Kulzer Farms has been selected as the 2024 Conservation Farm Achievement winner for the South McLean County Soil Conservation District. Kulzer Farms is operated by Jeff and Kim Kulzer with their farming operation located one and one-half mile southeast of Washburn, North Dakota in McLean County. Jeff is a third-generation farmer that began farming in McLean County during 2001 with Donald Streifel at Don's Washburn, North Dakota farm. Jeff has purchased and developed his own farm headquarters two miles north of the Streifel farmyard.

The Kulzer Farms conservation farming operation produces cash crops by growing various spring or fall seeded small grains, canola, grain corn, dry edible beans, field peas and soybeans in rotation. Several of the cropland fields are pivot irrigated with water from the Missouri River or irrigation water wells. Their rangeland acres are leased to other livestock producers.

Jeff has implemented a stripper type combine header on small grain crops for greater residue amounts and increased moisture management. Three irrigation pivot systems were converted to variable rate irrigation (VRI) application in 2022. Jeff has implemented advanced irrigation water management (IWM) on these pivot systems and utilizes standard IWM on the remaining irrigation pivots.

Several poor performing cropland fields have been enrolled into the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) and seeded to grass for erosion control and wildlife nesting habitat. Kulzer Farms has maintained wildlife food plots for many years and has multiple windbreaks designed for winter wildlife habitat cover. Sloughs and

The Kulzer's started their cropland conservation efforts with mulch tillage cropping or one pass seeding systems and progressed to no-till seeding with single disk airseeders and no-till row crop equipment. Kulzer farm's conservation practices on their cropland acres include a continuous conservation cropping system, no-till seeding residue management, field windbreaks, precision nutrient management, integrated pest management (IPM) and irrigation water management (IWM) on the irrigated cropland acres. These cropland conservation practices contribute to the farm's soil health and productivity. Kulzer Farm's annually soil test and utilize precision fertilizer application techniques for their cropland nutrient management system. The Kulzer's farm equipment utilizes GPS precision guidance systems for pesticide application operations and they implement best management practices for integrated pest control management.

native grass areas adjoining their cropland fields are maintained for wide variety of upland and wetland wildlife habitat. Jeff and his family are avid hunters and enjoy several family based outdoor recreation activities.

Their multiple farmstead headquarters are protected by established farmstead windbreaks that have been continually updated or renovated over the years to maintain the farmstead windbreaks condition and functionality.

Jeff has utilized the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP), Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP), Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), Ducks Unlimited programs and the North Dakota Outdoor Heritage Funds (OHF) program to implement his conservation planning efforts.

The South McLean County Soil Conservation District is proud to announce Kulzer Farms as their 2024 Conservation Achievement Farm winner. Kulzer Farms has done an outstanding job of conservation practice implementation and resource management on their farming operation.
