

kota, Nebraska and Montana on May 1. The reasons cited are staffing and resource limitations, which USACE said affect its ability to open and maintain recreation sites and services. According to USACE, the adjustments are being made to ensure visitor safety, protect environmental resources and sustain critical hydropower and dam operations across the Missouri River Basin.

The city of Beulah is collaborating with local nursery company High Plains Concepts to host an Arbor Day celebration on April 25 at Beulah Elementary School.


