2. Planting of trees and shrubs is only allowed if approved by the City of Garrison Cemetery committee. Trees and shrub planting is not allowed on the plots.
3. Flowers that are placed around the headstones for the Holidays should be removed from the area within two weeks after the Holiday if they are not attached to the headstones or in permanent vases on the headstones. Flowers that are left on the plot will be removed for facilitating ground maintenance.
4. Vehicles are restricted to the established roads.
