Survey Dates: March 23-26

To continue the work of developing an inventory of the water service line materials on the system, the next phase of the process will involve onsite verifications. Moore Engineering is working to document these service line materials, and you will see them throughout the City of Garrison over the course of the next couple of weeks. A portion of their job includes a visual inspection of the service line as it enters the building.

Why is this Survey Important?

This inventory is part of a nationwide initiative and the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality requests that residents and property owners in the City of Garrison cooperate. This initiative will allow water providers to document the presence (or absence) of lead service pipes in their systems. We appreciate your cooperation!

Our goal is to work as a team with the City of Garrison to identify as many of the service lines (on both sides of the curb stops) as possible to reduce the future effort of staff for reporting and user outreach. The more services we can identify under this workorder from the state, the less work for City of Garrison staff in the future.

Don't want a Visit, Complete the Survey on your own.

For those that have previously completed the survey themselves, you can disregard. If we have your water service line information, Moore will not need to visit your residence.

If you would like to complete the survey on your own, please visit www.ndwaterpipes.com. The online survey take approximately 5 minutes to complete and, if successfully submitted, we will eliminate the need for a Moore Engineering employee to enter your property for documentation.

To complete the survey, you'll need a coin, magnet, and smartphone. The website will guide you step-by-step on how to locate and identify your properties water service pipe.

Two McLean Electric Cooperative Director Seats Up for Election

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BEING A DIRECTOR?

This year, the two districts up for election are:

District 2, which is a three-year term, includes the townships of Douglas, Blue Hill, Gate, Roseglen, 149-86, 149-85, Saint Mary, 148-86, Blackwater, 147-88, 147-87, 147-86. Clarence Behles currently serves District 2. Clarence Behles is not seeking re-election.

District 7, which is a three-year term, includes the townships of Mercer, 146-80, 145-80, 145-84, 145-79, 144-80, 144-81, 144-82, 144-83, 144-84, 143-81, 143-80. Larry Gessele currently serves District 7. Larry Gessele is seeking re-election.

Pick up a petition at the McLean Electric Cooperative headquarters in Garrison and secure 15 signatures of members from within your district. You can start circulating the petition right away, but it must be filed not less than 60 days before the annual meeting. Petitions for the 2026 director elections must be filed with McLean Electric Cooperative by April 13, 2026, by 5:00 p.m.

According to the bylaws, any member of McLean Electric Cooperative who is a member of this cooperative as a bona fide resident of the district they represent and is in no way employed by or financially interested in a competing enterprise can become a candidate for the board of directors. Directors shall be elected by the members at large at the MEC annual meeting on June 16, 2026, in Garrison.

Directors have a fiduciary responsibility to the cooperative. They exercise care, time, and responsibility in reviewing cooperative matters. Directors treat cooperative business as if it were their own. Directors devote a certain amount of time to the cooperative. At a minimum, a director attends each monthly board meeting. Directors learn about the industry as a whole by reading other materials and by attending state and national meetings. An understanding of the industry's issues is vital. To help directors with their responsibilities, training is offered through the electric cooperative's statewide organization. Courses cover director duties and liabilities, understanding the electric business, board roles and relationships, strategic planning, and financial decision-making. Directors currently serving on the cooperative's board find the duty extremely rewarding.
