

NOTICE TO LANDOWNERS

Notice is hereby given to all landowners and renters in Sheridan County to cut all weeds and grasses along the shoulder right of way on township roads adjoining their land by October 1, 2023 as provided for in section 63-05-01 and 02 of the North Dakota Century Code. If weeds and grasses are not cut by this time, the Sheridan County Commission will instruct the County Road Crew or Organized Township to cut weeds. The cost of cutting such weeds and grasses in each township will be charged \$300.00 per mile and such charges shall become part of the taxes to be levied against such land for 2023. Notice is also given to all landowners and renters that no electric fencing is allowed along shoulder right of way on township or County roads and removal of bales along road right of way must be removed by November 1, 2023 or bales will be burned. Removal of any equipment along road right of way must be done by November 1, 2023 also or equipment will be towed and cost of towing will be charged to the equipment owner. 





*Sept. 16 & 17: Veterans & active military & youth ducks, coot, & merganser season.

*Sept. 16: Sandhill crane season opens.

*Sept. 22: Eastern Zone Early Canada Goose closes.

*Sept. 23: Resident waterfowl season opens.

*Sept. 24: Youth deer season closes.

*Sept. 30: Nonresident waterfowl season opens.

*N.D. Game & Fish Dept. game wardens: No new reports.

*Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Cenex Bait & Tackle, Garrison: Limited activity on the east end of Lake Sakakawea. Continue working deep around Garrison and Douglas bays. No Lake Audubon reports.

*Lakes Audubon & Sakakawea, Hwy. 83 Lawn & Leisure, Garrison: Work the Highway 83 islands and around Mallard Island on the east end of Lake Sakakawea with a switch to minnows in 35 to 40 feet for walleye. Continued smallmouth bass and muskie success with some pike mixed in on Lake Audubon. Remember to release all muskie less than 48 inches.

*Lake Sakakawea, Dakota Waters Resort, Beulah: Look for a morning walleye bite but move around and try minnows or try jigging Raps when locating a pocket of fish. Work shallower in 20 to 25 feet. Resort closed for the season after Sept 17.

Lake Sakakawea, Indian

of Washburn: Missouri River generally quiet with limited reports from area lakes and Lake Sakakawea.

*Missouri River System, Scott's Bait & Tackle, Pick City: Missouri River tailrace remains slow with a few catfish and walleye in the spillway channel from boats. Try jigs and minnows or Lindy rigs and nightcrawlers. Try crankbaits in the main river. Limited salmon and trout activity. Shore-fishing slow during the day with better success at night. Occasional success from the wing walls during the day. East end of Lake Sakakawea producing a few walleye off the points in 40 to 50 feet using spinners or slow death hooks and minnows. Some fish are shallower but seem less active. Try Steinke, Douglas, or Government bays and around Alcatraz. Work around the thermocline in 75 feet and deeper for salmon on the east end. Try shallower before sunrise with crankbaits or a variety of presentations later in the day. Spawning salmon should be moving in. Salmon are still running in the 3- to 5-pound range.

*McLean Co. area lakes, Cenex of Wilton: Anglers continue using a mix of minnows and nightcrawlers for walleye with most activity on Lake Sakakawea or New Johns. Hunting:

*Deer: Look for a little more

movement with cooler weather. *Doves: Birds bunching more

with cooler weather with fair numbers yet.

*Upland: Hunters finding nice partridge numbers with fair grouse numbers in pockets but not much hunting activity. Numbers to know:


