•Nov. 29: Dove season closes.

DAKOTA GARDENER-

Growing paperwhites is fun and easy

Are you looking for a fun holiday project?

There is nothing easier to grow than paperwhites. Just add some rocks and water, and you can enjoy flowers in a month!

Paperwhites are sold online and at garden centers this time of year. You can plant them in a pot with soil, but I like to grow them in glass bowls with water to watch their roots grow. It's fascinating.

The most common variety of paperwhites is Ziva. It grows vigorously and has pure-white blooms. Bulb companies say Ziva has a spicy fragrance, but I think they stink. Try them and judge for yourself.

I once gave my girlfriend some Ziva paperwhites as a gift. My intentions were nice, but she smelled them and thought I wanted to break up with her. I quickly learned that diamonds are a girl's best friend; Ziva paperwhites are not.

Other varieties have more delicate and pleasing scents.

Grand Soleil d'Or has yellow petals surrounding an orange cup. Chinese Sacred Lily has white petals and a gold cup. Both of these are lovely choices.

Grow your paperwhites in a glass bowl. If you don't have one, your local dollar store is a great place to buy one.

Tall, columnar bowls work especially well. They keep the 18-inch paperwhite stems upright, preventing them from flopping over.

Place about 3 to 4 inches of stones in the bowl. Rocks or gravel will work, but you can add a special touch by using marbles, glass beads or decorative stones.

Then add the bulbs, gently pressing their bottoms down into the stones. Set the bulbs so they are close to each other without touching. The stones should cover the lower half of the bulbs.

Then add water into the bowl, putting just enough water to touch the base of the bulbs. Maintain water at that level.

Keep your paperwhites in a cool (60s), dark place to encourage strong rooting. Move the bowl to a bright spot after you see roots emerging.

It's time for a shot of booze. Not for you, but for the bulbs.

Research from Cornell University has shown that alcohol can make paperwhite stems shorter and sturdier.

Dump the old water out of the bowl and replace it using a water solution with 4 to 6% alcohol. You can use 70% rubbing alcohol (1 part rubbing alcohol to 11 parts water). Distilled spirits such as gin, vodka or tequila can be used. These are approximately 40% alcohol, so 1 part booze to 7 parts water will work. Adjust concentrations if needed and continue watering with this solution.

Adding alcohol to the water is not necessary. If you do add alcohol, do not overdo it. Don't use beer or wine as they contain sugars that may damage the bulbs.

Grow your paperwhites under cool temps (60s) and bright, indirect light. In about a month, your paperwhites will be blooming. It's that easy!

Decorate the holidays with paperwhites! They are fun to grow and beautiful!

Minot's Japanese Americans in World War II DAKOTA DATEBOOK

The Japanese attack at Pearl Harbor on Sunday, December 7, 1941, plunged the U.S. into World War II. Congress declared war on Japan the following day, December 8.

On that same day, the Japanese-American residents of Minot placed an advertisement in the Minot Daily News to tell of their loyalty to the U.S., entitling it: "A Statement By the Japanese People Of Minot." It read: "Japan has made a cowardly attack upon the United States. Her military leaders have plunged Japan into a conflict in which the inevitable end for her is a crushing and deserving defeat.

The United States is OUR HOME, OUR COUNTRY. She must and will end this war which was not of her choosing. Eagerly we await the opportunities to prove the

sincerity of these words, and our loyalty to America. Count us in, we ask, in the task that lies ahead to smash forever the military machine which stabbed without warning."

Despite this pledge, on the very next day, Tuesday, December 9th, U.S. Treasury Department agents, assisted by F.B.I. agents and local police, marched into two Japaneseowned restaurants in Minot, asked all customers to leave, and informed the two owners that the government was taking over the properties.

The owners, Roy Yanagita and Tom Toyama, also had their Minot bank accounts frozen by the Treasury Department. Both Yanagita and Toyama faced background investigations, but were allowed to re-open their restaurants on December 20 following an eleven-day shutdown.

On the evening before the re-

opening, Tom Toyama bought another ad to tell his customers that he was truly thankful for their patronage and treatment he enjoyed from the people of Minot for the twenty-six years he had served them in his Cafй. "Everything I have in the world," Toyama wrote, "is in Minot." He gave heartfelt thanks to the hundreds who expressed sympathy for the recent closing, and he was grateful for the support he had been given in what he called the darkest moment of his life.





Lung cancer screening saves lives

This year nearly 250,000 patients will be diagnosed with lung cancer and 130,000 will die from it. In SD, 660 people will be diagnosed and over 400 will die from the disease. Lung cancer accounts for the most cancer deaths in both the US and in SD.

Smoking is the most important risk factor for lung cancer and accounts for 80% of lung cancer deaths. Although smoking rates continue to decline in the US, in SD there are many rural and tribal communities where the smoking rates are still 20-40%. These patients continue to be at risk for developing and dying from lung cancer. The Lakota Sioux have the highest lung cancer death rates in the nation at 95%.

Lung cancer screening with low-dose computed tomography (LDCT) has been demonstrated to reduce lung cancer death rates by detecting earlier stages of cancer with relatively high cure rates - similar to other screen detectable cancers such as cervical, prostate, breast and colorectal. An LDCT is a five-minute, outpatient CT scan performed without IV contrast and has minimal radiation exposure. The current recommendations are for healthy adults ages 50-80 with a 20 pack year smoking history or who have quit within the last 15 years.

Unfortunately, many SD patients are at risk, and are unaware of the value of an LDCT. In SD, there are at least 30,000 patients who are eligible for this test.

If patients are diagnosed with early stage lung cancer, surgery is the standard treatment with high cure rates. If patients are not surgical candidates, they can be safely treated with 4 to 5 radiation doses, called stereotactic ablative radio-surgery, with essentially no side effects and also very high cure rates. This specialized form of radiation is offered at most cancer centers in SD.

To address the high lung cancer death rates among the Lakota Sioux, we implemented a lung cancer screening navigation program on the west river reservations in an attempt to lower these death rates as part of an ongoing program called Walking Forward that has been in existence since 2002. This is a community-based program based in Rapid City with staff who live and work in their communities of Pine Ridge and Rosebud. The overarching program goal is to lower cancer death rates for Lakota Sioux, through patient navigation, access to cancer screening and early detection and state of the art cancer treatments. To date we have referred over 420 patients for an LDCT with

over 335 completed scans.

So, if you are a smoker: 1) try to quit; 2) if you are a candidate for lung cancer screening talk to your primary care provider about an LDCT, and 3) for the younger generation – don't start smoking!

Bottom Line: lung cancer can be successfully treated if caught early – get screened if you are eligible.
