

THE OPEN RANGE

By the time the "incident" was over, it was a foregone conclusion as to who was the hero in Israel's rendition of the story.





Primary Election 2024

The Primary Election for 2024 is fast approaching. McLean County has been a Vote-by-Mail County since 2012 with four polling locations and this will continue for the 2024 Primary Election.

Absentee ballot applications were sent out to all voters in McLean County. If you received one, you may fill it out and return it to our office. If you did not receive one in the mail, you can complete the application below; contact the Auditor's Office at (701) 462-8541 to have one mailed to you; or complete it online at https://www.mcleancountynd. gov/departments/election-information/ vote-by-mail. If you check all of the boxes at the top of the application, you will automatically receive your school ballot, General Election ballot in November, and the ballots for any special elections held in 2024. After you have completed your application, please return it to the McLean County Auditor's Office by mail, drop off in the secure drop box in front of the courthouse main entry, or in person. Remember to return your voted ballot by mail early or you can drop it off in the secure drop box located in front of the McLean

County Courthouse at 712 5th Avenue in Washburn.

Those who do not check the box for General Election on their application will receive another ballot application around September 26 for the November General Election.

*** It is very important to fill out the application COMPLETELY, be sure to include name, phone number, date of birth, ID used, ID number, residential address, mailing address and signature. ***

SIGNATURES ON BALLOT ENVE-LOPE AFFIDAVITS WILL BE COM-PARED TO SIGNATURES ON BAL-LOT APPLICATIONS. If the signatures do not appear to match, the ballot could be rejected. If the ballot is rejected the McLean County Auditor's office will do their best to contact you to provide you the opportunity to verify the authenticity of the signatures.


