible.
